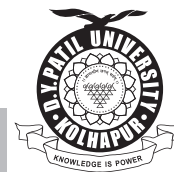

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1. INTRODUCTION

All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Test 2008 (AIPGMET 2008) will be conducted for admissions to various Post Graduate Medical Courses Under D. Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur 416006, a constituent college of **D.Y. Patil University on 24th February 2008 from 11.00 am to 2.30 pm.**

The College was established in 1989 and is recognized by the Medical Council of India, New Delhi. The College is associated with a 604 bed teaching hospital in its campus having state of the art facilities for health care and treatment.

The Admission Committee of the University will be responsible for conduct of the entrance test, declaration of results, counselling and final admission to the courses.

2. COURSES

2.1 The following Post Graduate courses are available at D.Y. Patil Medical College, Kolhapur.

2.3 a. General Category: 50% seats are in this category. Admission to this category will be made on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates at AIPGMET-2008.

b. Management Seats: 50% of the seats are reserved for Management quota. Admission to this category will also be made on the basis of inter- se- merit of the candidates at AIPGMET-2008.

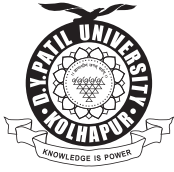
The candidates desirous of getting admission under this category will have to apply Separately on a prescribed form available from the university office.

3. MODE OF ENTRANCE TEST

3.1 The AIPGMET-2008 will be of three and half hours duration containing 300 multiple choice questions (MCQs). Questions will be of single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct answer will be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for incorrect answers.

3.2 The Examination will be conducted in **English.**

3.3 The Entrance Test shall be of the standard of M.B.B.S. Examination and shall cover all the subjects of the M.B.B.S. course. The subject wise distribution of MCQs will be as follows.

3.4 There shall be no verification of marks or reassessment in paper of APGMET 2008. If there is any objection on the conduct of examination or declaration of result, then he has to pay Rs. 5000/- as objection fees with the written objection letter. (Annexure - B)

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National. Nationality certificate issued by the District Magistrate or Additional District Magistrate or Chief Metropolitan Magistrate / valid passport shall constitute proof of nationality.

4.2 The candidate must have passed M.B.B.S Examination from a recognized medical college and should have obtained final registration either from the Medical Council of India, New Delhi or Maharashtra Medical Council after completion of one year rotating internship training.

4.3 The candidate undergoing one year rotating internship training and likely to obtain final registration certificate from the Medical Council of India, New Delhi or Maharashtra Medical Council on or before 15th April 2008 can also appear for the Entrance Test. Such candidates will be required to submit a certificate from the Principal / Dean of the College regarding the likely date of completion of has rotating internship training failing which his application will be treated as incomplete and shall be rejected.

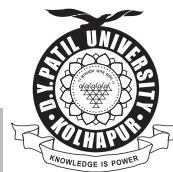
6. APPLICATION FORM

6.1 A Candidate desirous of appearing for All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Test of this University will be required to submit application in the prescribed form along with attested copies of the documents in support of application.

6.2 Entrance Test Fee

The Entrance Test Fee is Rs 2000/-. The fee is payable by demand draft drawn in favour of "Registrar, D.Y. Patil University" drawn on a nationalized / schedule bank, payable at Kolhapur. The Candidate should write his / her name and address on the reverse side of the demand draft.

6.3 The last date for receipt of completed application form along with requisite documents and entrance test fee at the University Office is upto 5 PM on 4th February 2008 (With late fee of Rs. 1000 /- upto 14th February 2008). It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that his / her application reaches the office of the University within the specified time and date. The application received after the due date or not accompanied by entrance



test fee / supporting documents shall be rejected and such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the Entrance Test. The university will not be responsible for non-receipt of application within the specified time and date due to postal or courier service delays.

7. HALL TICKET

Hall Tickets carrying photograph of the candidates shall be issued to the candidates who are eligible to appear for the Entrance Test.

The candidates will have to collect Hall Tickets from the Office of the University on 23rd february 2008

The Hall Ticket must be presented in the Examination Hall for verification of candidate's identity when instructed by the invigilator to do so and also at the time of counselling. The Hall Ticket is not transferable.

8. SELECTION PROCEDURE

8.1 The selection of the candidates will be done on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates taking into consideration the preference given by the candidate and availability of seat in the branch/ discipline of his choice when it is his turn for counselling.

8.2 Tie Breaker

In case of equal marks at AIPGMET 2008 inter-se-merit of the candidates will be determined by applying following tie breaker rules :

- a) First Level :** A Candidate securing higher percentage of marks in the aggregate of marks at the First, Second and Third M.B.B.S. (Part I & II) Examinations taken together will be preferred. If the tie still persists, then :
- b) Second Level:** A candidate securing higher percentage of marks in the Third M.B.B.S. (Part I & II) Examination will be preferred. If the tie still persists, then
- c) Third Level:** A Candidate securing higher percentage of marks at the Second M.B.B.S. Examination will be

- preferred. If the tie still persists then
- d) Fourth Level:** An older candidate will be preferred over a younger candidate.

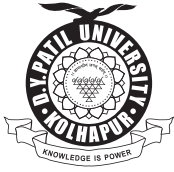

- 9.2** The tuition fee for the first year will have to be paid on the day of counselling or within the time limit if given at the time of counselling. Failure to pay the tuition fees within the specified time will result in automatic cancellation of admission offered to the candidate.
- 9.3** The tuition fee for the subsequent years will have to be paid as and when notified by the University / College. The candidates may be required to give a bank guarantee to cover fees of the subsequent years.
- 9.4** The fees once paid are non refundable.
Total Fees includes tuition fee and development fee.
University registration and eligibility fees is Rs. 35000/- (one time) in addition to above fees.



The present fees are tentative and shall be subject to rationalization by the competent authority.

10. DECLARATION OF RESULT

The result of the All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Test 2008 in the form of merit list arranged according to the marks obtained by the candidates containing names of the candidates will be declared at 3.30 PM on 10th March 2008 at the University office and on website.

11. COUNSELLING

- 11.1 The candidates will be called for counselling on 10th & 11th April 2008.
- 11.2 At the time of counselling the eligibility of the candidates for admission shall be verified from original documents and those found eligible will be offered admission to a course.
- 11.3 The candidate will have to appear for counselling at his own cost.
- 11.4 The Physical presence of the candidate for counselling is essential. Absence of the candidate at the specified time, date and venue will result in instantaneous forfeiture of any claim for admission and the University will not be responsible for it.
- 11.5 Asking a candidate to report for counselling does not mean that he/she will be admitted to the course. The actual admission will depend upon the course and seat availability when his / her turn comes in order of his / her inter-se-merit position.

12. DOCUMENTS

The attested copies of the following documents must be submitted along with application form for Entrance Test and originals should be presented at the time of counselling.

- Nationality Certificate / Valid Passport
- Birth Certificate
- First M.B.B.S. Examination Mark statement
- Second M.B.B.S. Examination Mark statement
- Third M.B.B.S. (Part I & II) Examination Mark statement.
- Rotating Internship Training Completion Certificate or Certificate from the Principal / Dean of the College indicating likely date of

completion of Rotating Internship Training

- Registration Certificate issued by MCI / State Medical Council

13. GUIDE LINES FOR ENTRANCE TEST

13.1 Candidate must be present at the Examination Hall and occupy the seat allotted to him half an hour before commencement of the Entrance test.

13.2 15 minutes prior to commencement of examination the invigilator will give general instructions on taking the test.

13.3 During the test, the invigilator will check identity of the candidates by referring to the Hall Ticket given to him.

13.4 The candidate must sign on the Attendance

sheet and also in the space provided for signature on the Test Booklet as well as answer-sheet.

13.5 The Answer-sheet will be given to the candidate at 10.45 am and Test-Booklet will be given at 10.55am. The candidate shall carefully read instructions printed on both Test Booklet and Answer Sheet and make correct entries. The correctness of the entries will be cross checked by the invigilator.

13.6 For answering the question, the candidate shall darken the appropriate circle using a **Black or Blue Ball Point pen**.

13.7 Each correct answer will be awarded one mark. However if more than one circles are darkened or any other marking method is used, no marks will be awarded.

13.8 Rough work, if any should be done in the space provided in the Test Booklet. Rough work should not be done anywhere on the Answer-sheet.

13.9 Printed Log Tables containing only Log, Anti-log, Sin, Cos, Tan and Square Roots only are permitted. Log Tables with formulae, conversion tables, calculators, Cellular Phones and any other electronic gadgets are not allowed in the Examination Hall.

13.10 Smoking is strictly prohibited in the University Campus and Examination Hall.

13.11 No candidates will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall till the Entrance test time is over.

- 13.12 After the Entrance Test is over the candidate must hand over the Test Booklet and Answer-sheet to the invigilator.



14. DISCIPLINE

The candidates admitted for the courses in the constituent college of the University are subject to the discipline and conduct Rules of the University. The Disciplinary Committee of the University will deal with all cases involving discipline or conduct either suo moto or when referred to it by the Principal/Dean of the College. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in this regard.

15. COURT JURISDICTION

Any legal dispute arising out of conduct of All-India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Test 2008 (AIPGMET 2008) and the admission procedure shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts of Kolhapur Only.

16. DISCLAIMER

D.Y.Patil University, Kolhapur, has not authorized any individual or agency to deal with the admissions to various constituent colleges of the University. The University will not be responsible for any activity of such individuals or agencies. The University does not charge any capitation fee in lieu of admission to its constituent colleges. It should also be noted that contents of this information Brochure are subject to changes as the University may deem fit. Changes, if any shall be notified on the Web-site of the University.

17. RAGGING

It must be noted that the institute considers ragging a cognisable offence and will not hesitate to take strong action against the offenders. Here are the extracts from the UGC's Committee Report. Guidelines given by the University Grants Commission to Curb the Menace of Ragging in Universities/ Educational Institutions. The word 'ragging' mean the act of teasing, taunting, playing a practical joke upon someone or holding comic parades and other activities during certain period of a college term to raise money for charity. Forms of ragging: Ragging is found to take the following forms (the list is only indicative and not exhaustive) Crisp Orders.

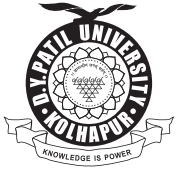
- To address seniors as 'Sir'
- To perform mass drills;

- To copy class notes for the seniors;
- To serve various errands;
- To do menial jobs for the seniors;
- To ask/answer vulgar questions;
- To look at pornographic pictures to 'shook the freshers out of their innocence;
- To force to drink alcohol, scalding tea, etc.
- To force to do acts with sexual overtones, including homosexual acts,
- To force to do acts which can lead to physical injury/mental torture or death;
- To strip, kiss, etc;
- To do other obscenities

Punishments

The following could be the possible punishments for those who are found guilty of participation in or abetment of ragging. The quantum of punishment shall naturally, depend upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Disciplinary Committee or the court of law

1. Cancellation of admission
 2. Suspension from attending classes.
 3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
 5. Withholding results
 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 7. Expulsion from the hostel
 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to –1 semesters
 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
 10. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-
 11. Rigorous imprisonment up to three years.
- While the first 10 types of punishment can be awarded by the appropriate authority of the institution itself, the last punishment can be awarded only by a court of law.

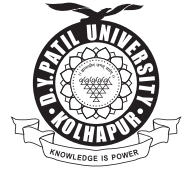
