

DMIMS(DU) ALL INDIA POST GRADUATE MEDICAL & DENTAL COMMON ENTRANCE TEST 2010 (DMIMS(DU)-AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU)-AI PGD CET 2010)

1. Department of Human Resource Development, Govt of India, on the recommendation of University Grants Commission (UGC) has accorded the status of University to the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Dentistry to Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur. Since Govt. of India, on the recommendation of UGC has given the status of Deemed University to Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences, for their under Graduate, Post-Graduate and Diploma courses, they would have the same status as those given by any statutory University that are recognized by the U.G.C.. through its circular dated 15th July & 13th Sept. 2006 has accorded the total parity with any Centre or State, university including permitting the usage of the word "UNIVERSITY" in the nomenclature. Moreover, prior to coming under the University, the Medical College and Dental College and their Post Graduate Degree & Diploma courses & under graduate courses were already approved and recognized by the respective statutory Councils i.e. Medical Council of India and Dental Council of India respectively and also by the State and Central Governments.

Therefore, the Medical and Dental Post-graduate courses offered by DMIMS(DU) are recognized by Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India, Govt of India, and University Grants Commission, New Delhi.

2. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Entrance Test DMIMS(DU)-AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU)-AI PGD CET 2010

- 2.1 The DMIMS(DU) AI PGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AI PGD CET 2010 will be conducted at **Nagpur only** for selection of candidate for admission to the MD / MS / Diploma / MDS / Diploma courses offered by DMIMS(DU) Nagpur. The medium of instruction of entrance test is English. The competent authority **DMIMS(DU)-AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU)-AIPGD CET 2010** will conduct the Examination, declare the result and display the merit list. The competent authority will be responsible for counseling and final admission to the course.

- 2.2 The Application Form & Examination fees of **DMIMS(DU)-AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU)-AIPGD CET 2010** is Rs. 2500 for each exam. which shall have to be paid by **CASH / D.D. drawn in favour of “Competent Authority DMIMS(DU) payable at Nagpur** at the time of the submission of application form.
- 2.3 No original documents are to be attached with the application form.
- 2.4 Candidate should submit the application form along with the attested true copies of the required certificates and documents.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 3.1 A candidate who has passed final M.B.B.S. OR B.D.S. Examination from a recognized Medical College OR Dental College approved by Medical Council of India OR Dental Council of India and who has obtained full registration either from the Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India or from the State Medical/Dental Council, after completing one-year compulsory rotating internship, will be eligible to appear for **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010**.
- 3.2 The full/permanent MCI / MMC or state for Medical or DCI / MDC for Dental or State registration is a condition precedent for appearing at **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** and its proof including submission of application for registration should be enclosed.
- 3.3 A candidate who has completed one year compulsory Internship or is likely to complete the same on or before **31” March 2009**, can also appear in **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010**.
- 3.4 Candidates likely to complete their internship -on or before 31-03-2010 should submit documentary proof from their Principals/Dean of the College regarding the likely date of completion of the Internship along with the form, failing which the application form will be rejected.
- 3.5 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing / completed the course are not eligible for appearing at **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010**. Candidates who have passed PG Diploma are eligible to appear for the **DMIMS(DU) AI PGM CET 2010** for admission to PG degree in the same subject only.
- 3.6 Candidate should keep one photocopy of his/her duly filled in application form with him/her for future reference.
- 3.7 Candidate should preserve the Receipt-cum-Identity card and Information Brochure for subsequent use.
- 3.8 The candidates who possess Indian Nationality, with a proof in the form of Nationality Certificate / valid passport, are eligible to appear for examination.
- 3.9 NRI candidates, who have passed from MCI/DCI recognized Medical / Dental Colleges, are also eligible for the examination.
- 3.10 Photographs - Two recent photographs, taken from the same negative, without cap or goggles, taken within the last six months should be pasted; one on the application form and other on the admit card, attached to the inside of the back cover.

4. CANDIDATES NOT ELIGIBLE FOR APPEARING

- 4.1 Candidates who are not completing internship on or before 31.03.2010.
- 4.2 Candidates who are registered for PG Degree/Diploma and have not completed the terms.
- 4.3 Candidates who have NOT obtained permanent MCI/DCI State Council registration at the time of submission of application form except those candidates who will be completing internship by 31.03.2010, such candidates will have to submit the same latest by 02.05.2010 .
- 4.4 Candidates who are previously registered and are pursuing the course.

5. CONDUCT OF DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AI PGD CET 2010

- 5.1 Completed application forms alongwith necessary certificate/documents duly attested should

- 5.2 All the eligible candidates are required to take the **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** exams. at their own cost.
- 5.3 The **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010** will be conducted on **Sunday 14/02/2010** between **2.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.** & **DMIMS (DU) AIPGD CET 2010** will be conducted on **Sunday 14/02/2010** between **2.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m.** at **Vimlatai Tidke Convent, Jr. College, Atrey Layout, Pratap Nagar, Nagpur.**
- 5.4 Candidates shall not bring Cellular Phone, Pager, Calculator etc. in the Examination Hall.
- 5.5 Competent Authority reserves the right to shift, if required, the examination city/center The change would be notified to eligible candidates.
- 5.6 **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010** paper would be of three & half hours duration containing **300** multiple choice questions (MCQ). **DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** paper will be of three hours duration containing **200** multiple choice questions (MCQ). Candidate must indicate there response to the question by darkening the appropriate circle completely with 2B Pencil or Black Ball Pen. Questions will be of single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct response shall be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Scratching, overwriting, tick mark and multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks would be awarded to them.
- 5.7 The candidate shall write with 2B Pencil or BLACK BALL POINT PEN. Candidate shall bring his own writing material.
- 5.8 The syllabus for the Common Entrance Test for P.G. Medicine & Dentistry shall cover all the subjects of MBBS & BDS . The tentative number of questions of each subject would be as given below :

6 RESULT AND MERIT LIST

- 6.1 The Competent Authority **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** will prepare a merit list indicating Merit list number, Name, Marks scored by the candidate.
- 6.2 A name of only those candidates who have obtained 50% or more marks i.e. **150 or more out of 300**

in **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET - 2010** and **100 or more out of 200 in DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET - 2010** shall be included in merit list. This list will be displayed on the notice board of DMIMS(DU), Camp Office, Wardha and Nagpur, also on the Website i.e. www.dmims.org for counseling and admission session.

- 6.3 The statement of marks of the candidates indicating marks obtained and merit number of the candidate will be dispatched by Post / Courier.
- 6.4 The candidate who desires a duplicate mark sheet will have to apply to the Competent Authority with prescribed fees of Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) paid by DD drawn in favour of "Competent Authority, DMIMS(DU) payable at Nagpur.
- 6.5 There will be no re-checking / revaluation of the answer sheets. However, the candidate can apply for verification of marks to the Competent Authority **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** within 4 days of declaration of result in prescribed form along with prescribed fees of Rs. Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) paid by DD drawn in favour of DMIMS(DU) payable at Wardha drawn on Nationalized bank.
- 6.6 The statement of marks of the candidate indicating Merit List (ML) number, name, marks scored, will be dispatched on the address filled in the application form by the candidate.
- 6.6 In case of any typographical error in mark sheet e.g. name, age, sex, category, etc., representation should be submitted within 24 hours from the date of distribution of mark sheet, to the Competent Authority, **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010**.

7. SELECTION PROCESS

- 7.1 Candidate should obtain 50% or more marks i.e. 150 or more out of 300 in **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010** & 100 or more marks in **DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** to qualify for admission.
- 7.2 The admissions will be done on the basis of merit list of **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** only.
- 7.3 50% seats are reserved as Merit Seats. 50% seats are reserved as management seats. Candidates desirous of seeking admission against management seats should mention specifically in the column provided in the application form.
- 7.4 Selection of the candidate for the management seats will be done according to the Inter-set Merit of the candidates in the entrance test i.e. **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010** or **DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** as is applicable to the candidate.
- 7.5 Some seats are reserved for "In-service" Candidate and Non Resident Indians (N.R.I.), or Foreign Nationals (F.N.), or People of Indian Origin (P.I.O.).
- 7.6 The candidate must produce original certificates at the time of interview and a set of attested

photocopy of each of the document as per the list given, which is also annexure to this brochure. The candidate should bring the following documents:

- u **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 OR DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010** Mark list.
 - u Nationality Certificate or valid passport.
 - u Proof of age (Date of Birth)
 - u Statement of MBBS marks of 1st MBBS, 2nd MBBS, Third MBBS, Part I and Part II exams. for MD/MS/Diploma courses & Statement of BDS marks of 1st BDS, 2nd BDS, Third BDS, Final BDS exams for MDS courses.
 - u MBBS / BDS Degree / Passing certificate.
 - u Internship Completion Certificate OR Certificate indicating the likely date of completion of Internship.
 - u Registration Certificate of MCI/DCI / State Council.
 - u Receipt cum Identity Card.
 - u Admit Card.
- 7.7 In case any candidate is unable to appear in person on a notified date, he/she can send his/her authorized representative with an undertaking and authority letter for selection (Annexure "D"). The decision taken by the representative will be final, binding and irreversible.
- 7.8 The registration once granted is valid only if the teacher and the Dean / University are satisfied about regularity, diligent persuasion of studies by the student as well as good conduct.
- 7.9 Candidate selected for admission shall be subject to the Rules of the University/Institution/Government and management.
- 7.10 A candidate selected for Postgraduate Degree/Diploma course will not be allowed change of subject.
- 7.11 A candidate who reports late due to any reason during the selection process will be considered for allotment of a seat available at the time of reporting. Under no circumstances, the candidate who reports late shall be considered for allotment of seat which was previously available to him/her as per his/her merit position.
- 7.12 In case of dispute in the matter of allotment of seat/course or any other matter pertaining to the provisional selection or cancellation of admission, the decision of the competent authority shall be final and binding.
- 7.13 A candidate will have to deposit his/her all relevant original certificates, documents along with the complete tuition fees at the time of admission failing which admission will be cancelled.
- 7.14 The counseling and admission session for **Merit Seats** will be held on **3.4.10 from 12.30 PM.** and for **Management Seats** will be held on **3.4.10 from 3.30 PM. at Camp Office, Sawangi (Meghe) Wardha. For MS/MD/ Diploma courses.**
- 7.15 The counseling and admission session for **Merit Seats** will be held on **5.4.10 from 12.30 PM.** and for **Management Seats** will be held on **5.4.10 from 3.30 PM. at Camp Office, Sawangi (Meghe) Wardha. For MDS courses**
- 7.16 Only candidates and one parent/guardian will be allowed in the hall where counseling will be held. The candidates will be called in the order of their merit and offered the seats available at that point of time. The candidates will be permitted to choose any of the seats available when his/her turn comes.
- 7.17 When all the seats in a given course are filled, admission of students to that course will instantaneously cease and Competent Authority DMIMS(DU) will not be responsible for non availability of the seats and non allotment to the rest of the candidates.
- 7.18 The choice of the course made by the candidates will be final and binding and will not be altered later under any circumstances except upgradation in the second round as per merit of the candidate will be permitted.
- 7.19 Failure to attend the counseling or pay the fees at the time of admission or failure to submit all the necessary documents in original may result in automatic forfeiture of the claim of the candidates for the selection or cancellation of admission subsequently.
- 7.20 The selected candidates will have to join the course as full time Resident/Student at the given date.

If he fails to join by the stipulated date his / her admission will automatically be cancelled and he will not be entitled for any refund of fees and will be required to pay the fees for the entire duration of the course he has taken admission.

8 TIE-BREAKER

Determination of the Inter-se merit of candidates obtaining equal marks at **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010**. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the **DMIMS(DU) AIPGM CET 2010 & DMIMS(DU) AIPGD CET 2010**, the inter-se merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of preference as under:-

- 8.1. The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at First, Second, Third MBBS - Part I & II or BDS Examinations taken together shall be preferred. If the tie still persists then.
- 8.2 The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Third MBBS (Part I & II) or Final BDS Examination would be preferred. If the tie still persists.
- 8.3 The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at IIInd MBBS or IIIrd BDS Examination will be preferred. If the tie still persists then.
- 8.4 An older candidate will be preferred over a young candidate.

9. CANCELLATION AND REFUND

In terms of the Public Notice F.No.1-3/2007(CPP-II) dated 23rd April, 2007 from the University Grants Commission, New Delhi and as decided in the meeting of the Board of Management held on 29th June, 2007; a student who is admitted through counseling and is desirous of withdrawing / canceling his admission to the course before the start of the concerned course, an amount of Rs. 1,000/- towards processing charges will be deducted from the total fees deposited by the student and rest of the fees shall be refunded to student alongwith his original certificates.

If a student withdraws / cancels his admission after joining the course but before the last date of admission prescribed in this regard and if such vacant seat is filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, then the fees paid shall be proportionately deducted for the period the student has attended the college alongwith proportionate deduction of hostel fees and the balance fee alongwith original certificate will be returned to the student.

Important - If a candidate admitted to PG programme, leaves the course at any time after 31.05.2009, the candidate shall be required to pay the full amount of Tution Fees and Other Fees for the remaining entire duration of the PG course as no admission is permissible against such resultant vacancy.

10. DISCIPLINE

10.1 Any candidate / authorized representative or accompanying person is found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner / creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the Competent Authority in this respect shall be final and binding.

10.2 A candidate selected shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the University.

11. UNDERTAKING AND BOND

A candidate selected for Postgraduate course will be required to submit a bond **of Rs. 2 Lacs** in the form of refundable fixed deposit of Rs.2 Lacs in the name of the University to serve the Institution for one year after passing University examination if required by the University, failing which security deposit will be forfeited.

11.1 In-service candidate will be required to execute a bond as per rules of the Institution/ University.

12. LEGAL JURISDICTION

All dispute pertaining to the conduct of examination and selection process shall fall within the jurisdiction of Nagpur bench of Mumbai High court at Nagpur.

13. All admissions made are provisional.

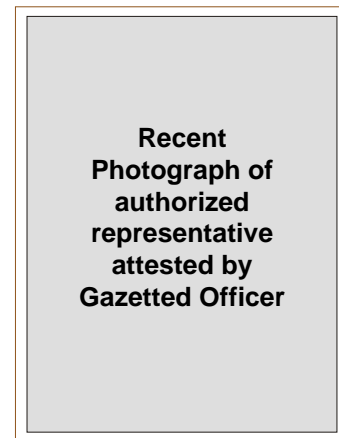
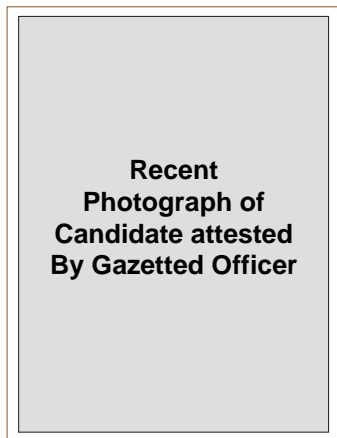

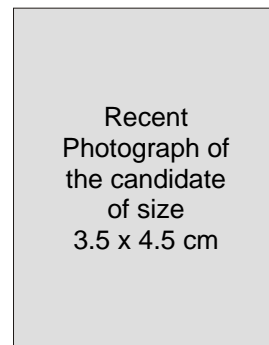
