ADMISSION NOTICE

DOCTOR OF MEDICINE IN HOMOEOPATHY [M.D. (HOMOEOPATHY)]

COURSE OF STUDY

M.D. (Homoeopathy) at NIH is a full time regular, residential and stipendiary course of 3 years duration affiliated to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences and recognized by the Central Council of Homoeopathy. At present this Institute runs M.D. (Homoeopathy) courses on the following 3 specialties:

- M.D. (Homoeopathy) in Homoeopathic Materia Medica including Applied aspects
- M.D. (Homoeopathy) in Organon of Medicine with Homoeopathic Philosophy
- M.D. (Homoeopathy) in Repertory

ADMISSION

Admission for M.D. (Homoeopathy) is done by the West Bengal University of Health sciences on the basis of an All India Entrance examination (WBPGHAT - **West Bengal Post-Graduate Homoeopathic Admission Test**) followed by the counseling strictly according to the rank in the merit list.

SEATS AVAILABLE

6 seats in each of the three subjects of specialization are available.

A Candidate for MD (Homoeopathy) shall opt any of the above-mentioned special subjects as his / her specialty at the time of counseling, as per availability.

RESERVATION

22%, 6% & 3% seats shall be kept reserved for the SC, ST & Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates respectively, 'Physically Handicapped' means 'Persons with disabilities' as defined by MCI. The government order and/or the court directives which will be in force on the respective day of counseling will be followed for this purpose. Wherever necessary, rosters will be maintained by the University.

Two (2) seats are reserved for BIMSTEC countries sponsored by Government of India.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

A candidate seeking admission is required to submit his/her application online by logging in www.thewbuhs.org. Application submitted by all other means will be summarily rejected.

The candidate will, first of all, visit the university website www.thewbuhs.org through Internet. He/she is required to go through the relevant 'Information Booklet' carefully and acquaint him / her with all requirements regarding filling in the application form.
