1.0 GUIDELINES FOR FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORM

For admission to MD/MS/PG Diploma/M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) and MDS Courses 2011 in the Faculty of Medicine.

1.1 How to apply

A candidate desirous to apply is required to follow the steps given below :

Step 1 Visit the official website of AMU i.e. www.amucontrollerexams.com

**Step 2 Fill in the online Application Form :
Important Instructions**

- (i) The candidate must have the Demand Draft of requisite amount (Rs. 1000/-) non-refundable against the Admission Test Fee and Processing Charges in favour of Finance Officer, AMU, Aligarh payable at Aligarh OR Cash Receipt. Candidate is not allowed to proceed without filling up the Admission Test Fee / Processing Charges column.
- (ii) The candidate must fill in all the entries carefully. All the correspondence will be made on the correspondence address only, including dispatch of Admission Test Card (Hall Ticket) etc.
- (iii) The candidate must fill in his/her valid E-mail ID as his/her user name and password will be sent on this ID for logging in and downloading the Acrobat PDF File generated after the submission of

Application Form at a later stage if required.

- (iv) A candidate, after filling in all the entries of the Application Form, is given a chance to review his/her details. If he/she has made an incorrect entry he/she may edit it by clicking on the “Edit Button” at the bottom of the online Application Form.
- (v) The candidate, after submission of Application Form will be allotted a user name and password that will be shown to him/her on the screen and the same will be mailed to the E-mail ID, he/she has mentioned in the Application Form. However, he/she may note it down for his/her convenience. He/She may also Open/Save the PDF File by clicking the link shown on the screen below the user name and password.
- (vi) The Application Form is user friendly but still, if a candidate feels any difficulty in filling in the Application Form, he/she may contact on the following Nos. : +919219401936. He/She may also mail at helpdesk@amucontrollerexams.com.
- vii) Incomplete Application Form such as those received without requisite Fee or Demand Draft of requisite fee not drawn in favour of Finance Officer, AMU or Application Forms received after the last date shall be rejected.

Step 3 The candidate is required to send the original print out of the Generated PDF File. Before sending the print out of the Application Form through Registered / Speed Post so as to reach the Deputy Controller (Admissions), Aligarh Muslim

University, Aligarh, 202002 by 5.00 p.m. on or before the last date, the candidate must ensure that he/she has :

Important Instructions

Photograph	Applicants are required to paste recent photograph of size 2.5 cm x 3 cm not older than three months, in the spaces provided on the Generated PDF Copy of the Application Form. The photograph must be exactly same as he/she uploaded on the online form. Applicants must not paste any photograph on the Scan Slip.
Thumb Impression of the Candidate	The candidate must give his / her Thumb Impression, Male (LTI) and Female (RTI), in the box provided on the Application Form.
Signature	A candidate is required to sign the Application Form after going through the declaration.
Transaction ID	A candidate is required to mention his / her Transaction ID given at the top of generated PDF File along with his / her name at the back of the Demand Draft.
Status	(i) For admission to the MD/MS/PG Diploma & MDS Courses in the Faculty of Medicine, only Institutional (Internal) candidates are eligible for admission. (ii) The applicant for M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery Course, the candidate is required to Select whether he/she is an Institutional candidate (Internal candidate) OR External candidate, strictly in accordance with the definition of Institutional candidate given under Section 1.5 on page 7 & 8.
Enrolment Number	To be provided by an applicant who is already enrolled or has been a student of this University, irrespective of whether he/she falls in the Internal Category or not.
Gender	Select the Gender 'Male' or 'Female' from the Drop Down List.

Name of the Candidate	The applicant is required to write his / her full name exactly as given in his/her High School/Secondary School Certificate.
Is hostel accommodation required	Select `Yes' or `No' whether Hostel Accommodation is required or not, upon his selection at A.M.U.
Date of birth	The date of birth is required to be given in the Christian Era.
Nationality	The nationality of the applicant is required in this column. If the applicant is a Citizen of India, he/she shall Select `INDIAN' from the Drop Down List.
Details of Qualifying Examination / Professional Experience	<p>Candidates are required to furnish details of the qualifying examination passed. The percentage of aggregate marks secured at the qualifying examination is required to be given only up to two decimal places.</p> <p>If the result of a candidate has not been declared at the time of filling the Application Form, he/she is required to enter "Result Awaited" in the column provided for remarks. No candidate without the required statement of marks shall be allowed to appear for Counselling and completion of admission.</p> <p>A three-letter code for the name of the Board/University from which the qualifying examination has been passed be mentioned in the relevant column. For Board / University codes please refer to Table I (Annexure-I)</p> <p>Candidates are required to give details of Professional Experience/ Training /Internship as the case may be. The documentary proof in respect of the above must be attached with the Application Form.</p>

Incomplete Application Forms or received after due date and without requisite fee shall not be considered and no further correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

Candidates for the MD/MS/PG Diploma Courses 2011 in the Faculty of Medicine are required to fill in only one Application Form.

Candidates desirous of applying for M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) Course 2011 shall be required to fill in a separate Application Form.

Candidates desirous of applying for MDS Courses 2011 shall be required to fill in a separate Application Form.

1.2 Duplicate Admission Test Card (Hall Ticket)

For genuine reasons, Duplicate Admission Test Card shall be issued to the candidates in person by the Admission Section one day before the Admission Test after proper identification and on production of two photographs.

1.3 Instructions to candidates appearing at the Admission Test

1. The medium of all tests shall be English, except where a question paper is set in a language other than English.
2. The University shall not be responsible if it is compelled to make changes in the Admission Test Schedule due to unforeseen circumstances.
3. Answer to the question is to be made in the Answer Sheet which is read and evaluated by a computer control Optical Mark Reader (OMR).
4. The OMR Answer Sheet has two kinds of spaces for making entries – squares and circles. Squares are meant for writing alphabets and digits, while circles are to be shaded in.

5. Use only ballpoint pen to mark your responses in the Answer Sheet.
6. For every question, there are four responses, only one of which is correct. Select only one response which you think is the most appropriate and indicate your choice in the answer sheet by shading the appropriate circle.
7. Do not make any stray marks on the Answer Sheet. Do not fold, tear, roll or mutilate your Answer Sheet in any manner.
8. For making entries in boxes (numbered 1-7) of the Answer Sheet, write one digit/alphabet in each square and shade the relevant circle in the column beneath it.
9. All information required in the Answer Sheet is given in the Admission Test Card (Hall Ticket) and the Question Booklet which will be given to the candidate in the Examination Hall. For Course Number, please see **Table II (Annexure - II)**.
10. Candidates are required to bring their own Stationary Items required to attempt the Admission Test.
11. OMR Answer Sheet consists of Carbonless Duplicate Copy. Do not attempt to separate or displace them while answering.
12. A sample answer sheet is given at the end of the Guide to Admissions (Supplement) 2011. Please read the instructions in the said answer sheet carefully.
13. Use of Mobile Phones / Pagers / Calculators or any other electronic gadgette are strictly not allowed in the Examination Hall.

1.4 Examination Centres for Admission Tests :

All Admission Tests shall be conducted at the Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh. The Examination Centre assigned to each candidate shall be clearly mentioned in his/her Admission Test Card (Hall Ticket). Candidates are advised to see the seating arrangement chart which shall be

displayed on the Notice Board of the concerned Examination Centre one day before the test date.

Note : Candidates appearing at the Admission Test shall have to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging. However, hostel accommodation may be provided to a limited number of women candidates in Abdullah Hall/Indira Gandhi Hall / SN Hall of this University on payment. 1.5 Institutional Candidate (Internal Candidate)

- a) For purposes of admission, an **INSTITUTIONAL CANDIDATE (INTERNAL candidate)** is one who has passed the qualifying examination held by **THIS** University, as a regular student not earlier than **THREE** (3) academic years from the date of admission to the Course he/she is seeking admission to.
- b) As per the definition of an Institutional (Internal) candidate for the Faculty of Medicine the period of **THREE** (03) years will be counted from the date, the candidate has completed the Internship except in case of M.Ch.
- c)* *All internal applicants will be allowed to appear at the admission test only for three (3) consecutive attempts.*
- d) All applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from any other University or those who have passed the qualifying examination from this University earlier than three academic years shall be considered **EXTERNAL**.

- e) All the External candidates as defined in 1.5(d) above, are not eligible for admission to MD/MS/PG Diploma and MDS Courses offered by the Faculty of Medicine of this University except M.Ch. Seats reserved for External Candidates are filled through All India Quota.

* *Clause (c) above shall be applicable from the session 2012.*

1.6 Documents to be attached with the Application Form :

For admission to PG Courses in J.N. Medical College, Faculty of Medicine

- i) Marksheet of final professional MBBS Examination.
- ii) (a) Those who have already completed their compulsory Rotatory Internship must submit a copy of completion certificate.
- (b) Those who are undergoing Rotatory Internship must submit a certificate from the Dean or competent authority indicating probable date of completion of Internship.
- iii) Permanent or temporary registration from MCI or State Medical Council.

For admission to M.Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery), J.N. Medical College, Faculty of Medicine

- i) Proof of passing M.S. (General Surgery)
- ii) Attempt Certificate

For admission to MDS Course in Dr. Ziauddin Ahmad Dental College, Faculty of Medicine.

- i) Marksheet of final professional BDS Examination.
- ii) (a) Those who have already completed their compulsory Rotatory Internship must submit a copy of completion certificate.
 - (b) Those who are undergoing Rotatory Internship must submit a certificate from the Dean or competent authority indicating probable date of completion of Internship.

2.2 Minimum Qualification for admission (PG Degree / Diploma Courses) :

- (i) The candidate must have passed the M.B.B.S. examination from this University.
- (ii) The candidate should have obtained full registration i.e., they should have completed satisfactorily one year of compulsory rotatory internship after passing the final M.B.B.S. Examination and should have full registration with Medical Council of India / State Medical Council.

2.4 Method of Selection :

A Common Admission Test (MCQ Type) will be held for the admission to Postgraduate Degree / Diploma Courses in various specialities.

The minimum percentage of marks for eligibility for Counselling shall be 50% in the Admission Test.

2.5 Counselling :

- (i) There will be Counselling for admission to Post Graduate Courses in different subjects. The subject of choice shall be allotted by the Counselling Committee on the basis of merit of the candidate determined after the Postgraduate Medical Admission Test.
- (ii) The selected candidates of PG Medical Admission Test appearing for Counselling will be required to fill a Proforma.
- (iii) Candidates shall appear before the Counselling Committee in person.

2.6 Condition for Leaving the Course :

(i) If a candidate admitted to the Postgraduate Degree / Diploma Course leaves the Course after final counselling he / she shall not be eligible to appear at the Postgraduate Medical Admission Test conducted by AMU and will also not be eligible for admission to Postgraduate Courses consecutively for next three years, and shall have to refund the money in full received by him / her in the form of stipend.

(ii) **Penalty** : A candidate who, after admission to PG Courses, leaves before completion of the Courses, he/she will have to pay Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) as penalty from the session 2010 and also return the money received by him / her as stipend.

2.7 M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) - 2011

There shall be negative scoring in the Admission Test of M.Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) Course.

Course of Study	:	M.Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery)
Duration	:	3 Years
Intake	:	As per MCI norms.
Eligibility	:	Medical Graduate holding the Degree of M.S. (General Surgery) from an Institution recognised by the Medical Council of India.

2.7.1 Method of Selection : M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery)

The Admission Test is open to candidates from all over the country. The merit of the candidates will be determined on the basis of written test only and as per the University rules, in which the candidate should secure at least 50% marks.

Attested copies of the following be attached with the Application Form.

- (a) Proof of passing M.S. (General Surgery)
- (b) Attempt certificate

Those who have passed M.S. (General Surgery) Examination in more than two attempts need not apply.

2.8 Duration of Stay :

The duration of stay required by a candidate admitted to MD/MS degree Course shall be 36 months but in case of candidates holding a Diploma Course in the same specialization prior to his/her admission to the Degree Course, the duration of stay shall be 24 months. For the candidates admitted in the PG Diploma Courses the duration of stay shall be 24 months. The total duration of stay for the M. Ch. (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) shall be 36 months. For all the Courses, the duration of stay shall be counted from the date of joining the Course after completing admission formalities. Casual Leave / Earned Leave admissible as per the rules may be availed. As per MCI regulations, attendance requirement for all the Courses shall be 80% in each academic year separately.

2.9 Stipend :

The stipend payable to a candidate shall in any case, will not exceed 36 months / 24 months as the case may be depending upon the prescribed duration of the Course to which he / she is admitted.

2.10 Absence and name removal :

The name of a student of PG Degree / Diploma Course in the Faculty of Medicine may be removed :

- a) On his own request in writing to the Dean, Faculty of Medicine submitted through the Chairman of the Department concerned;
- b) On account of non-payment of his/her arrears, by the Dean, on the recommendation of the Provost of Hall where the student is residing after being giving appropriate notice and reasonable opportunity to pay the fees/ dues of the University / Hall of residence;

- c) On account of gross misconduct by order of the Vice-Chancellor or by the Disciplinary Committee;
- d) On account of continuous absence from the class or Clinical / Lab duties without obtaining prior leave, for 15 days, the Chairman of the Department of Studies concerned will give a notice to the student at his/her residential and permanent addresses by registered post asking him/her to resume his/her duties within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of the registered letter; and if the student fails to resume his/her class / duties within the time granted, the Chairman of the Department concerned shall recommend to the Dean, Faculty of Medicine for removal of the name of the student immediately.

Notwithstanding any thing contained in this clause the total absence from duty with due permission on medical ground, shall be sixty days and thereafter, the name of the student shall be removed from the rolls of the University by the Dean, Faculty of Medicine on the recommendation of the Chairman of the Department and no correspondence shall be entertained and no medical certificate shall be admissible for a continuous period of more than sixty days. In that event, he / she shall refund to the University, all the money received as stipend / salary plus Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) as penalty.

2.11 Choice of subjects :

The subject of choice for the MD/MS/PG Diploma Course shall be allotted by the Counselling Committee on the basis of merit of the candidate determined after the MD/MS/PG Diploma admission test conducted by this University.

2.12 Admission :

- (a) The following original certificates / documents of the candidate admitted shall be retained in the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Medicine at the time of admission :
 1. Secondary School Certificate / High School Certificate

2. MBBS Degree
3. MBBS Final Professional Marksheet.
4. MS (General Surgery) Degree in case of M.Ch.(Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) Course in addition to the above.

NOTE : The documents shall be returned to the candidate after completion of the Course or at the time of removal of his/her name from the rolls of the University after clearing the outstanding University / Hall dues.

- (b) All admissions shall be provisional in the first instance and shall be liable for cancellation at any time if it is found that the candidate has furnished wrong information or has concealed the facts purposefully.
- (c) A candidate who has completed PG Degree shall not be eligible for admission to PG Diploma Course in the same subject.

2.13 The Bond :

The admitted candidates, on joining the Departments, shall have to execute a prescribed bond on non judicial stamp paper within the stipulated time notified by the Dean, Faculty of Medicine.

- 1. The next batch of candidates for MDS Courses for academic session 2011 will be admitted after renewal of permission from the Central Government.**

3.2 Minimum Qualification for admission to MDS Courses :

The candidate must have passed the BDS Examination from this University. They must have completed satisfactorily one year of compulsory Rotatory Internship after passing the BDS Final Examinations and must have full Registration with DCI / State Dental Council.

3.3 Method of Selection :

- (i) A Common Admission Test consisting of 200 questions of multiple choice will be held for admission to MDS in the above specialities.
- (ii) The minimum percentage of marks for the eligibility for Counselling to MDS Course shall be 50% in the Admission Test.

3.4 Counselling :

- (i) There shall be counselling for admission to MDS Courses in different Specialities. The speciality shall be allotted by the Counselling Committee on the basis of the merit of the candidate in the Admission Test.
- (ii) The selected candidates for admission to MDS shall be required to fill in a proforma at the time of counselling.

- (iii) Candidates shall appear before the Counselling Committee in person.
- (iv) No candidate will be allowed to appear in counselling unless he / she presents the following documents :
 - (a) Internship Completion Certificate
 - (b) No Objection Certificate from the employer / Institution where he/she was working /pursuing the MDS Course.

3.5 Condition for Leaving the Course :

(i) If a candidate admitted to the Postgraduate Degree / Diploma Course leaves the course after final counselling, he / she shall not be eligible to appear at the Postgraduate Admission Test conducted by AMU and will also not be eligible for admission to Postgraduate Courses consecutively for the next three years, and shall have to refund the money in full received by him / her in the form of stipend.

(ii) **Penalty** : A candidate who, after admission to PG Courses, leaves before completion of the Courses, he/she will have to pay Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) as penalty from the session 2010 and also return the money received by him / her as stipend.

3.6 Duration of Stay :

The duration of stay of a student admitted to MDS Course shall be 36 months and the duration of stay shall be counted from the date of joining the Course after completing admission formalities. Casual Leave / Earned Leave admissible as per the rules may be availed. As per DCI regulations, attendance requirement for all the Courses shall be 80% in each academic year separately.

3.7 Stipend :

The stipend payable to a candidate shall in any case, will not exceed 36 months depending upon the prescribed duration of the Course to which he / she is admitted.

3.8 Absence and name removal :

The name of a student of MDS Course in Dr. Ziauddin Ahmad Dental College, Faculty of Medicine may be removed :

- a) On his own request by writing to the Dean, Faculty of Medicine submitted through the Chairman of the Department concerned;
- b) On account of non-payment of his/her arrears, by the Dean, on the recommendation of the Provost of Hall where the student is residing after giving appropriate notice and reasonable opportunity to pay the fee/ dues of the University / Hall of residence;
- c) On account of gross misconduct by order of the Vice-Chancellor or by the Disciplinary Committee;
- d) On account of continuous absence from the class or Clinical / Lab duties without obtaining prior leave, for 15 days, the Chairman of the Department of Studies concerned will give a notice to the student at his/her residential and permanent addresses by registered post asking him/her to resume his/her duties within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of the registered letter; and if the student fails to resume his/her class / duties within the time granted, the Chairman of the Department concerned shall recommend to the Dean, Faculty of Medicine for removal of the name of the student immediately.

3.9 Choice of Subjects :

The subject of choice for the MDS Course shall be allotted by the Counselling Committee on the basis of merit of the candidate in the MDS Admission Test.

3.10 Admission :

(a) The following original certificates / documents of the candidate admitted shall be retained in the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Medicine at the time of admission :

1. Secondary School Certificate / High School Certificate
2. BDS Degree
3. BDS Final Professional Marksheet.

NOTE : The documents shall be returned to the candidate after completion of the Course or at the time of removal of his/her name from the rolls of the University after clearing the outstanding University / Hall dues.

(b) All admissions shall be provisional in the first instance and shall be liable for cancellation at any time if it is found that the candidate has furnished wrong information or has concealed the facts purposely.

3.11 The Bond :

The admitted candidates, on joining the Departments, shall have to execute a prescribed bond on non judicial stamp paper within the stipulated time notified by the Dean, Faculty of Medicine.
