1. Introduction :

Admission to Post Graduate courses offered by Nitte University is based on merit in the All India Entrance Test, NUPGET 2011 conducted by the University. Based on Merit inter se in the Entrance Test, students will be admitted to MDS program in the constituent college, **A.B. Shetty Memorial Institute of Dental Sciences, Mangalore**

2. Eligibility:

Candidates who fulfill the following criteria shall be eligible to appear for the Entrance Test, namely:

- i) He/she is a citizen of India
- ii) He/she must have studied and passed courses leading to the award of Bachelor's Degree scoring **at least 50% marks in aggregate**, from a college recognized by the DCI.
- iii) He/she has completed or is completing compulsory rotatory internship on or before **30th April 2011**.
- iv) Must be less than 45 years of age as on 30-4-2011

Note: Applications are liable for rejection if

- i) incomplete
- ii) received after the last date (06-01-2011)
- iii) not signed by the candidate
- iv) photographs are not of recent origin

3. Examination Fee:

The candidates are required to pay the registration fee of **Rs. 1,500/-** through A/c Payee **Demand Draft** in favour of "**Nitte University**" payable at **Mangalore**.

a) **Syllabus :**

The syllabus content will ordinarily be that prescribed for the Bachelor's degree by the DCI.

b) Mode of conducting the test:

- i) Entrance Test will be conducted in English.
- ii) Each question carries one mark. Correct answer will be awarded one mark. There is no negative marking for wrong answers.
- iii) Question paper (booklet) is of **3 hours duration** consisting of **200 multiple choice questions**. Subject wise distribution of marks would be approximately in the range as given below:

- iv) There will be at least 4 versions of the question paper booklet and therefore serial number of question differs from version to version.
- v) Questions will be of multiple choice type, each having **one** best response out of four alternatives.
- vi) Answer sheet (Response Sheet) is of Optical Mark Reader (OMR) type and is to be marked as per instructions on it, using a black or blue ball point pen.

7. General Instructions:

- i) The candidates shall appear for the Entrance Test at their own cost, in any one of the centres as per the choice indicated by them in their application form. No change of centre is permissible.
- ii) Each candidate will be given a TAT Number and the Test Admission Ticket will bear this number. Seating arrangements with this number will be displayed at the Test Centre.

- iii) Candidates shall be present at the centre 30 minutes before the commencement of the Test.
- iv) Only those candidates who possess the Test Admission Ticket shall be allowed to write the Entrance Test. **However, a duplicate may be issued against a payment of Rs. 100/-.**
- v) No candidate shall be admitted to the Hall after the commencement of the Test.
- vi) No candidate will be allowed to leave the Hall before the end of first 30 minutes. Candidates leaving the hall prior to the end of test will have to handover the question paper and OMR sheet to the room invigilator and collect the question paper after the Test. No candidate will leave the room without handing over the OMR sheet.
- vii) Candidates should sign the Attendance Sheet as per the instructions of the invigilator.

Candidates found guilty of disorderly or improper conduct may be debarred from the Entrance Test by the Chief Superintendent of the Centre.
