CLARIFICATION

In pursuance to Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of PA Inamdar V/s State of Maharashtra and Others 2005 (6) SCC 537. The absolute right is granted to Private Medical & Dental Colleges to Admit the Students.

In the meanwhile, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the aforesaid Judgment at this stage all the seats in the constituent Medical Colleges will be done as per MGM – PG – CET – 2009 merit only.

The programme mentioned in this brochure is applicable to the admissions to be given for the Academic year 2009 at the constituent Medical Colleges of MGM University for Post Graduate Medical courses.

However, it is made ample clear that after publication of this brochure any Legislation or Judgment by any court of law, then the MGM University will abide by the appropriate order / Judgment, reserving its right to challenge and without prejudices to any rights in the PA Inamdar's Case (supra).

The MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai established u/s 3 of UGC Act, 1956 vide HRD Notification No. F.9-21/2005-U.3(A) dt.30-8-2006, here in after referred to as “MGM University”.

MGM – PG – CET – 2009
Post Graduate Common Entrance Test – 2009

1. Application

- 1.1. Candidates desirous to seek admission to post-graduate medical (Degree / Diploma) courses are required to appear for MGM- PG-CET-2009 announced by the MGM University.
- 1.2. Information Brochure along with blank application form is available at the University office and at notified centers on payment in cash of **Rs. 2000/-** or by D.D. **Rs. 2500/-** drawn in favour of “MGM University “ payable at Mumbai drawn on any nationalised / scheduled bank.
- 1.3. The examination fee for MGM – PG – CET – 2009 is **Rs. 3000/-** which shall be paid by D.D. in favour of “ MGM University “ payable at Mumbai drawn on a nationalised / scheduled bank to be submitted with the application form.
- 1.4. No original documents to be attached with the application form.
- 1.5. Candidate should fill up the application form carefully and submit the same on or before **5.01.2009** or with a late fee of **Rs. 1500/-** up to **12.01.2009** to MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai only.
- 1.6. The candidate applying for NRI category shall have to pay **US \$ 50** for form fee and **US \$ 100** towards exam fee.
- 1.7. Candidate should keep one photocopy of duly filled application form for future reference and should quote application No. in future correspondence with MGM University.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. A candidate who has passed final MBBS Examination from a recognized Medical College included in the schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and who has obtained permanent registration either from the Medical Council of India or Maharashtra Medical Council or any other State Medical Council after completing one-year compulsory rotating internship will be eligible to appear for MGM – PG – CET – 2009.
- 2.2. The permanent MCI / MMC / Other State Council registration is a condition precedent for appearing at MGM – PG – CET – 2009 and its proof including submission of application for registration should be enclosed.
- 2.3. A candidate who has completed one year compulsory Internship or is likely to complete the same on or before 31st March 2009 can appear for MGM – PG – CET – 2009.

- 2.4. Candidates likely to complete their internship on or before **31/03/2009** should submit documentary proof from their Principals / Dean of the college regarding the likely date of completion of internship.
- 2.5 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing / completed the PG Course are not eligible for appearing at MGM-PG-CET-2009. Candidate who has completed or pursuing PG Diploma is eligible to appear for MGM-PG-CET-2009 for PG Degree in the same subject only and likely to complete before the date of reporting.

3. ADMIT CARD

- 3.1. The admit cards will be sent by post / courier on the addresses of candidates before **19.01.2009**. In case the candidate do not receive the card by **24.01.2009**, he / she may collect duplicate admit card from MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai OR from respective his / her examination centre.
- 3.2. Admit card only authorizes the candidate to enter the examination hall & appear for MGM – PG – CET – 2009. It does not imply that the candidate satisfies all the requirements of eligibility conditions of admission
- 3.3. In case the admit card is lost, it shall be obligatory on the part of candidate to procure duplicate admit card by paying fees **Rs. 500/-** from the office of the Center Incharge not later than one hour before the commencement of examination on production of receipt cum identity card / sufficient evidence to prove that his / her bonafide.
- 3.4. Candidates are requested to send two self-addressed envelopes of size 20 cm x15 cm with postal stamps of Rs. 50/- pasted.

4. CONDUCT OF MGM – PG – CET – 2009

- 4.1. MGM – PG – CET – 2009 will be conducted on **Sunday 22nd February 2009** between 1:30 PM to 5:00 PM.(tentative)
- 4.2. Examination will be conducted at three centers
- Mumbai
 - Aurangabad
 - Noida (UP)

The detail addresses of examination centres with phone numbers will be available on website. The students are advised to visit our website – **www.mgmuhs.com** regularly for updated information pertaining to MGM-PG-CET-2009.

- 4.3. The examination will be conducted in English.
- 4.4. MGM – PG – CET – 2009 Examination paper will be of three hours duration containing 300 multiple-choice questions (MCQ). Questions will be of single best response objective type with four-answer options. Each correct response shall be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answer. Scratching, overwriting, tick marks and multiple answers will be considered as wrong answer and no marks will be awarded to them.
- 4.5. The Common Entrance Test shall be of the standard of MBBS Examination and shall cover all the subjects of MBBS Course. The tentative number of questions of each subject will be as given below:

5. RESULTS AND MERIT LIST

- 5.1. The results & merit list will be displayed on the website of MGM University on the date declared as per schedule.
- 5.2. The statement of Marks indicating marks obtained and merit number of the candidate will be sent by post / courier.
- 5.3. There will be rechecking / revaluation of the answer sheets. However, the candidate may apply for verification of marks on or before **28.02.2009** in a prescribed form along with fee of **Rs. 2000/-** to be paid by D.D. in favour of “ **MGM University**” payable at Mumbai drawn on any Nationalised / scheduled bank. The candidate shall be provided photocopy of the answer sheet and model answer key after verification by the University authority.
- 5.4. The candidate who wants duplicate marks sheet will have to apply to MGM University with a payment of fee of **Rs. 1000/-** by D.D. Drawn in favour of “ MGM University “ payable at Mumbai.
- 5.5. In case of any typographical error in the mark sheet e.g. name, age, sex, category etc. representation should be submitted within 24 hours, from the date of distribution of mark sheet by fax to MGM University, Mumbai.
- 5.6. To be eligible for selection to Medical Postgraduate courses a candidate must secure not less than 50% Marks at MGM – PG – CET – 2009.
- 5.7. Determination of the Inter-se merit of candidates obtaining equal marks. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the MGM – PG – CET – 2009 the inter-se merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of preference as under:
 - 5.7.1. The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at First, Second and Third MBBS Examination (Part I & II) taken together shall be preferred. If the tie still persists.
 - 5.7.2. The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Third MBBS Examination (Part I & II) will be preferred. If the tie still persists.
 - 5.7.3. The candidate with more aggregate marks (convert into percentage) at second MBBS examination will be preferred. If the tie still persists.
 - 5.7.4. An older candidate will be preferred over a younger candidate.

6. SELECTION PROCESS

- 6.1. The selection to a course / college will be made as per Merit cum preference given by the candidate. The selection process shall be as follows:
 - 6.1.1. The preference form is provided with brochure. The duly filled preference form should be submitted at the office of Registrar before the last date prescribed in the scheduled of MGM-PG-CET-2009.
 - 6.1.2. The candidate should submit only one preference form. Submission of more than one form may lead to disqualification.
 - 6.1.3. The Dean of the constituent college or a responsible officer of MGM University will countersign the preference form duly filled in by the candidate.
 - 6.1.4. The selection will be on the basis of merit and the preference submitted by the candidate in their preference form.
 - 6.1.5. The choice of Course & College once entered in the preference form shall be final and irrevocable. The final data shall be used in the entire selection process for admission to PG Courses for the academic year 2009-10.
 - 6.1.6. The candidates who have filled in preference forms but are not selected in the first round are eligible for vacant seat(s) in the subsequent round.
 - 6.1.7. For filling of vacant seats after first round, same preference form will be considered and no separate preference form will be required to be filled in by the candidate.

- 6.2. The candidate shall have to appear personally and must produce original certificates at the time of admission and a set of attested photocopy of each of the document as per the list given below:
- Nationality Certificate or Valid Passport.
 - Proof of Age.
 - Statement of MBBS marks of 1st year, 2nd year Final year (Part I and Part II Exams).
 - MBBS Degree / Passing certificate.
 - Attempt Certificate of all University Examinations.
 - Internship completion certificate.
 - Permanent Registration certificate of MMC / State Council / MCI.
 - Receipt cum Identity card.
 - Bonafied Certificate.
- 6.3. In case a candidate unable to appear due to unforeseen circumstances, authorized representative by the candidate may appear on behalf of the student with duly filled and signed authority letter of the candidate. The authorized representative as defined in the rules and regulation of MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai could be only blood relative (mother / father/ elder brother/ elder sister/ elder sister in law/ elder brother in law)
- 6.4. Canvassing directly or indirectly for the allotment of seat would disqualify the candidate for admission. Influencing the staff by unfair means will lead to cancellation of allotted seat and such candidate will also face disqualification for appearance in the subsequent MGM – PG – CET.
- 6.5. The registration once granted is valid only if the teacher and the Dean are satisfied about regularity, diligent persuasion of studies by the student as well as good conduct.
- 6.6. Candidate selected for admission shall be subject to disciplinary rules of the University / Institution.
- 6.7. A candidate selected for Postgraduate Degree / Diploma course will not be allowed for change of course / College / Institute on mutual basis.
- 6.8. In case of dispute in the matter of allotment of course/institution or any other matter pertaining to the provisional selection or cancellation of admission, the decision of the University shall be final and binding.
- 6.9. Status Retention of Admissions: After selection in first / subsequent rounds if the candidate desires to retain the same selection (Course & College) and does not want to take any further betterment then he/she can do so by filling “Status Retention Form “ in a prescribed Proforma given in Brochure of Preference System. Status Retention Form is to be submitted to the MGM University through the College where he/she is admitted. However candidate should note that his/her name would be deleted from the further selection process for the academic year 2009-10.
- 6.10. To confirm the admission, the candidate shall have to deposit his/her tuition fee together with all-relevant original certificates, documents on day of counseling. The details of payment of fees will be communicated to the candidates before the counseling.

7. PROCESS FOR FILLING VACANT SEATS

- 7.1. After first round, the vacant seats will be filled. For these seats, the selected as well as not selected candidates who have filled the preference form are eligible. For this process MGM – PG – CET – 2009 merit list will be operated from merit number 1 onwards. The candidate selected in round one will be considered for betterment in the subsequent selection process. “Betterment” means the higher preference exercised by the candidate. The shift in such betterment shall be compulsory and mandatory, except as provided in Para 6.9.
- 7.2. The university authority will issue notification which will be displayed on the website of University indicating the dates of subsequent selection process if the seats remain vacant. There will not be any separate communication to the students for subsequent selection process.
- 7.3. The following candidates will not be held eligible for subsequent admission process.
 - 7.3.1. Accepting registration but not reporting to the College and / or not paying the fees in prescribed time as per 6.10.
 - 7.3.2. Reporting to the college not attending the residency programme regularly.
 - 7.3.3. Unauthorized absence during the residency.
 - 7.3.4. Paying the fees but not attending the residency.
 - 7.3.5. If the admission given by the University is cancelled by the Dean as a disciplinary action / defaulter.
 - 7.3.6. If postgraduate registration given by the University is cancelled by the candidate.
- 7.4. If the candidate offered admission as per his/her order of preferences refuse to accept admission then he / she will not be consider for next round of counseling even for final round against vacant seats.

8. CANCELLATION AND REFUND OF FEE

- 8.1. Candidate who has confirmed his/her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the concerned Dean.
- 8.2. Candidate canceling his/her admission after **3/05/2009** will not be eligible for subsequent two years of MGM – PG – CET
- 8.3. A refund claim may be admitted on merits after due consideration of the request through the institution, in accordance to the regulation prescribed for the purpose by the University.
- 8.4. No candidate will be allowed to take their original certificates for any reason. If for some purpose the applicant insists on taking the original certificates for a period, they need to pay the tuition fees of the remaining years in advance.
- 8.5. Security Deposit is refundable after the completion of the course or candidates leaving the course for any other reason.
- 8.6. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the waitlisted candidates will be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than **Rs. 1000/-** (one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student / candidate withdrawing from the programme. If a student leave after joining the course and if the seat consequently falling vacant has been filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the Institution will return the fee collected with proportionate deduction of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable.

- 8.7. If the candidate residing in the hostel, withdrawing admission after commencement of the course, the institution shall deduct one term fee for the hostel and mess.
- 8.8. If the candidate withdrawing admission after cut of date or 31.05.2009 then no refund is permissible and candidate shall have to pay the tuition fee for total duration of the course.
- 8.9. The fees paid other than above shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

9. DISCIPLINE:

- 9.1. Any candidate / authorized representative or accompanying person is found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner / creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the University in this respect shall be final and binding.
- 9.2. All candidates selected shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the Institution & University.

10. UNDERTAKING AND BOND:

Candidate selected for Postgraduate course will be required to execute a bond with 2 sureties of Rs. Fifteen Lac each with a promise to serve the Institution for 3 years, if required, failing which the bond amount will be recovered from the candidate /sureties.

11. LEGAL JURISDICTION:

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of examination and selection process shall fall within the jurisdiction of Bombay High Court bench at Mumbai only.

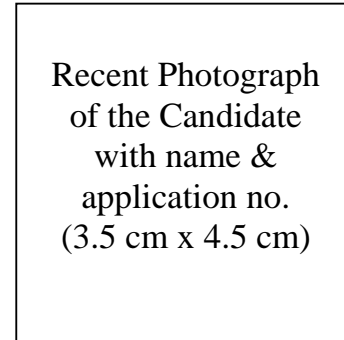

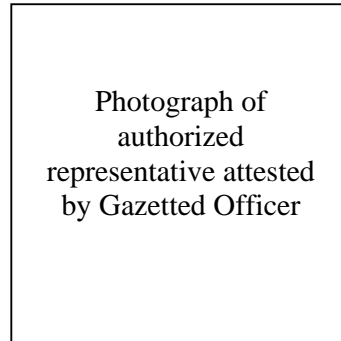
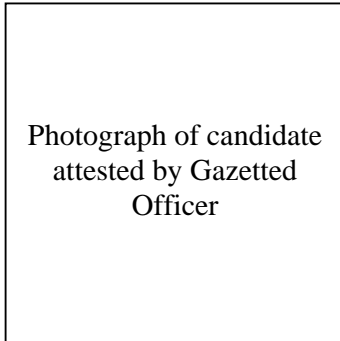
