Important Instructions To Candidates

1. Candidate must preserve the Receipt and Admit card safely and bring to the examination hall and produce the same on demand by the examination staff.
2. Candidate should be present in the examination hall at least Thirty minutes before examination begins.
3. All details like Roll Number, Question Booklet Number and Version AA, BB, CC or DD must be entered carefully on the answer sheet and the question booklet.
4. No candidate will be allowed to leave the exam hall in the middle of the exam.
5. In case of loss of Admit card, it shall be obligatory on the part of the candidate to procure duplicate Admit card from the examination centre in-charge not later than one hour before the start of examination with sufficient evidence to prove that he/she is the genuine / bonafide candidate.
6. All entries on answer sheet must be made only with Black ball pen.
7. Please note that admit card is just an enabling provision for appearing Asso CET-2008 and does not imply that the candidate satisfies all the requirements of eligibility conditions of admission.
8. All further correspondence will require quoting of your application number till you received allotted Roll No..

CLARIFICATION

In pursuance of the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in the case TMA Pai Foundation (2002) 8 SCC 481 and P. A. Inamdar v/s State of Maharashtra & others 2005 (6) SCC 537, Unaided Private Medical & Dental Colleges have a right to admit students and to hold Common Entrance Test, Therefore at this stage admissions to all the seats in the Unaided Private Medical & Dental College except NRI seats will be done as per Asso-CET 2008 merit only.

As per the aforesaid judgment there is NRI quota upto 15% at the discretion of the member colleges. Particulars regarding the same will be displayed on the official website of AMUPMDC.

The programme mentioned in this brochure is applicable to the admissions to be given for the Academic year 2008-09 at the Unaided Private Medical, Dental and all Health Science courses.

The Association is conducting Asso-CET 2008 as per the order of the Hon'ble High Court in Review Petition No. 120 of 2006 in Writ petition No 6332 of 2005 dated 10/8/2006.

However, it is made amply clear that after publication of the brochure, if there is any legislation or Judicial pronouncement not in consonance with above referred Judgments of the Apex Court AMUPMDC reserves its right to challenge the same.

1. PREAMBLE

The **Association of Managements of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges, Maharashtra (AMUPMDC)** herein after referred as **Association** was established in 1994 and registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 at No. GBBSD No. 308/1994 dated 30TH March, 1994.

The Association has been formed to consider, deliberate and formulate indicative guidelines related to various aspects of quality education in Medical and Dental fields and to make recommendations regarding matters related to medical /dental education to various authorities and bodies. The Association has always focused on the interests of the society at large and students in particular. The Association in the past decade took up common issues with the State and Central Governments, Universities and Regulatory Bodies such as Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India. The Association is committed to continuing its efforts for improvements in the field of Medical/Dental Education.

A Common Entrance Test (Asso-CET 2008) will be conducted by the **Association** for admissions to Health Science Courses in Private Unaided Medical, Dental, Ayurvedic, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Nursing Colleges (i.e. MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BPh, BTh, BSc-Nursing).

Asso-CET 2008 will be held in the form of multiple – choice questions. The answer sheets are assessed by scanning with the help of computers. The admissions will be on the basis of merit in Asso-CET 2008 conducted by Association.

The brochure for Asso-CET 2008 contains single application form for entrance examination. It also contains Rules for admission and information about Colleges. These Rules are applicable for admission process only for the Academic year 2008-09.

2. COMPETENT AUTHORITY

- 2.1. The Competent Authority appointed by the Association will be available at Association's office as and when required.
- 2.2. The Competent Authority will supervise the conduct of Asso-CET 2008 and also supervise the declaration of Merit List. The Competent Authority will issue necessary instructions for implementation of these rules and provide relevant information to be published and communicated.
- 2.3. The Competent Authority will be Chairperson of the Appeal Committee for representations, queries, complaints etc. of the candidates.

- 2.4. Candidate will receive the Admit Cards (offline & Online) by 20/04/2008. In case the candidate does not receive Admit Card by 20/04/2008 he/she should approach the Association Office for further instructions or check the Web Site.
- 2.5. The candidate is required to preserve the Receipt and Admit Card for all future reference & correspondence.
- 2.6. The candidate shall submit one and only one application form. In case candidate submits more than one application form, he/she shall be disqualified for appearing for Asso-CET 2008.

3. CONDUCT OF COMMON ENTRANCE TEST Asso-CET 2008

- 3.1. Asso-CET 2008 shall be conducted by the Competent Authority appointed by the Association of Managements of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges. Candidates should go through the contents of this Brochure carefully and for any clarification and genuine doubts / difficulties approach the Office of AMUPMDC, Mumbai. Further information, if any, about Entrance Test, will be uploaded and published regularly on the Association website i.e. www.amupmdc.org Students & Parents are requested to visit the website regularly.

Please Note: Association reserves the right to add or delete the examination centers.

Due to unforeseen circumstances during the conduct of Asso-CET 2008 at a Centre(s) like incidence of mass copying, leakage of question paper, entrance of unauthorized persons in the Examination Centres/halls, natural calamities, riots, etc. or any other reason rendering it impossible for the smooth conduct of Asso-CET 2008 the Competent Authority may cancel the examination at such or all centre(s). It shall be further notified on the website of fresh programme for conduct of Asso-CET2008 at such centre(s) only.

- 3.3. Syllabus for the Asso-CET 2008 will be same as of HSC Examination of Maharashtra State Board for the academic year 2008-09 for Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Syllabus will be available on the Website of the Association.

- 3.4. The Asso-CET 2008 will consist of one common question paper in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) consisting of 200 Multiple Choice Question (MCQs) 50 in Physics, 50 in Chemistry & 100 in Biology. There is no choice among the questions. The candidate is expected to attempt all the
- 3.5. 200 questions. Out of four circles provided for selection of answers against a question, the candidate should fill-up one circle only. Each correct answer will be given one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Scratching, overwriting, tick marks, erasers, whiteners & multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks will be awarded to them.
- 3.6. Duration of examination will be of 3 hours. **The medium of examination shall be English Only.**
- 3.7. No candidate will be allowed to appear for Asso-CET 2008 unless he /she holds Admit Card issued by the Competent Authority.

4. ELIGIBILITY

A candidate will be eligible for admission to Health Science Courses i.e. MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BPTth, BOTth, BSc-Nursing for the academic year 2008–09 on fulfillment of the following conditions:

- 4.1. The candidate may be an Indian National / NRI / Foreign National. The candidate is required to produce proof in support of his/her Nationality from a District Magistrate, Additional Magistrate or Metropolitan Magistrate. School Leaving certificate of HSC/12th Std indicating the nationality of the candidate as Indian or Valid Passport also shall be considered as sufficient proof of Nationality.
- 4.2. The candidate must be born on or before 01ST January, 1992 to be eligible to appear for Asso-CET 2008. For admissions to B. Sc Nursing candidate must be born on or before 31st December 1991 as directed by Indian Nursing Council. The Secondary School Certificate (i.e. SSC) or equivalent examination certificate or the certificates of age and nationality endorsing the date of birth will constitute the valid proof.
- 4.3. The candidate must be medically fit and must submit a certificate of medical fitness **Annexure "J"**.
- 4.4. A candidate must have passed the qualifying examination i. e. Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) or equivalent examination (with English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology as subjects). NRI's and Foreign Nationals shall submit eligibility certificate obtained from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

- 4.5. Eligibility Criteria for qualifying Examination for various courses:-
- 4.5.1. For MBBS and BAMS :
- A candidate belonging to open category must have obtained not less than 50% Marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.
- A Candidates belonging to Reserved Category must have obtained not less than 40% Marks Physics, Chemistry & Biology subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.
- 4.5.2. For BDS and B.Sc. Nursing:-
- A candidate belonging to open category must have obtained not less than 50% Marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.
- A Candidates belonging to Reserved Category must have obtained not less than 40% Marks Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English subject taken together at the HSC (or Equivalent) Examination.
- 4.5.3. For BPT, BOT rule no. 5.5.1 and 5.5.2 is not applicable to these course, passing at Std. XII or HSC or equivalent examination is necessary.
- 4.6. No rounding off of the marks secured by the candidate will be done in individual subject or final total while converting marks of the individual subject out of 100 or total marks out of 300. For example, if the total of the marks in three subjects comes to 149 out of 300, percentage comes to 49.66 that will not qualify the candidate.
- 4.7. The candidates who are appearing for the qualifying examination i.e. HSC or equivalent in March/April-2008 are also eligible to appear for Asso-CET 2008, provided they must fulfill the eligibility conditions.
- 4.8. The eligibility conditions may vary in accordance with Judicial Pronouncements and orders issued by appropriate Authorities from time to time.

5. REVALUATION OF HSC / EQUIVALENT MARKS

If the marks of a candidate at HSC (or equivalent) examination have been revised after re-evaluation, the eligibility of the candidate may be altered. The candidate will be permitted to avail the benefit of revised marks subject to his/her representation to the Competent Authority and production of necessary proof to the satisfaction of the Competent Authority. The candidates must note that the Competent Authority will not be responsible for late declaration of result of such re-evaluations or late submissions of proof due to any reason whatsoever and request to consider / reconsider the claim of the candidate arising out of such re-evaluation shall not be entertained.

6. RESERVATIONS (For Maharashtra Candidates Only)

Admission under the constitutional reservation seat will be governed by the Maharashtra Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes, (Vimukt Jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Category (regulation of issuance and verification

of) Caste Certificate Act 2000 (Maharashtra Act No. XXIII of 2001). In this connection Govt. of Maharashtra have issued following notification Annexure "E".

Reservation of Seats for SC/ST/OBC/VJ/NT1/NT2/NT3 will be as per Government notification No MED/-2006/1196/CR206/06 Edu-1(2) dated 24/06/2006. Candidate belonging to Reserved Category will be required to submit the caste certificate and the caste/tribe validity certificate from the appropriate authorities of the Government of Maharashtra.

7. MARKSHEET

- 7.1. The candidate will receive the mark sheet by post "Under Certificate of Posting" within a week of declaration of result and also online, if application is made online..
- 7.2. The mark sheets will contain details regarding marks obtained by the candidate and their merit ranking.
- 7.3. **Duplicate Mark Sheet:** In case of loss of original Asso-CET 2008 Mark Sheet, a duplicate Mark Sheet can be obtained on making an application on plain paper to the Competent Authority, AMUPMDC along with a DD of Rs. 1000/- in favour of AMUPMDC payable at Mumbai.

8. VERIFICATION OF MARKS

The answer sheets of Asso-CET 2008 examination will be assessed by scanning with the help of computer. If the candidate wishes to verify the Answer sheet a written representation in prescribed Proforma (Annexure E) should be submitted to the Competent Authority within 5 days (up to 20/06/2008) of declaration of results along-with DD of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of AMUPMDC payable at Mumbai. The candidate will be given photocopy of the answer sheet and model answer key after verification by the Competent Authority. In case, there is any change in the marks in verification revised mark-sheet will be issued.

9. MERIT LIST

- 9.1. Basis of Merit Ranking.

Marks obtained by the candidate at the Asso-CET 2008 will form the basis of selection.

- 9.2. Tie-Breakers.

In case of equal marks at the Asso-CET 2008, the following procedure shall be adopted for deciding inter-se-merit.

- 9.2.1. *First level:* A candidate with higher marks in Biology at the Asso-CET 2008 Exam shall be preferred, if the tie still persists then:
- 9.2.2. *Second level:* A candidate with higher marks in Chemistry at the Asso-CET 2008 Exam shall be preferred, if the tie still persists then;
- 9.2.3. *Third level:* A candidate with higher percentage of aggregate marks at the SSC(or equivalent) Exam shall be preferred, if the tie still persists then:
- 9.2.4. *Fourth level:* An older candidate shall be preferred over a younger candidate.

10. INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING-UP PREFERENCE FORM

- 10.1. Admissions to the Health Science Courses Admissions for the first year for the academic year 2008-09 will be done by filling up the Preference Form. The Preference filled by the Candidate will be centrally processed and list of selected candidates will be declared on the Official Website of AMUPMDC (www.amupmdc.org). Candidates selected should report to the allotted College/Course within the stipulated time.
- 10.2. **The Preference Form will be Issued on the same date to all the Candidates after completion of Asso-CET 2008 examination on 4th May 2008 in Exam Hall only. Students should not leave Exam Hall unless Preference Form is collected from Invigilator.**
- 10.3. For MBBS and BDS course minimum 50% marks are required in Asso-CET 2008. Those who do not comply with this condition will not be eligible to apply for MBBS & BDS course.
- 10.4. Candidate will fill-in the relevant information along with his/her Roll Number Merit Number etc. of Asso-CET 2008.
- 10.5. The Preference Form must be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting using Black Ball Point Pen. The Preference Form complete in all respect shall be **submitted directly to the Office of AMUPMDC, Mumbai** either in person or by Speed post/ Courier in the envelope provided with the preference Form. Filled in Preference form should reach the office of Amupmdc on before 30th June 2008. Preference Form received after 30/06/2008 will not be considered.
- 10.6. Candidate will be issued only one Preference Form. Another Preference Form will not be issued to the candidate on any ground.
- 10.7. In case the candidate is not eligible for admission as per the rules, the Preference Form issued already will be treated as cancelled.
- 10.8. Candidate should read all the instructions before filling the Preference Form. Candidate should carefully note the Faculty and College Code. The Candidates are instructed to make 2 Xerox copies of the Preference Form. One Xerox copy may be used as specimen copy to fill in the same for practice, once the candidate is satisfied with his/her filled in choices in the Xerox specimen copy, then he/she should fill in the Original Preference Form Provided by AMUPMDC by using Black Ball Point Pen. Then the filled in Preference Form of AMUPMDC must be Xeroxed. The Original filled in Preference Form along with the Xerox copy to be submitted to AMUPMDC Office. The second Xerox copy may be retained by the candidate for his/her record.
- 10.9. Candidate should write faculty of Preference and College Code number in the boxes. one digit in each box (3 digits in 3 boxes). Candidate should write the codes with Black Ball Point Pen with neat legible and clear handwriting. Please DO

NOT FOLD, PIN OR STAPLE the Preference Form, because the Preference Form will be Scanned by the Computer.

- 10.10. List of College Code Numbers will be issued with the Preference Form.**
- 10.11.** Candidate can fill minimum one preference or any desired number or Maximum 100 Preferences available. The same faculty and College Code should not be filled more than once. In case the candidate fills the same Code More than once higher Preference will be considered and subsequent repeated Preference number will be ignored. If the candidate fills any wrong code of faculty and College it will be rejected.
- 10.12.** If a Candidate does not give Preference for a Particular College then it means that he/she is not interested in that College. Candidate should note that there will be no **Change/Addition /Deletion** in the Preference at any stage.
- 10.13.** The candidate selected as per his/her Merit Cum Preference for a Particular College has to join the College as per Procedure. In failure to join the Allotted College he/she is debarred/dropped from subsequent admission process of Asso-CET 2008.
- 10.14.** In case the candidate is not selected in the First Selected List then he/she remains eligible for the subsequent Rounds as per Preference which he/she has given in the Preference Form for MBBS/BDS only.
- 10.15.** For filling of vacant seats after the First Round same Preference Form will be considered and no separate Preference Form will be required to be filled in by the candidate.
- 10.16.** **Candidate should submit only one Preference Form.** Submission of more than one Preference Form will lead to disqualification.
- 10.17.** Candidate should note that the Preference of College Codes once entered in the data shall be final and irrevocable. Thereafter they cannot be change addition or deletion of Preference entered by Candidate. This final data shall be used in entire selection Process for the admission to Health Science Courses.

11. SELECTION PROCESS

Pursuant to the orders dt 10-08-2006 the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in writ Petition No, WP 5655 of 2006, the Selection to all the Health Science Courses will be made as per Merit Cum Preference given by the candidates. The Selection Process will be as follows:

- 11.1.** As per the orders there will be three rounds of Selection Process for **MBBS & BDS** Courses only.
- 11.2.** For BAMS, BPTH, Both, B.Sc Nursing there will be only ONE Round of Centralized Admission. There after the respective Association or Such Collages will fill-in the unfilled Seats at their own level on the basis of Merit of Asso-CET 2008.

- 11.3. For MBBS & BDS Courses there shall be three Rounds of selection of candidates depending on the availability of vacant seats. The selection will be on the basis of Merit and the Preference submitted by the candidates in their Preference Form. For second and subsequent Rounds no separate Preference Form will be filled in by the candidates. The choices of the College & Course once entered in the data shall be final and irrevocable. This final data shall be used in entire selection process for the admission to first year Health Science Courses for the academic year 2008-09.
- 11.4. The candidates may kindly note that while filling the Preference form Asso-CET 2008 merit number will be operated from number one onwards in each Round of selection. The candidate selected in previous Round will be considered for betterment in the subsequent Round. The betterment means the higher Preference exercised by the candidate. The shift in such betterment shall be compulsory and mandatory except for those who have filled **Status Retention Form**. Such a candidate who has filled Status Retention Form will not be considered for any subsequent Rounds of selection process for the year 2008-09.
- 11.5. Based on Merit and Preference given, the seat will be allotted on merit and the allotment will be displayed on Official Website of AMUPMDC (www.amupmdc.org). **No separate letters will be issued to the candidates.** they should report to the allotted Colleges with a printed copy of website.
- 11.6. Candidates as per the allotment should report along with all Original Certificates and a set of attested photocopies of each document at the allotted College as per the schedule. All Original Certificates will be verified by the allotted College before finalizing the admission. Certificates & documents should be submitted as per the list given below:
- 11.6.1. Asso-CET 2008 Mark Sheet.
 - 11.6.2. Receipt Cum Identity Card of Asso-CET 2008.
 - 11.6.3. Photocopy of filled in Preference Form.
 - 11.6.4. Nationality Certificate or Valid Passport.
 - 11.6.5. Proof of Age.
 - 11.6.6. Statement of Marks obtained in the HSC or equivalent examination.
 - 11.6.7. Passing Certificate of HSC or equivalent.
 - 11.6.8. Medical Fitness Certificate as per **Annexure - J**.
 - 11.6.9. **Caste Certificate Caste Validity and non-creamy layer where applicable issued by appropriate authorities of the Govt. of Maharashtra.**
- 11.7. Canvassing directly or indirectly for the allotment of seat would disqualify the candidate for admission. Influencing the staff by unfair means will lead to cancellation of allotted seat and such candidate will also face disqualification for appearance in the subsequent Asso-CET.

- 11.8. Candidate selected for admission shall be subject to disciplinary rules of University/Institution/Government and Management.
- 11.9. A candidate selected for any Health Science Course as per Merit cum Preference will not be allowed for change of college on mutual basis. **Request for mutual transfer is not permissible. Such request will not be entertained.**
- 11.10. The selection made by the Competent Authority as per procedure is final and will be binding on the candidate.
- 11.11. **Status Retention of Admissions** : After selection in first or second round if the candidate desires to retain the same selection (Course & College) and does not want to take any further betterment then he/she can do so by filing "Status Retention Form" in prescribed proforma given in the Brochure. Status Retention Form is to be submitted to the Competent Authority through the College Principal/Dean where he/she is admitted. However Candidate should note that once Retention Form is given his/her admission is confirmed in that College and his/her name will be deleted from the further selection process for the academic year 2008-09. (**Annexure "G"**)
- 11.12. To confirm the admission the Candidate will have to deposit his/her all relevant Original Certificates, documents along with the complete tuition fees to the concerned college where the candidate is admitted

12. PROCESS FOR FILLING VACANT SEATS of MBBS & BDS Courses only.

- 12.1. After first round, the vacant seats will be filled-in. For these seats, the selected as well as not selected candidates who have filled the Preference Form are eligible. For this process Asso-CET 2008 Merit List will be operated from Merit Number 1 onwards. The Candidate selected in round one will be considered for betterment in the 2nd round & 3rd of selection process. "Betterment" means the higher preference exercised by the candidates. The shift in such betterment shall be compulsory and mandatory, except as provided in para no. 12.11.
- 12.2. The Competent Authority will issue notice which will be displayed on the website of AMUPMDC indicating the date of subsequent round of selection process.
- 12.3. The following candidates will not be eligible for subsequent admission process.
- 12.3.1. A candidate who is selected as per his/her merit cum preference, but does not join the allotted college or cancels the admission after joining is not eligible for further selection process.
- 12.3.2. Accepting admission but not reporting to the College and/or not paying the fees.
- 12.4. For remaining courses the vacant seats will be filled in by the respective Colleges, after the First Round.

13. DISQUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION

- 13.1. Any candidate himself or his Authorized Proxy if found obstructing the admission process or creating nuisance the candidate shall be liable for Disqualification from

the admission process. The decision taken by the College Authority Shall be final and binding.

- 13.2. Notwithstanding anything stated in the rules here-in-above, a candidate who was allotted a seat in any course under MUHS Nashik in previous year(s) and who vacates/abandons it after availing the said seat, has completed such a period of course which would result into lapse of the said seat, will not be eligible for admission for the next two years.

14. FEES FOR COURSES

- 14.1. Fee Structure: Fee Structure will be as per declaration of the Shikshan Shulka Samiti, appropriate authority and Judicial pronouncements. The fees declared by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti is displayed on the official website of the Samiti i.e. www.sspnsamiti.gov.in.
- 14.2. Payment of Fees: The Candidate shall be admitted only on payment of full fees as declared by Shikshan Shulka Samiti or Judicial pronouncements.

15. NUMBER OF SEATS

Information regarding the number of seats available in various institutions/colleges for admission on the basis of merit in Asso-CET 2008 will be displayed on the official website of the Association.

16. CANCELLATION and REFUND OF FEES

16.1. CANCELLATION

16.1.1. The Selected candidate must join the College at which he/she is selected on or before the date prescribed by the competent Authority. Failing which his/her admission stands cancelled.

16.1.2. The selected candidate who has confirmed the admission wishes to cancel the admission should cancel it at the respective College. The College should accept the cancellation and inform the Competent Authority along with copy of the cancellation Letter immediately (Annexure H)

16.2. REFUND OF FEE

As per instructions received from The Pravesh Niyantran Samiti vide letter No. PNS/ Meeting / March /2007/122 dt 14.3.07 has directed that refund of fee for cancellation of Admission will be as follows

The candidate who has confirmed his / her admission may cancel admission by submitting an application on plain paper to the respective college and may request for the refund of fees. The refund of fees to candidates admitted in the college shall be made after deduction as under

16.3. Refund of fees by the college after change of college for higher preference by the **Same Competent Authority** for the same year the deduction of Rs. 1,000/- from the tuition fees.

16.4. As per decision taken by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti that if a seat is filled-in and there is no vacant seat remain to be filled-in by the College/ Institute in such a case the College/Institute should deduct only up to Rs 1,000/- and balance amount of fees paid by a student should be refunded. The Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents such as Mark List, Leaving Certificate etc. collected from the Student.

16.5. Vacant seat remain to be filled-in by the College/Institution will be known only after the cut-off date of the respective courses/respective councils.

16.6. Candidate who has confirmed the admission expires or becomes invalid within three months from the date of admission, full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administration charges.

17. GRANTING OF TERM

Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik shall take the decision regarding granting of the term and the eligibility of selected candidates. The decision taken by MUHS will be final and binding on the candidate/student.

18. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE.

18.1. The student while studying in the Health Sciences Courses, if found indulging in antinational activities, unlawful activities or ragging in any form, contrary to the provisions of Acts and Law enforced by Government, will be liable to be expelled from the college by the Dean / Principal of the College.

- 18.2. Failure of the candidate in making full and correct statements in the application form and / or Suppression of any information is liable for disqualification of the candidate, even at later date. Such a candidate will be debarred from the entire selection process and pursuing the course of studies.
- 18.3. It is the responsibility of every candidate to submit proper documents. Any attempt to submit documents, which are not genuine, will lead to cancellation of the admission of the candidate, forfeiture of the fees, deposits and expulsion of the candidate from the college by the Competent Authority or by his authorized official. The name of such candidate/s shall be deleted from the Merit List.
- 18.4. Pursuant to the orders in W. P. (Civil) No. 645 of 1999, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, has directed the Department of Human resources Development and Education, Govt. of India, to take all necessary steps to curb the menace of ragging and take severe action against the students involved in such activities. Students to take serious note.
- 18.5. As per the provisions of Maharashtra Act XXXIII known as "Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act of 1999", students indulging in ragging can be punished under the Act resulting in suspension, expulsion from the college and imprisonment.
- 18.6. Any issue not dealt here-in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the Competent Authority.

19. INSURANCE SCHEME

In accordance with GR. NO. MED-100/880/CR-129/EDU-1, dated 23/10/2003 "Amartya Shiksha Yojana", an insurance scheme has been introduced by Govt. of Maharashtra. The details about this scheme shall be known to the candidate at the time of admission.

1. The candidates recognized by the State of Maharashtra as belonging to the following Backward Classes, shall alone be eligible to claim admissions as against the seats reserved for such backward class categories. These Backward Class categories are as follows:-

(i)	Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism (SC)	6.50 %
(ii)	Scheduled Tribes (ST)	3.50 %
(iii)	Vimukta Jati (VJ/DT - A)	1.50 %
(iv)	Nomadic Tribes (NT - B)	1.25 %
(v)	Nomadic Tribes (NT - C)	1.75 %
(vi)	Nomadic Tribes (NT - D)	1.00 %
(vii)	Other Backward Category (OBC) including SBC	9.50 %
	Total	25.00 %
2. Candidates belonging to aforesaid Backward Class categories will be required to submit the Caste Certificate and the Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate.
3. Caste certificate issuing authority: - Caste certificate stating that the caste is recognized under a particular backward class category in Maharashtra state is issued by Sub-Divisional Magistrate /Executive Magistrate /Metropolitan Magistrate in Maharashtra state.
4. The Caste/Tribe validity Certificate Issuing Authorities are as follows:-
 - 4.1. For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism, Vimukta Jati (A), Nomadic Tribes B, C & D and Other Backward Class, Caste Validity Certificate is issued by **Divisional Caste Scrutiny Committee of respective Divisional Social Welfare Office** (Mumbai, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati, Nagpur and Latur).
 - 4.2. For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe the Tribe Validity Certificate is issued by Commissioner/Jt. Commissioner, **Tribe Scrutiny Committee of respective Region** [Kokan (Thane), Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati, Nagpur, Nandurbar and Gadchiroli].
5. **The candidates who have claimed the Constitutional Reservation in the original Application Form must submit Caste Validity Certificate at the time of filling the Preference Form, failing which the category claim, will not be granted.**
6. **NON-CREAMY LAYER**
A candidate belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the categories (iii), (iv), (v), (vi) and (vii) must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him/her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories (iii), (iv), (v), (vi) and (vii) above will be required to produce Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the name of candidate as specified in the Government resolution No. – CBC 10 / 2006 / CR 15 / Ma.V.K., dated 30-6-2006.. The certificate stating that it is valid upto 31/3/2009 should be submitted at the time of filling up of Preference Form. The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate is issued by Sub- Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector/Collector of the district. However, such a Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be produced in any case on or before the last date of filling up of Preference Form, failing which the category claim will not be granted.

Applicants belonging to Special Backward Category

N.B.: Hon'ble High Court Mumbai had stayed admission to Special Backward Category as a separate quota and therefore, vide Government Circular from Social Welfare, Cultural Affairs and Sports Department No. CBC-1095/WS/264/BCW-5 dated 24th October 1995, the persons belonging to Special Backward Category (SBC) are to be considered as OBC candidates.

Admission under constitutional reservation seat will be governed by the Maharashtra Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Category (Regulation of Issuance and Verification of) Caste Certificate Act, 2000 (Mah. Act No. XXIII of 2001). Candidates are instructed to note following provisions of the said act; Para 10: (Benefits secured on the basis of false Caste Certificate to be withdrawn)

1. Whoever not being a person belonging to any of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes, De-notified tribes, (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes or Special Backward Category secures admission in any educational institution against a seat reserved for such Castes, Tribes or Classes, or secures any appointment in the Government, local authority or in any other company of Corporation, owned or controlled by the Government or in any Government aided institution or Co-Operative Society against a post reserved for such Castes, Tribes or Classes by producing a false Caste Certificate shall, on cancellation of the Caste Certificate by the Scrutiny Committee, be liable to be debarred from the concerned educational institution, or as the case may be, discharged from the said employment forthwith and any other benefits enjoyed or derived by virtue of such admission or appointment by such person as aforesaid shall be withdrawn forthwith.

2. Any amount paid to such person by the Government or any other agency by way of scholarship, grant, allowance or other financial benefit shall be recovered from such person as an arrears of land revenue.
3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act for the time being in force, any Degree, Diploma or any other educational qualification acquired by such person after securing admission in any educational institution on the basis of a Caste Certificate which is subsequently proved to be false shall also stand cancelled, on cancellation of such Caste Certificate, by the Scrutiny Committee.
4. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force, a person shall be disqualified for being a member of any statutory body if he has contested the election for local authority, Co-operative Society or any statutory body on the seat reserved for any of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, De-notified Tribes, (Vimukt jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes or Special Backward Category by procuring a false Caste Certificate as belonging to such Caste, Tribe or Class on such false Caste Certificate being cancelled by the Scrutiny Committee; and any benefits obtained by such person shall be recoverable as arrears of land revenue and the election of such person shall be deemed to have been terminated retrospectively.

Para 11: (Offences & Penalties)

1 Whoever,-

- (a) Obtains a false Caste Certificate by furnishing false information or filing false statements or documents or any other fraudulent means ; or
 - (b) not being a person belonging to any of the Scheduled Tribes, De-notified Tribes, (Vimukt jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Classes or Special Backward Category secures any benefits or appointment exclusively reserved for such Castes, Tribes or Classes in the Government, local authority or any other company or corporation owned or controlled by the Government or in any Government aided institution, or secures admission in any educational institution against a seat exclusively reserved for such Castes, Tribes or Classes or is elected to any of the elective offices of local authority or Co-operative Society against the office, reserved for such Castes, Tribes of Classes by producing a false Caste Certificate; shall, on conviction, be punished , with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than six months but which may extent up to two years or with fine which shall not be less than two thousand rupees, but which may extend up to twenty thousand rupees or both.
- 2 No court shall take cognizance of an offence punishable under this section except upon a complaint, in writing, made by the scrutiny Committee or by any other officer duly authorized by the Scrutiny Committee for this purpose.

Para 12: (Offences under Act to be cognizable & non-bailable) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure; 1973 --

- (a) offence punishable under section 11 shall be cognizable and non-bailable;
- (b) every offence punishable under this Act, shall be tried by any Magistrate of First Class in a summery way and provisions of sections 262except sub-section(2) to 265 both inclusive of this Code shall as for as possible may be applied to such trial.

Para 13: (Penalty for issuing false Caste Certificate))

- 1 Any person or authority performing the functions of Competent Authority under this act, who intentionally issues of false Caste Certificate shall earn conviction, be punished with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than six months but which may extend up to two years or with fine which shall not be less than two thousand rupees, but which may extend up to twenty thousand rupees or both.
- 2 No court shall take cognizance of an offence punishable under this section except with the previous sanction of the Government.

Para 14: (Penalty for abatement)

Whoever abets any offence punishable under this Act shall be punished with the punishment provided for in this Act for such offence.

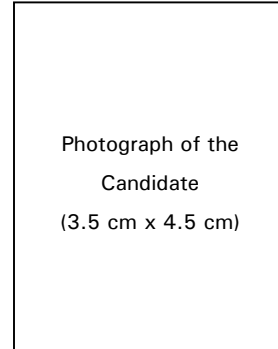
