My Dear Student,
Good day.

We would like to let you know a brief outline of the profession, which you are planning to enter.

What is Medicine?

Studying medicine is much more than just getting your MBBS degree and becoming a doctor: medicine is a vocation and a way of life. It's about thinking of others and putting your patients first - very much a caring profession. So you'd better be sure that you really like people! It is challenging and demanding, of course, but highly rewarding and also provides its own support system, otherwise known as your colleagues (a source of life-long friendships).

It's also about variety: don't choose medicine if you like a set routine! Variety means that you can choose from different types of workplaces, from a GP's clinic to a hospital ward, a lab, the operating theatre or even a university. Even as a student you're always moving on to new hospitals, people and specialisms. Variety also obviously means that patients come in all sorts of shapes and sizes, with all manners of illnesses – and, of course, personalities. Which means that medicine is also about communication: with colleagues, patients, relatives and so on (don't forget that this also includes listening).

Medicine is about teamwork – doctors work with a host of other professionals and have to be co-operative (or everyone loses out); you'll work with other doctors, nurses, pharmacists, physios, surgeons, lab technicians and plenty more.

If you think medicine is just like being on the set of TV serial then think again, long and hard. To start with, it is very hard work, and not just because of those well-publicized long hours: it's also incredibly intense. A surgeon, for example, doesn't just perform operations; he also diagnoses what's wrong with a patient, supports and counsels them and, when they get the odd moment, also trains staff. The ultimate in multi-tasking ! And don't assume that your patients will necessarily thank you for all your care and attention. Sick people (and their relatives) can be difficult and sometimes downright rude (usually due to stress); on the other hand they are often incredibly grateful and sometimes buy you chocolates. It's not glamorous and definitely not the career for you if you flinch at the mere mention of blood, let alone other bodily fluids. Plus there can be lots of distinctly un-medical admin work, form filling and so on. Then there is the constant learning and generally updating your knowledge: not many professions have you sitting exams well into your thirties and forties, but as a doctor you will have to. Medicine changes rapidly and doctors can't just sit back and base all your work on what you learnt twenty-five year's earlier.

Most doctors, however, will say that despite all the challenges, the thrill of the white coat never leaves you: medicine is exciting, interesting and satisfying – diagnosing and recommending treatments which (hopefully) work is intrinsically rewarding. Finally, studying medicine is fun – medics are famous on campus for their social life: a quick glance at the list of sports and activities they run will show that they work hard and play even harder.

Why study Medicine? What can I do afterwards?

A medicine degree really does guarantee you a job for life in the medical field, although your degree is not the end of your training (did you realize that it can take up to 15 years before you can practice completely independently? – quite reassuring given that people's lives are involved). Medicine gives you financial security, though it's true you might earn more – with less responsibility – in any business, IT job etc.

You'll acquire a range of useful skills :

- Communication – if you cannot talk to your fellow human beings you will never make it as a doctor – sorry!
- Clinical skills – you'll of course get to be adept at taking a history from patients, examining them and performing life saving procedures.
- Team – working ability – if you can't manage this you won't succeed.
- Leadership skills & Time management – you will learn how to lead a team and management of time too!
- Problem solving and critical decision – making skills – you'll use evidence from lots of sources to work out the best solution to all sorts of problems, often literally matters of life and death.
- Determination and staying power – absolutely vital!

Will I enjoy Medicine?

- Aren't afraid of hard work
- Are a naturally motivated, enthusiastic person with high aspirations
- Really enjoy learning and generally finding things out
- Are the sort of person everyone (your friends, teachers, family and even complete strangers) says would be a good doctor.
- Are as happy working in a team as on your own.
- Are a good listener – do others plague you with their problems? That's a good sign.
- Are fully aware of all the realities (good and bad) of being a doctor.
- Enjoy having a healthy social life!

- 1.1 As per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment, all admissions to First Year MBBS Course (Except admissions of NRI/ PIO / FN) shall be done on the basis of inter se merit of the candidates in the MGM-CET-2009 conducted by MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai.
- 1.2 The Candidates belonging to Foreign Nationals / Persons of Indian Origin/ NRI Category are exempted from MGM-CET-2009.
- 1.3 MGM-CET-2009 examination will be objective in nature. A question paper containing 200 multiple-choice questions, 50 each on Physics & Chemistry and 100 on Biology (Botany & Zoology) based on the model syllabus. Each Correct answer will get one mark. There is no negative marking for wrong answer. This examination will be of 3 hours duration.

- 2.10 "NRI" means Non Resident Indians
- 2.11 "PIO" means Person of Indian Origin
- 2.12 "Registrar" means Registrar of MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai
- 2.13 "SSC" means Secondary School Certificate
- 2.14 "Qualifying Examination" Means examination on the result of which candidate becomes eligible to apply for MGM-CET-2009
- 2.15 "UPC" means Under Certificate of Posting

3. ELIGIBILITY

A candidate will be held eligible for admission to 1st MBBS for the academic year 2009-10 in the constituent colleges on the fulfillment of following eligibility conditions:

- 3.1 The candidate must be an Indian National

fulfill the eligibility conditions listed at 3.4 & 3.5 above, at the time of admission counseling.

- 3.7 The eligibility conditions may vary in accordance with judicial pronouncements and the university will make appropriate communications from time to time on its official website www.mgmuhs.com
- 3.8 The candidate must secure not less than 50% marks at MGM-CET-2009.

4. EXAMINATION: MGM- CET-2009

4.1 SCHEDULE

4.2 NATURE OF EXAMINATION

The MGM-CET-2009 will consist of one common question paper in the subject of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) consisting of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) in Physics, 50 MCQs in Chemistry & 100 MCQs in Biology. There is no choice among the questions. The candidate is expected to attempt all the 200 questions.

4.2.1 The Candidate will be required to mark the correct answer by blackening the corresponding circle against the serial number of the question, in the answer sheet with **black ballpoint pen only**. Out of four circles provided for selection of answer against a question, the candidate should fill up one circle only. Each correct answer will be given one mark. **There shall be no negative marking for wrong answer**. Scratching, overwriting, tick marking & multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks will be allotted to them.

4.3 SYLLABUS

Syllabi of Physics, Chemistry & Biology for CET shall be the same for HSC (10+2) or equivalent examination. For the sake of clarity, the syllabi is available on the web site www.mgmuhs.com

4.4 Language of Examination:

The medium for this examination shall be English only.

- 10.1. University fees, Hostel fees and such other fees shall be charged extra
- 10.2. The course fees, registration fees and caution deposit should be paid by a single demand draft drawn in favour of "MGM University".

RAGING: PREVENTION & PUNISHMENT

(As per committee constituted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, India in SLP No 24295 of 2006)

Raging has been recognized as a criminal offence, hence would be very seriously taken at constituent units of MGM University of Health Sciences. The students alleged by the juniors for raging act shall have to abide by the punishment as per the recommendation of Anti Raging committee / guidelines of Anti raging Act prescribed by committee constituted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, India in SLP No 24295 of 2006.

Broadly raging has been defined and categorized in following way for which various terms of punishment prescribed as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No 24295 of 2006 ranging from one year imprisonment and fine to up to 7 years rigorous imprisonment and fine.

Following shall treated as Act of Ragging

1. *Verbal – Where senior causes mental harassment, discomfort for the junior by forcing him / her to answer unacceptable / personal questions, dancing etc is said to rag the junior. It also includes within its ambit cyber ragging*
Punishment: 1 year imprisonment or fine or both
2. *Severe verbal ragging- where the mental harassment, discomfort is to such an act as forces the junior to withdraw from the college.*
Punishment : 7 year imprisonment with fine
3. *Physical – Any act by the senior towards the junior which inflicts bodily injury on the junior . Like beating the junior, hitting him/her with objects etc.*
Punishment : 7 year imprisonment with fine
4. *Sexual ragging – where the senior asks the junior to do an act which damages sexual dignity of the junior.*
Punishment : 7 year rigorous imprisonment and fine

It is learnt that an enactment of anti ragging act is pending with amendment in IPC, hence till such time there is an institutional authority at MGM University of Health Sciences whereby the institutions shall be competent authority to initiate appropriate measures to check ragging. Following are some of the guidelines for information to junior students to remember in case, they are subjected to any act of ragging (definition of Ragging as per 1 to 4 of above).

1. The complainant can report orally or in writing either to the Dean, Head of the department any teacher or non-teaching staff of the institution or to the members of Anti Ragging committee constituted as specific body to deal with menace of ragging.
2. Any cases of ragging where such act of ragging is witnessed by teacher, non-teaching staff or the administrative staff, shall be treated as the evidence without any further proof and will be enough to initiate appropriate action against the alleged students of the college.
3. There is a specific body comprises of faculty members, non-teaching and administrative staff as well as senior staff whose contact number can be obtained from the students section, Dean, Registrar to look into the ragging cases. Following shall be procedure for trial of alleged students of ragging cases.
 - a. On receipt of complaint from any students, there shall be immediate suspension from the hostel/college.
 - b. Institutional Enquiry which shall be concluded and submit its report in 24 hours of the complaint with recommendation for punishment.
 - c. Written compliant to the police as FIR
 - d. Expulsion from the College
 - e. Endorsement of remark in College Leaving Certificate/Migration Certificate
4. All the Students are requested to Join the institutional authorities for prevention and monitor ragging cases as there is need for collective responsibility of each and every one at the institutional level.
5. All the students must note that At MGM institutions, the cases of ragging are dealt on a fast tract basis within specific time-frame.
6. There will be periodic review of the instruments and mechanism laid down by the university & medical college in order to plug the loopholes and find other solution if necessary. Hence active participation of all the fresher to join MGM Institution efforts against ragging mandatory.

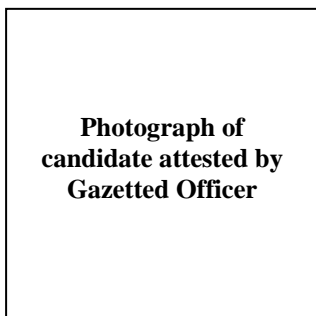

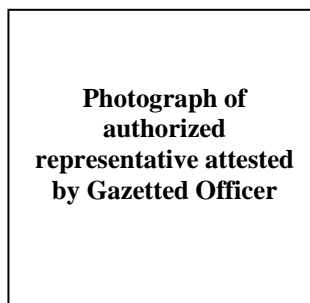
