## Eligibility Criteria to appear for MEDPET 2012

1. The candidate must be an Indian National.
2. Foreign / NRI / PIO candidates seeking admission to PG Programmes will have to obtain registration from the Medical Council of India.
3. The candidate must have passed MBBS examination from any Medical College recognised by the Medical Council of India.
4. The candidate should have completed the compulsory rotating internship on or before **30th April, 2012**. He / She will have to produce a certificate of completion of internship before joining the programme.
5. The candidate should have a permanent registration with any State Medical Council in India or Medical Council of India. If he / she does not have the same, he / she will be required to obtain such registration within one month after admission to the PG Programme failing which his / her admission to PG Programme will automatically get cancelled.
6. If a candidate does not fulfill any or all of the above requirements or fails to pay the fees at the time of counselling and admission, he / she will not be considered eligible for admission irrespective of his / her appearing for MEDPET 2012 examination and securing a rank in the merit list.
7. The candidates possessing Diploma qualification in the same subject recognised by the Medical Council of India are eligible for exemption of 1st year of the 3 year residency (Post-Graduation Period) in the same subject.

## Bharati Vidyapeeth University, Pune

During the last 15 years or so, the University has achieved still higher pinnacles of academic excellence and has established its reputation to such an extent that it attracts students not only from various parts of India but also from abroad. According to a survey conducted by Association of Indian Universities, this University is one among the top ten Universities in the country preferred by the overseas students for admissions. At present, there are more than 800 overseas students from 67 countries on the rolls of constituent units of this University.

During the last 15 years, there has been tremendous academic expansion of the University. # Bharati Vidyapeeth University

## Medical College, Pune (India)

Bharati Vidyapeeth University Medical College, Pune established in 1989 is one of the premier institutes imparting quality medical education at undergraduate, postgraduate and post doctoral level. The college was under the Pune University before it became the constituent unit of Bharati Vidyapeeth University, Pune in April 1996.

At present the college is permitted to admit 150 students for MBBS course and 103 students in various postgraduate degree and diploma courses. All the courses have been started with the prior permission of the Medical Council of India and are recognized by it. The college is recognized by General Medical Council, Great Britain. The college is listed in the World Health Organization's Directory and the students of this college are eligible to appear for USMLE and PLAB examination. The college also conducts certain post doctoral fellowship programs, M.Sc. program in Basic Sciences and Ph.D. program.

The college as a constituent unit of Bharati Vidyapeeth University, Pune was accredited "A" grade by NAAC in 2004.

The college boasts of excellent infrastructure, experienced, dedicated and caring faculty, a strong student support system, facilities for research including a dedicated research institute, community outreach and extension activities and a 860 bedded multispeciality, tertiary care hospital offering all the modern diagnostic and therapeutic services, which also serves as a teaching and training centre for undergraduate and postgraduate medical students. The hospital is a multi-storied building well equipped with diagnostic facilities in the form of laboratories and Radiology Department with state-of-the art equipments. The ICU, NICU and PICU beds providing critical care are well known and get referrals from all over Maharashtra. It has a modern OT complex with well equipped super specialty services like Neurosurgery, Plastic Surgery, Nephrology etc.

The college library building is a fine specimen of architectural beauty and provides excellent collection of books and journals with a separate computer and Internet facility.

The college has so far hosted many National and International Conferences, Seminars, Workshops and provides excellent educational ethos for all-round development of the students.

The students come here with a dream and we help them for its maximum fulfillment.

## Bharati Vidyapeeth University Medical College & Hospital, Sangli (India)

Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University Medical College, Sangli was established in 2005. The college has so far admitted 6 batches of 100 students each. The college is recognized by the Medical Council of India. At present the first batch of students admitted are doing internship in the Medical College and Hospital.

The college is built in huge edifice & serene atmosphere of Sangli. The college is established in 2.2 lakh sq. ft. spacious building. The area for the 500 bedded attached teaching hospital is 3.2 lakh sq. ft.

The college has excellent infrastructure, well equipped laboratories; facilities for MRI, C.T. Scan, Mammography, Haemodialysis, Blood Bank with Blood Components etc. are available. The state-of-art museums, library and other teaching learning resources have made it a centre for academic excellence.

With more than thousand patients a day in OPD & 400 in IPD the hospital ensures a good & all round clinical exposure to the students. The institute boasts of qualified and caring staff and advanced instruments ensuring adequate training and keeping pace with the development in Medical field. ### Overseas Students

#### Foreign / NRI / PIO / Management Seats :

Out of the seats sanctioned by the Medical Council of India, for the PG programmes to these Colleges, fifty percent of seats are reserved as Foreign / NRI / PIO / Managements Seats. The candidates seeking admissions to these courses on the seats of this category need to purchase the CET Brochure of the University and will also have to apply separately on a prescribed application form. The Indian students seeking admission on the seats of this category will have to appear for MEDPET 2012 along with regular students. The completed form should be submitted to the Registrar, Bharati Vidyapeeth University, Pune. The seats remaining vacant after the allotment of the Foreign / NRI / PIO students will be allotted to the Indian students who have applied for admissions on the seats of this category, on the basis of merit determined in terms of marks obtained by them in MEDPET 2012. The last date for the submission of application form for the students seeking admissions on the seats of this category is **31/12/2011**.

## Admission Procedure

1. The Admissions to M.D./M.S. and Diploma courses to Bharati Vidyapeeth University Medical College, Pune will be made on the basis of merit obtained by the candidate in medical post graduate entrance test i.e. MEDPET-2012.

In case of candidates having equal marks in MEDPET-2012 the following procedure shall be adopted as a tie-breaker.

- (1) First preference to the candidates on the basis of higher marks obtained in the III M.B.B.S. examination.
  - (2) In case of equal marks in the (1) above, preference will be decided on grand total of marks secured by the candidate at I, II and III M.B.B.S. examinations.
  - (3) If equal, preference shall be decided on the basis of total marks obtained by the candidate at the XII Std. examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects taken together.
  - (4) If equal, preference shall be decided on the basis of total marks obtained by the candidate in the X Std. examination.
2. MEDPET-2012 will be conducted at the Centers in Pune, New Delhi, Navi Mumbai, Sangli, Hyderabad and Vadodara at the addresses given on cover 3.
  3. The question paper of MEDPET-2012 will contain 200 multiple choice questions of, one best choice type, out of 4 choices. The questions will be on the syllabi prescribed for the I, II and III M.B.B.S. examinations, with more weightage given to clinical subjects. Each correct answer will get 3 marks. There will be no negative marking. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions.

## Application Procedure

Candidates paying their fees through Demand draft(DD) are required to enclose the attested photocopies of the following documents duly attested by Principal/Gazetted Officer along with the form. If the payment is done through Credit/Debit card, please bring these document along with the form at the time of examination.

- i) Statement of marks of I, II and III MBBS examinations.
- ii) If the candidate is employed, he should submit 'No Objection Certificate' from the employer.

- iii) Statement of marks of 10+2 or equivalent examination & SSC Certificate.
- iv) Certificate from the Dean / Principal of the Medical College of the candidate stating, that the College is recognised by the Medical Council of India.
  
- I) The application has to be signed by the applicant.

If payment is done through DD, the form complete in all respects should be sent by registered post/speed post/courier/ by hand so as to reach this University not later than 5.00 p.m. on the date specified in the Calendar of Events (last page) at the following address :

2. THE EXAMINATION HALL WILL BE OPENED 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TEST. CANDIDATES ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE THEIR SEATS 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE EXAMINATION. IF THE CANDIDATES DO NOT REPORT IN TIME THEY ARE LIKELY TO MISS SOME OF THE GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BE ANNOUNCED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL.
3. A candidate who comes late by 30 minutes or more after the commencement of the examination will not be permitted to appear for the examination.
4. The candidate must show, on demand, the Admission Card for admission to the examination hall. A candidate who does not possess the Admission Card issued by the Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University, Pune will not be admitted to the examination hall under any circumstances by the Centre Superintendent.
5. A candidate will not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the Admission Card inside the examination hall. Reasonable number of candidates in accordance with the merit will be

informed and called for counselling.

### Counselling And On-the-Spot-Admission Session :

- a) Please note that the admissions will be done strictly on the basis of merit and on the availability of seats in Medical College at PUNE and SANGLI as declared on pages 15 & 16 in the brochure.
- b) The counselling and on-the-spot admission session will be held at the Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University Medical College, Pune-Satara Road, Pune-411 043 on the date and time communicated individually to the candidates as per the merit list. Only the candidates who have received communication should attend counselling on specified date & time.
- c) Only the candidate and one parent/guardian will be allowed into the hall where counselling is held. The candidates will be called in the order of their merit and offered the seats available at that point in time. The candidate will be permitted to choose any of the seats available when his/her turn comes.
- d) When all the seats in a given course are filled, admission of students to that course will instantaneously cease and Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University will not be responsible for non-availability of the seats and non-allotment to the rest of the candidates.
- e) At the time of reporting for the counselling, the candidate is required to produce the documents (original and two sets of photocopies) listed in above application procedure. If the candidate is admitted to any of the courses, these documents will be retained by the University till he/she completes the course. If the candidate fails to produce the documents listed in application procedure on page 12, he/she will instantaneously forfeit his claim for a seat.
- f) Physical presence of the candidate at the counselling is mandatory. The choice of course made by the candidate is final and binding and will not be altered later under any circumstances.
- g) If any candidate finds it impossible to be physically present for the counselling due to unavoidable circumstances, he/she may authorise any other responsible individual to represent him/her at the counselling. This representative must carry with him/her the letter of authorisation in the format given in Annexure II and all the documents mentioned in Annexure-I. If the candidate or his representative fails to report for the counselling on the date and the time mentioned in the schedule of counselling as per the counselling letter, his claim for admission to any of the courses will be forfeited. The choice of course made by the candidate / his / her representative will be final and binding and will not be ordinarily altered later.

The selected candidates from amongst those called for counselling will have to finalise the admission by payment of fees on the spot.

- (3) If a student submits his application for cancellation of admission in a prescribed form (duly completed) within 30 calendar days from the date of commencement of the particular course, 20 percent of the total amount of tuition fees prescribed for the course will be deducted from the amount of tuition fee paid by him and the balance amount will be refunded.
- (4) If a student submits an application for cancellation of admission after 30 calendar days from the date of commencement of the particular course, no refund will be made and Rule (5) may also be invoked.

However, if the application for cancellation of admission is submitted before the last date prescribed for admission, and if the vacated seat is filled by another candidate, 25% of the amount of tuition fees prescribed for the course will be deducted from the amount of tuition fee paid and the balance amount will be refunded.

- (5) If any student admitted to any course leaves the course after the prescribed last date for admission of the particular course no refund will be made and he will be required to pay full amount of tuition fees for the remaining entire duration of the course.
