CLARIFICATION

The Hon'ble Supreme Court (Bench of Hon. 7 judges) has delivered a judgment on 12/8/2005 in Civil Appeal No.5041/2005 in SLP (C) No.9932/2004 in respect of 'rights and entitlement' of Government as against Private Professional Educational Institutions (including Private Medical Colleges conducting graduate and postgraduate medical and dental courses). This judgment expects enactment of legislation by Central Government and in its absence, by State Government in this regard. This process has been initiated. However it is not certain, as of this date, as to when such legislation will come into force, as also its provisions.

In the meanwhile, in terms of the observations of the Hon'ble Supreme Court from the aforesaid judgment, at least at this stage, it appears that State Government cannot claim any quota/seats in these colleges/institutions and consequently cannot effect admissions in these Private Medical Colleges/institutions, except to the extent agreed to with certain institutions.

It is therefore made clear that on the aforesaid interpretation and advice given to the State Government, this Brochure will not apply to the admissions to be effected in the academic year 2007-2008 at the Private Medical Colleges/Institutions, in so far as postgraduate courses are concerned, with the above exception.

However, it is made expressly clear that if, after issuance of this Brochure, either on account of any legislation or on account of any different interpretation/opinion/advice or due to any judgment/order passed by any court of law or even otherwise, the State Government is found entitled to any seat(s) in the Private Medical/Dental Colleges/Intuitions and consequently entitled to effect the admission(s) to such seat(s), the rules and regulations set out in this Brochure will be made applicable to such seat(s) and admission(s). In such event, a separate intimation will be issued with appropriate details.

It is also made hereby clear in no uncertain terms that the same 'Common Entrance Test' (CET) that is proposed to be conducted in terms of this Brochure will govern such admission(s), if any.

**PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION AND ADMISSION TO
POST-GRADUATE DEGREE COURSE IN DENTISTRY
MASTER OF DENTAL SURGERY (MDS)**

1. INTRODUCTION:

The Director, Medical Education & Research, Mumbai has been declared as the Competent Authority by Govt. of Maharashtra vide Government Resolution No.PGM-1006/2742/CR-301/06/Edu-2, dated 20th September, 2006 for conducting PGD-CET 2007 and selection of candidates for admission to various dental postgraduate courses (MDS) for the year 2007-2008.

- i) The brochure for PGD-CET 2007 contains a single application form & manual form for Entrance examination as well as for admission to various dental postgraduate courses (MDS) subject to eligibility criteria. It also contains details for admission process.
- ii) Definitions:
 - a) **“Appropriate Authority”** means the Government of Maharashtra.
 - b) **“Approved Institution”** means the hospital, affiliated college recognised by the DCI and Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik (MUHS) as an institution in which postgraduate Degree courses in dentistry are available.
 - c) **‘Designated Authority’** means authority responsible to carry out the instructions given by the Competent Authority in respect of selection and admission process for postgraduate medical courses.
 - d) **“Central Government”** means the Government of India.
 - e) **“Competent Authority”** means the authority appointed by the Government for the purpose of conduct of common entrance test for selection and admission to postgraduate degree courses in Dentistry.
 - f) **“Course”** means 3 years degree course leading to MDS degree in various subjects.
 - g) **“Internship”** means the compulsory rotating internship to be completed as per rules of Dental Council of India (DCI) and Maharashtra State Dental Council (MSDC) and concerned University.
 - h) **“Dental Council of India (DCI)”** means the Dental Council of India established under Dentist Act, 1948.
 - i) **“PGD-CET Cell”** means postgraduate dental common entrance test cell constituted for the purpose of conduct of PGD-CET and selection process for postgraduate course in dentistry.
 - j) **“Recognised Qualification”** means the qualification recognised by the Dental Council of India (DCI) and the Universities in the State of Maharashtra.
 - k) **“Registration”** means the registration of the qualification either with the Dental Council of India (DCI) or Maharashtra State Dental Council (MSDC) after completing 1 year compulsory rotating internship.
 - l) **“Reservation”** means the reservation prescribed by the Government for admission to postgraduate courses in dentistry for constitutional reservation for the Backward Classes and Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates.
 - m) **“Postgraduate Teacher”** means the postgraduate teacher who is recognised as a teacher under the regulation of the Dental Council of India (DCI), by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.
 - n) **“University”** means the non-agricultural University constituted under the Maharashtra University Act, 1994 or by MUHS act 1998.

Terms which are used in these rules but not defined above are in consonance with the definition given in Maharashtra University Act, 1994.

2. COMPETENT AUTHORITY:

The Competent Authority will supervise and control the selection process by implementing these procedures through the PGD-CET Cell / Designated Authorities.

The Competent Authority will issue necessary executive instructions for implementation of these procedures and provide relevant information to be published or communicated. The Competent Authority will declare time-table, details of the dates of various processes relating to selection procedure. e.g. sale/ receipt of forms, date of Common Entrance Test, date of counselling for preference form filling etc.

3. APPELLATE COMMITTEE:

Appellate Committee will consist of the following members:

- (i) Competent Authority & DMER, Mumbai- Chairman.
- (ii) Jt. Director (Dental), MER, Mumbai.
- (iii) Dean, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Mumbai.
- (iv) Dean, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Aurangabad.
- (v) Dean, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Nagpur.

The appeal in ordinary course shall lie against allegedly, arbitrary decision or violation of prescribed procedure by PGD-CET cell, Designated Authority or their representatives.

4. DESIGNATED AUTHORITY:

For the purpose of implementation of these procedure following authorities will act as designated authorities for the regions and the districts indicated against the names:

Sr. No.	Name of the Designated Authority
1	Dean, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Mumbai
2	Dean, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Aurangabad
3	Dean, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, Nagpur

The Designated Authority will be responsible to carry out the instructions given by the Competent Authority in respect of Selection and admission process for postgraduate dental courses. Designated Authority may associate other officials to assist them in the selection and admission process.

5. NUMBER OF SEATS & LIST OF POSTGRADUATE COURSES:

The seats available for admission to postgraduate dental courses through PGD-CET will be for all State Government and Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation Dental colleges.

- 5.1 Vacancies arising due to any reason in postgraduate courses after 31/5/2007 shall neither be filled nor be carried forward to the next or subsequent academic years.
- 5.2 The seats available will be filled in on the basis of State Level Merit in PGD-CET. There will be no Regional reservation. However there will be reservation in these seats as per State Government orders issued from time to time (Annexure "C & D").

- 5.3 List of postgraduate degree courses are given in Annexure “A”. The seat position will be given in the preference form filling information brochure and will be displayed on the website of DMER (www.dmer.org).

6. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PGD-CET 2007:

- 6.1 Candidate must be an Indian National. Nationality Certificate issued by District Magistrate or Additional District Magistrate or Chief Metropolitan Magistrate / valid passport shall constitute the proof of nationality.
- 6.2 A candidate, who has passed final B.D.S. degree from a recognised dental college (Annexure-E) included in the schedule of the Dental Council of India and situated in Maharashtra, affiliated to the Non-agricultural University established under Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 and the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and who has obtained permanent registration either from the Dental Council of India or Maharashtra State Dental Council (MSDC) after completing one year compulsory rotating internship will be eligible to appear for PGD-CET. Candidate obtained BDS Degree before introduction of one year compulsory rotating internship training, i.e. on or before 1989 also will be eligible to appear for PGD-CET 2007. Candidate who has obtained BDS degree from Deemed University is not eligible to appear for PGD-CET-2007.
- 6.3 A candidate should have obtained DCI/MSDC registration on or before 15th April, 2007.
- 6.4 A candidate who has completed one year compulsory rotating internship/ and is likely to complete the same on or before 31st March 2007 can appear for PGD-CET.
- 6.5 All such candidates will have to submit the documentary proof, from the Principal / Dean of the college regarding the likely date of completion of internship along with the manual application form, failing which the application shall be rejected.
- 6.6 The candidates who were admitted to the colleges / institutions which are now affiliated to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS) will be eligible till such time as they are awarded the degrees by the University established under Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994.
- 6.7 Candidate who has passed the Final BDS examination of non-agricultural universities in Maharashtra and MUHS only, will be eligible to appear for PGD-CET.
- 6.8 However, the candidate who are domiciled in Maharashtra and who obtained admission under 15% quota for All India Entrance Examination (AIEE) for BDS course and who has obtained the degree from a University situated outside the State of Maharashtra will also be eligible for PGD-CET. Such candidate should submit:
- i) Certificate from the Dean of respective college stating that the candidate was admitted under 15% AIEE quota for BDS course.
 - ii) Certificate of domicile in Maharashtra.
- 6.9 The candidate belonging to Backward Class must have claimed so in his application form, failing which such a claim will not be entertained subsequently. The candidate belonging to Backward Class Category should submit the certified copies of Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (wherever applicable) along with the application.

- 6.10 The candidates belonging to DT(VJ (A)), NT1(B), NT2(C), NT3(D), OBC and SBC categories should have Non-Creamy layer certificate issued by appropriate authority on or after 1/4/2006.
- 6.11 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing/completed the PG degree course or have obtained PG degree, are not eligible for appearing at PGD-CET 2007.
- 6.12 Candidate will be eligible to appear for PGD-CET 2008, if he/she cancels his/her admission of PGD-CET 2007 before 13/5/2007.

7. APPLICATION FORM AND FEES FOR EXAMINATION:

- 7.1 The Information Brochure and Computerised Application form will be available at all Government Dental Colleges (Annexure-B) from 01/12/2006 to 14/12/2006 excluding Sundays and State Government Holidays. The cost of the Information Brochure along with Computerised Application Form of PGD-CET 2007 and Examination Fee is Rs. 1800/- to be paid by Demand Draft/ Pay Order drawn on any scheduled commercial Bank in favour of the **Director, Medical Education and Research, Mumbai**, payable at Mumbai. This amount is not refundable.
- 7.2 Application forms of the candidates shall be received at all the Government Dental Colleges. The applications will be scrutinised by them and shall be submitted with remarks to the Competent Authority. The forms of eligible and ineligible candidates should be submitted in two separate bundles to the Competent Authority. The Designated Authority will be responsible for sale, receipt of application form, scrutiny and determining the eligibility.
- 7.3 Admit Cards will be issued at the Designated Authority where the candidate has submitted his/her application form during 10/01/2007 to 20/01/2007.

8. CONDUCT OF PGD-CET-2007:

- 8.1 All the eligible candidates are required to take the PGD-CET at their own cost.
- 8.2 The PGD-CET will be conducted on **Sunday 21st January, 2007** at 10.00 a.m. **No entry will be permitted to the candidate in the examination hall after 10.00 a.m. for any reasons whatsoever.**
- 8.3 The PGD-CET will be conducted at Mumbai, Nagpur and Aurangabad.
- 8.4 There shall be one paper of 1 1/2 hours duration containing 100 multiple choice questions (MCQs). Questions will be of single best response objective type, with four answer options. Each correct response shall be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Scratching, overwriting, tick mark and multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks will be awarded to them.
- 8.5 The Common Entrance Test shall be of the standard of BDS Examinations and shall cover all the subjects of BDS course. The tentative number of questions of each subject will be as given below:

8.6 The examination will be conducted in English Medium.

9. DECLARATION OF RESULT AND PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST:

- 9.1 The Competent Authority shall conduct PGD-CET, evaluate the answer sheets and prepare the State Merit List.
- 9.2 The Competent Authority will prepare a State Merit List indicating number, name, category, category merit number and marks scored by the candidate. The same will be made available at all Government Dental Colleges in Maharashtra and also on the website of the Directorate of Medical Education & Research, Mumbai "<http://www.dmer.org>"
- 9.3 The statement of marks of the candidates will be dispatched by post/courier on 09/02/2007.
- 9.4 The candidate who wants duplicate mark sheet will have to apply to the Competent Authority with fees of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) which shall be paid by Demand Draft drawn on any scheduled commercial bank in the favour of "Director, Medical Education & Research, Mumbai".
- 9.5 There will be no rechecking/revaluation of the answer sheets. However the candidate can apply for verification of marks to the Competent Authority by 19/2/2007 in prescribed form (Annexure-H) along with fees of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only), which shall be paid by Demand Draft drawn on any scheduled commercial bank in favour of "Director, Medical Education & Research, Mumbai" payable at Mumbai. The candidate will be given photocopy of the answer sheet and model answer key after verification by speed post.
- 9.6 In case of any typographical error in Mark sheet/Merit List, regarding name, age, gender, category etc., representation for correction should be submitted to the Competent Authority within five days from the date of declaration of result.
- 9.7 Final Merit List will be declared on 28/2/2007 on the website of DMER.

10. STATE MERIT LIST:

- 10.1 The Competent Authority will prepare a State Merit List of eligible candidates on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidate at the PGD-CET-2007.
- 10.2 To be eligible for selection to postgraduate course in Dentistry, a candidate belonging to open category must secure not less than 50% marks and candidate belonging to backward class category must secure not less than 40% marks at PGD-CET-2007.

10.3 TIE-BREAKER - Determination of the Inter-se-merit of candidates obtaining equal PGD-CET marks.

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the PGD-CET, the inter-se-merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of preference as under:-

- 10.3.1 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at First, Second, Third and Final B.D.S. examination (Semester-I & II) taken together shall be preferred. If the tie still persists,
- 10.3.2 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Final B.D.S. examination (Semester-I & II) will be preferred. If the tie still persists,
- 10.3.3 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Third B.D.S. examination will be preferred. If the tie still persists,
- 10.3.4 The candidate with higher aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Second B.D.S. examination will be preferred. If the tie still persists,
- 10.3.5 An older candidate will be preferred over a younger candidate.
- 10.3.6 While considering I, II, III and Final BDS marks and aggregate for above purpose, grace and/or NSS marks will not be taken into account.

11. SELECTION PROCESS:

11.1 The selection will be made to a course/college considering his State Merit List Number and the preferences given by the candidates. Candidates as per State Merit Number will be called for counselling and asked to fill the preference form. Counselling will be carried out at Govt. Dental College at Mumbai, in the second week of March 2007. Counselling sessions are not meant for instant seat allocation. During these sessions candidates are assisted in exercising their preferences for various courses and the institutions. Seat allocation shall be made centrally at a later date on the basis of PGD-CET-2007 merit list and preferences exercised by the candidates.

11.2 Selection Process shall be as follows:

- 11.2.1 The candidate should submit only one preference form. Submission of more than one form may lead to disqualification. The preference form shall be available at the office of the Govt. Dental College at Mumbai. The duly filled preference form should be submitted at the same office.
- 11.2.2 The availability of postgraduate seats as per course, college and category will be provided in the information brochure for filling of Preference form and on website www.dmer.org. The selection will be on the basis of merit and the preferences submitted by the candidates in their preference form. For filling of vacant seats after first round, same preference form will be considered and no separate preference form will be required to be filled by the candidate.
- 11.2.3 **For reserved category candidates: Ear-Marking** - Reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of merit in an open category seat will have the option of taking admission either

against his / her respective category seat or on an open category seat. If he / she opts for the reserved category he / she will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as reserved category candidate. One seat in the college where he / she was eligible for admission against open seat shall be earmarked for a candidate belonging to the respective reserved category. Such earmarked seat will be made available immediately to the successive reserved category candidate from the same category merit.

11.2.4 The candidates who have filled in preference form, but are not selected in the first round, are eligible for vacant seats in the subsequent round.

11.2.5 Based on preferences given, the seat will be allotted on merit and the allotment will be displayed on website of DMER i.e. "**www.dmer.org**" and at the office of Designated Authorities i.e. Govt. Dental College of Mumbai, Aurangabad and Nagpur in the first week of April 2007.

11.3 DOCUMENTS:

The candidates must produce original certificates at the time of filling the Preference form / Counselling and a set of attested photocopy of each of the **documents as below:**

- (i) Nationality Certificate / Valid Passport
- (ii) Certificate of Age (SSC Certificate / Valid Passport)
- (iii) First B.D.S. Statement of Marks.
- (iv) Second B.D.S. Statement of Marks.
- (v) Third B.D.S. Statement of Marks.
- (vi) a) Final B.D.S. Sem.-I, Statement of Marks.
b) Final B.D.S. Sem.-II, Statement of Marks.
- (vii) B.D.S. Degree / Passing Certificate
- (viii) Attempt Certificates of University Examinations
- (ix) Internship Completion Certificate / Certificate indicating likely date of completion of Internship.
- (x) Registration Certificate (MSDC/DCI)
- (xi) Medical Fitness Certificate

If applicable

- (xii) Caste Certificate
- (xiii) Caste Validity Certificate
- (xiv) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (for DT[VJ]-[A], NT1(B), NT2(C), NT3(D), OBC & SBC Candidates)
- (xv) (a) Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State in case of candidates who are admitted under 15% quota for All India Entrance Examination and who have obtained their degree from a University situated outside the State of Maharashtra.
(b) AIEE selection letter / letter from Dean stating that the candidate was admitted under 15% quota for All India Entrance Examination.

NOTE: In case of dispute during counselling, the Competent Authority may verify following documents. Therefore candidates should also bring the following documents at the time of counselling:

- 1) Receipt-cum-Identity card.
- 2) Bonafide Certificate from the Dean
- 3) Receipt of enclosures.
- 4) Receipt of the Application Form fee.

- 11.4 At the time of filling the Preference form the candidate should bring all original documents and a set of attested copies of the same in support of claim made in application form e.g. Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate issued by the Scrutiny Committee failing which claim will not be considered. If the matter is still pending with Hon'ble Court, candidate should submit a fresh Court order for PGD-CET 2007, failing which claim will not be granted and the candidate will be considered as Open Category candidate.
- 11.5 The registration once granted is valid only if the teacher and the Dean are satisfied about regularity, diligent pursuance of studies by the student as well as good conduct.
- 11.6 Candidate selected for admission shall be subject to disciplinary rules of the Institution, MUHS, and State Government.
- 11.7 A candidate selected for postgraduate course will not be allowed to change the subject / college / institute on a mutual basis.
- 11.8 In case of dispute in the matter of allotment of seat / course / institution or any other matter pertaining to the provisional selection or cancellation of admission, the decision of the Competent Authority shall be final and binding.
- 11.9 **Status Retention of Admission:** After selection in first/subsequent rounds, if the candidate desires to retain the same selection (subject & college) and does not want to take any further betterment, then he can do so by filling 'Status Retention Form' (Annexure-H) in the prescribed proforma within specified time period after selection which will be notified along with selection list. 'Status Retention Form' is to be submitted to the Competent Authority through the college where he is admitted. However candidate should note that his name will be deleted from the further selection process for the academic year 2007.
- 11.10 **Legal Jurisdiction:** All disputes pertaining to the conduct of examination and selection shall fall within the jurisdiction of courts in Mumbai only.

12. PROCESS FOR FILLING VACANT SEATS

- 12.1 After first round, the vacant seats will be filled. For these seats, the selected as well as not selected candidates who have filled the preference form are eligible. For this process PGD-CET-2007 merit list will be operated from SML number 1 onwards. The candidate selected in round one will be considered for betterment in the subsequent selection process. 'Betterment' means the higher preference exercised by the candidates. The shift in such betterment shall be compulsory and mandatory, except as provided in Para 11.9.
- 12.2 The Competent Authority will issue notification in the news papers, which will also be displayed on notice boards of all Designated Authorities and on DMER website indicating the dates of subsequent selection process.

12.3 The following candidates will not be held eligible for subsequent admission process.

12.3.1 The selected candidate not reporting to the college and / or not paying the fees within stipulated time.

12.3.2 If the admission is cancelled by the Dean/Director as a disciplinary action/defaulters.

12.3.3 If postgraduate admission is cancelled by the candidate.

12.4 Candidates may resign before 13th May 2007, to be eligible for next PGD-CET-2008.

13. THE CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED BY THE CANDIDATE AFTER SELECTION:

13.1 A candidate will have to pay the prescribed fees (i.e. tuition + deposit + others). He/she should deposit all relevant original certificates / documents in the concerned institution.

13.2 All selected candidates will have to submit DD/Pay order of Rs.650/- drawn on any Scheduled Commercial Bank in favour of "**Competent Authority, MH-CET**" payable at Mumbai for Amartya Shikshan Yojana as per GR.MED/100/880/CR-129/Edu-1, dated 13/10/2003.

14. CANCELLATION AND REFUND:

14.1 Candidate who has confirmed his/her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the concerned Dean.

14.2 Candidate cancelling his/her admission on or before 13/5/2007 will be held eligible for subsequent PGD-CET-2008.

14.3 Candidate cancelling his/her admission after 13/5/2007 will not be eligible for subsequent two years for PGD-CET.

14.4 Refund of fees by the College after change of college/ course or cancellation of admission:

a. On or Before 13/5/2007 - Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One Thousand only) to be deducted and rest of the fees to be refunded.

b. After 13/5/2007 - No Refund.

14.5 The refund will only be made after 3 months from the date of application for refund. No correspondence shall be entertained by Competent Authority in this matter.

15. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE:

15.1 Failure of the candidate in making full and correct statements in the application form and/or suppression of any information would lead to disqualification of the candidate, even at later date. Such a candidate will be debarred from the entire selection process.

15.2 It is responsibility of every candidate to submit proper documents. Any attempt to submit documents which are not genuine will lead to cancellation of the admission of the candidate, forfeiture of the fees, deposits and expulsion of the candidate from the college by the Competent Authority or by his authorised official. The name of such candidate/s shall be deleted from the State Merit List and he/she will not be eligible for further rounds of the selection process and will be debarred from the selection process. If deemed fit even criminal proceeding may be initiated by the Competent Authority against such candidates / their parents.

15.3 If any candidate / authorised representative or person accompanying is found obstructing the counselling and / or admission process, or trying to influence in unlawful manner/ creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the Competent Authority in this respect shall be final and binding.

15.4 All candidates selected for admission shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the Institution, MUHS, Nashik and Government.

16. Bond:

16.1 Candidate selected for Postgraduate Course should complete PG studentship, failing which he/she will be required to pay Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh) for the default (i.e. Non Completion of PG Studentship). However this is not applicable to the candidates of PGD-CET 2007 resigning the PG Registration before 13/5/2007.

16.2 All selected candidates will be required to sign a bond with two sureties to serve the Govt. of Maharashtra, local self Government for a period of 2 years, failing which he/she will be required to pay Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) for the default.

17. Any issue not dealt here-in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the Competent Authority.

F	Nomadic Tribes (NT3) (एन टी - ड)	2.0 percent
G	Other Backward Classes (OBC) including SBC	19.0 percent
	Total	50.0 percent

- 2) Candidates belonging to aforesaid Backward Class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate and the Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate.
- 3) Caste certificate issuing authority: - Caste certificate stating that the caste is recognized under a particular backward class category in Maharashtra state is issued by Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra state.
- 4) The Caste/Tribe validity Certificate issuing Authorities are as follows:-
- a) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism, Vimukta Jati, Nomadic Tribes1, 2 & 3 and Other Backward Class, Caste Validity Certificate is issued by **Divisional Caste Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Divisional Social Welfare Office** (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).
- b) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe the Tribe Validity Certificate is issued by Director/Deputy Director, **Tribe Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Region** (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).
- 5) **The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original application form.** The candidate claiming constitutional reservation must submit original **caste validity certificate at the time of counseling for filling preference form, failing which the category claim will not be granted.**

6) **NON-CREAMY LAYER**

A candidate belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the categories (C) to (G) must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him/her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories (C) to (G) above will be required to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the name of parent as specified in the Government resolution No. सीबीसी १०/२००६/प्र.क्र.१५/मावक, दिनांक ३०/६/२००६). The certificate should have been issued **on or after 1st April 2006**. The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate is issued by Sub-Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector/Collector of the district.

However, such a Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be produced in any case on or before the last date of filling up of Preference Form, failing which the category claimed will not be granted.

Applicants belonging to Special Backward Class

N.B.: Hon'ble High Court Mumbai had stayed admission to SBC category as a separate quota and therefore, vide Government Circular from Social Welfare, Cultural Affairs and Sports Department No. CBC-1095/WS/264/BCD-5 dated 24th October 1995, the persons belonging to Special Backward Class (SBC) are to be considered as OBC candidates.

- 7) Inter-se amongst the reserved categories will be operated at the end of each admission process against the unfilled reserved category seats as per merit and choice of the reserved category candidates.

The seats remaining vacant from various categories will be filled in during inter-se admission process as follows:

- a) From among the candidates of their respective group from the Interse State Merit List of that particular group where the vacancies exist.

- (b) If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled, from among the candidates of all the categories mentioned above from the all categories combined merit list.

- (c) If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled from among the candidates of the common merit list.

- 8) **Ear-Marking** : Reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of merit in an open category seat will have the option of taking admission either against his / her respective category seat or on an open category seat. If he / she opts for the reserved category he / she will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as reserved category candidate. One seat in the college where he / she was eligible for admission against open seat shall be earmarked for a candidate belonging to the respective reserved category. Such earmarked seat will be made available immediately to the successive reserved category candidate from the same category merit.

ANNEXURE "D"

Physically Handicapped (PH)

- 1) As per Govt. letter NO. MED-1006/CR-72/06/Edu-2, dated 07/03/2006, three percent of the total available seats in Health Science courses at Government /Corporation /Govt. aided colleges are reserved for the physically handicapped candidates. As per MCI guidelines letter NO.MCI-34(I)/2003-Med/11773, dated 14/07/2003 the physically handicapped candidates should have "locomotory disability of lower limbs ranging between 50-70% only". The Candidate with a disability more than 70% will not be eligible for admission to Health Sciences (Post Graduate) Courses. No other disability shall be allowed as per the MCI guidelines. However, such a candidate will be required to undergo medical examination by a Special Medical Board constituted for this purpose by the Competent Authority. The Medical Board after ascertaining his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course despite his/her disability.
- 2) Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate in prescribed proforma from Civil Surgeon of a District Hospital/Medical Board/Medical Superintendent of a Government Medical College/Hospital in Maharashtra; or from the Director of All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Haji Ali, Mumbai; (as per Prescribed Proforma) at the time of verification of disability. Verification of the disability will be carried out by Special Medical Board constituted for this purpose by Competent Authority. The date and place of Special Medical Board shall be communicated to the concerned candidates telegraphically and by the way of notification on the website i.e. www.dmer.org

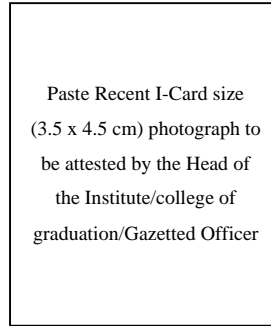
