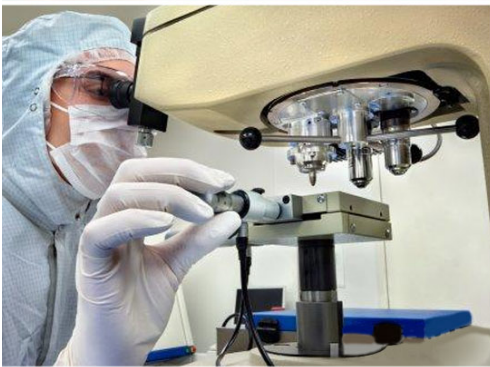

Sri Devaraj Urs Educational Trust started this pioneer Medical college in the year 1986, to fulfill its objectives and successfully transformed it into a Deemed to be University in the year 2007. The College is situated at Tamaka (abutting National Highway No.4 – between Bangalore and Chennai), 5 k.m. from KOLAR, Karnataka. Kolar is well connected by road, rail and air due to its proximity to Bangalore, which is 75 kms away. The nearest Railway Junction is Bangarpet, 15 km away from Kolar.

The Medical Council of India granted recognition for the Undergraduate Course in its very first Inspection in the year 1992, which shows the commitment of The Trust & Faculty, in

imparting Quality Medical Education. Post Graduate Degree and diploma Courses are being offered since 1997 in various Clinical, Pre & Para Clinical courses.

The location of this unitary campus with College, Hospital, Hostels and other facilities, is 2500 ft. above sea level and enjoys salubrious and pleasant weather throughout the year. The campus occupies around 100 acres of land covered with greenery and is pollution free. All the areas of campus are well connected and well lit.

R. L. Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre

Sri Devaraj Urs Educational Trust has a 850 beds Teaching Hospital to satisfy its Social obligation of meeting the health needs of people of the region and to provide the clinical-teaching requirements of undergraduate & post graduate medical students. Its design is hexagonal and is situated in the college campus with good ventilation, spacious waiting halls and corridors surrounded by lush green lawns. The ambience has a soothing effect on the patients, their attendants, students and staff. The excellent services and facilities offered by the hospital makes it comparable to any other leading medical institution in the country. The hospital has full fledged Departments in all specialties. Each department has its own seminar hall and patients examination rooms in the OPD. Each specialty has male & female wards, with bed strength as per MCI norms and each ward has its own attached side laboratory.

Specifications and Services of the Hospital

- It is the only centre in Kolar District to offer Super Specialty Services in Cardiology, Neurology, Nephrology, Diabetology, Thoracic Surgery, Vascular Surgery, Paediatric Surgery, Plastic Surgery, Neuro Surgery and Urology.
- Nephrology department has 7 dialysis machines and functions round the clock.
- Cardiology department has tied up with Vivus of Mahavir Jain Hospital, Bangalore and offers mobile cath-lab facility.
- The Oncology department has full fledged Medical, Surgical & Radiation Oncology units and is equipped with latest Radiotherapy facilities.
- There is a state of art Operating Room complex consisting of 12 Theatres equipped with latest anaesthetic ventilators, monitors, electro-cautery, laparoscopy, and C-Arm.

- Medical, Surgical, Paediatric and Central ICUs are available to take care of very sick patients and are manned by concerned specialists, anaesthetists intensive care personnel, experienced nursing staff and laboratory technicians.

- There is a full fledged Accident & Emergency Department with Ambulances and mobile ICU to offer round the clock emergency services.

- The Radiology Department has latest generation MRI, CT, Duplex Scan, Doppler, Mammography and IITV, in addition to routine radiography equipment.
- The well stocked RLJH Regional Blood bank is the only source for whole blood and its components for this entire region and adjoining Andhra Pradesh. Voluntary blood donation camps are conducted regularly.

2. Post Graduate Medical Programs

Post Graduate degree and diploma courses, for the academic year 2009-2010 are required to commence from **2/05/09** (any changes in the schedule will be updated in the website).

Post Graduate degree course is a 3-years full time program. Post Graduate diploma course is a 2-years full time program.

3. Eligibility Criteria

Degree / Diploma Programs:

Applicants must meet all requirements of eligibility stipulated by Medical Council of India (MCI). They should be holders of recognized medical qualification in terms of section 11 of Medical council Act and must have completed or completing their internship by **30/04/09**.

MCI REGULATIONS:

Every student, selected for admission to a Post Graduate medical course in any of the medical institutions on acquiring MBBS Degree or an equivalent qualification thereto shall have obtained permanent registration with the Medical Council of India, or any of the State Medical Council(s) or shall obtain the same within a period of one month from the date of his/her admission, failing which his/her admission shall stand cancelled.

In the case of a foreign national, the Medical Council of India may, on payment of the prescribed fee for the registration, grant temporary registration for the duration of the Post Graduate training restricted to the college / institution to which the applicant is admitted for the time being exclusively for Post Graduate studies; Provided further, that temporary registration to such foreign national shall be subjected to the condition that such person is duly registered as medical practitioner in his own country from which the applicant has obtained his / her basic medical qualification and that his / her degree is recognized by the corresponding Council or concerned authority.

*****As per the Post Graduate Regulation 2000 of Medical Council of India, the minimum percentage of marks in the entrance test (SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009) for eligibility for admission to Post Graduate Courses shall be 50% for General Category candidates and 40% for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.**

Rank list / Rank Card will be prepared only for those students who are eligible for admission to Post Graduate Courses as per the Medical Council of India Post Graduate Regulations.

Note:

Change of category status like SC, ST, OBC, will not be entertained subsequent to the submission of application form for SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009. The students are cautioned to declare correctly their category status while filling the application. The declaration / certificate is subject to verification. Any discrepancy or misrepresentation as to the category status while applying entails automatic cancellation of admission.

6. SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009

Sri Devaraj Urs University will conduct an entrance test *SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009*, for candidates seeking admission to Post Graduate courses in Medical studies and the admission would be granted based on the inter se merit determined under the said test. The *SDUU-AIPGMET – 2009 test* scores are valid only for admissions during the **academic year 2009-2010**.

The SDUU-AIPGMET – 2009 will be conducted at centres in Bangalore on 07.02.2009

The test venue will be mentioned in the candidate’s Test Admission Ticket (TAT) and also on the website under every candidate’s individual login.

Please recheck the website for any changes / updates before leaving your Home town for the test/counselling.

6.1 Application Procedure

- The Online application form has to be filled up properly and completely.
- **Take a printout of the filled in Application form and Date of Birth Certificate / Identity Proof (Two Copies: Candidate’s Copy and University Copy).**
- The Application form is said to be complete only if it is enclosed with all the documents mentioned in the checklist. The application can be submitted **in person (for which acknowledgement has to be obtained) or by post address to : *The Registrar, Sri Devaraj Urs University, Tamaka, Kolar -563101, Karnataka, India on or before 5 P.M on 03.01.2009***
- ***Multiple application forms filled and received from the same candidate causing confusion will be treated as deliberate and may result in disqualification.***
- ***Ensure that the Demand Draft (DD) for Rs.1500/-(One Thousand five hundred only drawn in favour of The Registrar, Sri Devaraj Urs University, Kolar (payable at KOLAR), along with all the marks cards, attempt certificate(s) and Degree Certificate(s) are enclosed .***
- **Multiple Demand Drafts in excess of the prescribed fee (Rs.1500/-) if sent, by the candidate will not be refunded.**

Note: Send the Application in A4 size envelopes only. Do not fold the application form. Superscribe the envelope at the top “ SDUU-AIPGMET-2009 Application Form”

- **Attested copy of SC/ST/OBC certificates issued by competent authority.**

6.2 Test Admission Tickets

Candidates appearing for *SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009* will be issued a Test Admission Ticket (TAT) for identification. Candidates are required to bring the TAT and the Candidate's copy of Date of Birth Certificate / Identity Proof duly attested by the Head of the Institution where he/she has last studied or Gazetted officer from the place of residence of the candidate, which should be similar to the copy which was submitted to the University along with the application form. This is mandatory.

The Test Admission Ticket gives the details of the test centre assigned to the candidate. The candidate is assigned a Test centre during the processing of his/her application and no request for change in the test centre would be considered.

The Test Admission Ticket would be dispatched to the candidate by Speed post at the address mentioned in his/her application form. All Test Admission Tickets will be dispatched by **20th January 2009** and candidates who do not receive the Test Admission Tickets on or before **25th January 2009**, must contact helpdesk at **Ph:08152-649209** or at email: **sdupg2009@gmail.com** to have the details on the status of the Test Admission Ticket dispatch. Candidates can also view their test centre details in the SDUU website ***www.sduu.ac.in*** or ***www.sdumc.ac.in*** through Applicant Login.

Change of address, if any, during the process of *SDUU – AIPGMET 2009* must be intimated through post / courier / Email / Fax to *SDUU – AIPGMET* office. However, the responsibility for the same rests solely with the applicant.

The *SDUU – AIPGMET-2009* is the basis for assessment of inter se merit of all candidates and admission to Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College would be granted based on inter se merit determined under the said test. A merit / rank list is generated based on the candidate's scores in the entrance test.

As part of our test process, to ensure fairness to the merited students and to eliminate fraudulent attempts, it is planned to use Biometrics (Fingerprinting) at various stages of the process involved in entrance test.

6.3.1 Test Process

Test will have **180 multiple-choice questions (MCQs)**.

- The time allotted for the test would be **180 minutes**. The test will **begin at 10:00 A.M and end at 1:00 P.M**
- Candidates are required to mark their answers in an **OMR (Optical Mark Reader) Answer Sheet provided for the purpose**.
- Each correct answer is awarded one mark.
- **There will be no negative marking.**

No mark(s) will be awarded for multiple marking (marking multiple responses) of any question. Any over writing on the OMR sheet would be treated as multiple marking.

6.3.2 Syllabi

The scope of the syllabus for the Post Graduate Medical Entrance is based on the M.B.B.S. syllabus as prescribed by MCI. The number of questions related to each subject in *SDUU – AIPGMET-2009* is approximately as mentioned below:

6.3.3 Test Location

The *SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009* will be held in centres in **Bangalore**. The test will be held on the time and date mentioned in the TAT. **The details of the test centres will be published on the website. The Address of the centre will be mentioned in the TAT,** which would be dispatched to the candidate prior to the examination as per the calendar of events.

6.3.4 Instructions for Candidates

Candidates please note:

- Report 60 minutes before the commencement of the test (at 9:00 A.M)

- Test commences at 10:00 A.M
- Arriving later than 15 minutes after the commencement of the test is not permitted.
If you arrive after 10:15 A.M on the day of the Test you will not be allowed to take the test.

Answer sheet: All answers need to be marked in the space provided on the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet, which is machine read and evaluated. Candidates must **use only black Ballpoint pen** for marking their answers on the OMR sheet. *Use of erasers or Whiteners is not permitted.*

- *OMR answer sheets will be supplied only at the examination hall. After the test is over, the Answer Sheet should be returned to the invigilator before leaving the room. Candidates are allowed to take the candidate's copy of the answer sheet only after the completion of the test (i.e. after 180 minutes).*
- Kindly note that the candidates must sign on their TAT and OMR answer sheets in the presence of the invigilator, after the invigilator has verified their TAT. **Invigilators will also sign on the column indicating 'Invigilator's Signature' on the OMR Sheet, if not; the answer sheet will be invalid** and will not be considered for processing.
- Candidates are also required to write their **name, question booklet number, Version Code, TAT number;** in the space provided in their OMR answer sheet.
- The OMR answer sheet is machine read and therefore it should be handled with care. If there is any doubt, please contact the test invigilator immediately.
- The SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009 test administration is time bound. The test session is designed to be completed within 180 minutes as indicated in this brochure and no compromise will be made on the set time limits. The Chief Superintendent of the test centre is the official timekeeper. **Candidates (Test takers)** will not be permitted to extend beyond the given time limit.
- It is planned to use biometrics (fingerprinting) during the test session.
- *Candidates are not allowed to go out of the room temporarily for any reason during the test duration.*

6.3.5 Grounds for Dismissal from the test

The *SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009 test* administrator is authorised to dismiss a candidate from the test session for the following reasons:

- Attempting to take the test on behalf of someone else (Impersonation)
- Failing to provide acceptable identification when asked for
- Creating disturbance at the test venue
- Giving or receiving unauthorised help
- Using any forbidden / unauthorised testing aids, such as personal computational devices, pagers, cell phones, other electronic gadgets, etc.
- The candidate is not allowed to leave the Test Center before 30 minutes from start of Test.
- Refusing to follow directions as stipulated by the invigilators etc.
- Requests like use of toilet during the test are not entertained. Failure to comply with the test procedures & regulations or with the test administrator's directions, can result in the University taking action(s) that include, but are not limited to, barring candidates from future testing and/or canceling the test scores. The test fee of these candidates will also be forfeited.

6.4 ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

All answer sheets (OMR) are machine read. Key Answers and Test scores of all the candidates will be published on the website, *www.sduu.ac.in or www.sdumc.ac.in* and clarifications, if any, should be sought within the time and dates stipulated. Subsequently the final result along with the Merit List will be published which will be binding on all candidates and no further claim would be entertained thereafter. (Please refer to the Calendar of Events for the details.)

Announcement of test results will be in two stages:

- Announcement of Test Score
- Announcement of Final Merit / Rank List

Individual rank card will be sent to eligible candidates only. The same information will also be made available at the SDUU–AIPGMET-2009 website, *www.sduu.ac.in or www.sdumc.ac.in*

6.4.1 Announcement of Test Scores

- **Key Answers** to the *SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009* will be published on the website, **late in the evening of 7th February 2009.**

- **Clarifications to the key answers**, if any, should be sought between 7th February 2009 and 14th February 2009 (Communications pertaining to key answers **received after 14th February 2009 will not be entertained**)
- **Test scores of SDUU – AIPGMET – 2009** will be published on **17th February 2009**
- **Clarifications to the Test Scores**, if any, should be sought between **17th February 2009 and 23rd February 2009**. Communications seeking clarifications pertaining to Test Scores received after 23rd February 2009 will not be entertained

No further claims will be considered. The final merit / rank list is generated based on the performance in the entrance test and the same will be published on **28th February 2009**

Inter-se Merit:

Ties in the test scores, if any, will be resolved based on the following, **in the order specified:**

- *Total aggregate percentage scored in the M.B.B.S.*
- *Number of additional attempts during the course of study, i.e., M.B.B.S.*
- *The age of the candidate, the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate.*

In case of tie existing after exhausting all of the above situations, merit will be based on random selection.

10. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. What is the eligibility for the courses?

A. As prescribed by MCI, candidates who have passed their M.B.B.S. from an institution recognised by MCI and have completed (or are expecting to complete their internship by **30/04/09**) are eligible for the courses. Candidates should also meet other requirements as prescribed by MCI.

Q. Is the Entrance Test open only to Karnataka students?

A. No, this entrance test is open to all the eligible students in the country.

Q. Who are the candidates eligible to get the benefit of lower eligibility qualifying marks?

A. All SC/ST and OBC candidates, irrespective of their State of Origin can seek the benefit, provided the certificate as applicable, issued by competent authorities not less than Tahsildar is furnished in support of the claim.

Q. I have finished my M.B.B.S. a few years ago, am I eligible for these courses?

A. You can apply for the notified courses, as long as you fulfill the basic eligibility, as prescribed by MCI.

Q. Is there an age limit for admission to the courses?

A. No, there is no age limit for admission to the courses.

Q. When is the last date to apply?

A. All filled-in applications with all enclosures including the **Demand Draft for Rs.1500/-** must reach **The Registrar, Sri Devaraj Urs University, Tamaka, Kolar -563101, Karnataka, India**, on or before 5:00 pm on 03rd January 2009.
