**AN OVERVIEW**

Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences (SGPGI) is a deemed university established under an act of the Legislature of the State of Uttar Pradesh in 1983. The Institute is located on a 550-acre residential campus on Rae bareli Road, 15 km from the city of Lucknow. The Institute is rated among the top medical institutions in the country. A highly skilled and dedicated faculty provides quality education and state-of-art patient care, and is involved in research that strives to meet the needs of the society. The Institute awards DM, M.Ch and MD degrees that are recognized by the Medical Council of India. It also offers PhD program, Post-Doctoral Fellowships (PDF), Post-Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC), and Senior Residency in various super specialties. The courses offered by the Institute are highly appreciated and the candidates obtaining degree from SGPGIMS are highly placed both within the country and abroad.

**Admission to MD Program**

The Institute offers MD courses in following specialties.

Admissions are made once a year, with the session commencing from 2<sup>nd</sup> May, as per guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- **Nationality:** Only bonafide Indian nationals are eligible to apply.
- **Qualifications:** Candidate must possess **MBBS Degree/passing out certificate** from any medical college/institution of the country duly recognized by Medical Council of India at the time of filling ON LINE APPLICATION FORM. **A certificate must be provided that degree is recognized by MCI.**
- **Internship :** After passing MBBS examination, the candidate should have completed compulsory rotational Internship of one year on or before May 01<sup>st</sup> , 2009.
- **Age:** Upper age limit is 30 years on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2009. Age relaxation of a maximum of 5 years may be given to SC/ST/OBC candidates **having domicile of Uttar Pradesh. Age relaxation to** widowed/divorced/legally-separated women who have not re-married and disabled/handicapped persons as per Government rules.
- **Reservation:** Reservation will apply as per rules. **Reserved category candidates having domicile other than Uttar Pradesh will be treated as general category candidates for all purposes.**

## **HOW TO APPLY:**

- The information brochure and application forms will be available on Institute website [<http://www.sgpgi.ac.in>] between Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> November and Friday 26<sup>th</sup> December 2008. **Candidates will have to fill up the APPLICATION FORM ONLINE.** After online submission, a print out of filled-in application form **MUST** be sent to Executive Registrar, SGPGIMS, Lucknow -226014 along with all relevant documents in support of age, qualification, Internship, **proof of MCI recognition of MBBS degree**, reservation etc duly signed by the candidate. A bank draft **for Rs 1000/- drawn in favour of Director, SGPGIMS, Lucknow Academic Account, on SBI, SGPGI Branch, (Code No. 7789), payable at Lucknow** should also be attached with the application form. The last date of receiving of completed application forms along with necessary enclosures **is Friday 26<sup>th</sup> December 2008.**

### **CHECKLIST:**

Please complete and arrange your application in the following order and firmly tag before dispatch to the Institute.

- ✓ Demand draft for Rs.1000/- drawn in favour of Director, SGPGIMS, Academic Account, drawn on SBI, SGPGI Branch, (code No. 7789), payable at Lucknow.
- ✓ Print out of the online application form in 3 Pages (2 page form and 1 page Identification cum Attendance card) with your signature at two places (page 2 of 3 and on Identification cum Attendance card page 3 of 3) and self certified passport size recent colored photograph pasted at the appropriate places
- ✓ A self-certified copy of matriculation certificate/age proof certificate.
- ✓ Self-certified copies of MBBS mark sheets of all professional examinations.
- ✓ **A certificate of recognition of your MBBS degree from Medical Council of India.**
- ✓ A self-certified caste certificate from the competent authority (if applicable).
- ✓ Sponsorship certificate from the employer (if applicable)
- ✓ If employed, candidate must ensure that employer's signature is at Page 2 of 3 of the application form.
- ✓ **Please use your correct email-id and password while filling your online application form. It is your responsibility to remember your email-id and password. No telephonic /personal request, in this regard, will be entertained.**

### **HOW TO KNOW YOUR ELIGIBILITY:**

- Eligibility status of each application will be available on the same Website on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2009.

### **HOW TO GET YOUR ADMIT CARD:**

- Eligible candidates can print their **Admit Card ONLINE** (only once) between Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> January and Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2009, using their email id, password and registration number written on right corner of application form.

### **HOW TO KNOW YOUR RESULT:**

- The result of Entrance Examination will be available on the same Website **within one month from the date of entrance examination.**

### **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS :**

Completed application form and identification- cum- attendance card should reach the destination on or before the last date as specified in the advertisement. Incomplete and incorrect applications or applications received after due date shall not be considered and no communication in this regard shall be entertained. The institute takes no responsibility for delay or loss of application in postal transit.

The not-eligible candidates may request for review of their applications to the Executive Registrar of the Institute between 16<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> January 2009 after paying prescribed fee of Rs. 500/- through **Bank Draft drawn in favour of Director, SGPGIMS, Lucknow Academic Account, drawn on SBI, SGPGI Branch, (Code No. 7789), payable at Lucknow.** However no additional document or information other than submitted in the original application form will be considered for review. Request for review in any case will not be considered beyond the specified dates as above.

Candidates in employment must get their applications forwarded through proper channel. State codes are provided in Appendix.

**The examination fee is not refundable either in full or part under any circumstances.**

### **METHOD OF SELECTION:**

**Theory Examination:-** It consists of two written papers. All questions in both papers will be of MBBS level and will be of objective type with four (1, 2, 3, 4) responses, of which only one will be the most appropriate response and therefore the correct choice.

**Paper I:-** Shall consist of 150 questions in pre- and Para clinical subjects. It shall be of two hour duration and shall carry a maximum of 600 marks.

**Paper II:-** Shall consists of 150 questions in clinical subjects. It shall be of two hour duration and shall carry a maximum of 600 marks.

The number of questions from different subjects in paper I and paper II shall ordinarily be as follows

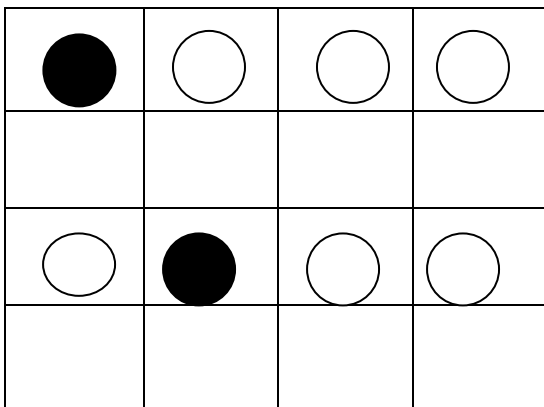

### **How to Answer the Questions :**

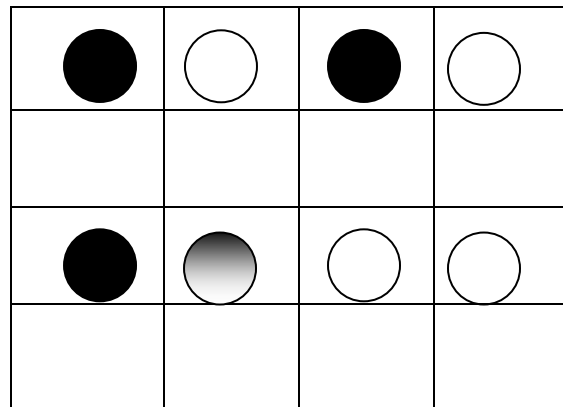
- Each candidate shall be provided with an Answer Sheet having **four circles** in a box for each question.
- The candidate should use only blue/black ball point pen for filling the circles.
- The candidate should be careful while filling the circles as the response once marked can not be changed subsequently.
- The candidate is required to respond to a question by filling the circle completely against an option that the candidate considers correct.

Any erasing putting a dot, a spot, a Line, X, /,  $\sqrt{\quad}$  etc. In the circle, partly filling a circle or filling (partly or fully) more than one circle for any question shall be considered as **incorrect** response. Few examples of correct and incorrect responses are given below.

- **Evaluation:** **Four** marks will be awarded for each correct response. **One** mark will be deducted for each incorrect response. **Zero** mark will be awarded for no response.
- **Qualifying Marks:** The minimum qualifying marks in aggregate of both paper I and paper II shall be 50 % for general category candidate and 40 % for the reserve category candidates.
- **Merit List :-** Merit list shall be made and declared as follows :
  - Category wise merit list shall be prepared based on the aggregate marks obtained in both paper I and paper II in descending order of the marks obtained.
  - Inter-se merit (rank) of the candidates securing equal marks in aggregate shall be determined in order of preference as under:-
    - i. Candidate securing higher marks in paper II shall be placed above.
    - ii. If candidates obtained equal marks in paper II also then the candidate obtaining higher marks in MBBS examination ( Total of marks **obtained** in all professional examinations) will be placed higher.

- iii. If above two criteria can not decide merit order then older candidate will be placed above the younger.
- **Counseling :-** Candidates called for counseling must bring all relevant documents in original, including caste certificate ( if applicable) . Allotment of subject for admission to MD course will be made by the admission committee under chairmanship of the Dean , Sanjay Gandhi Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Lucknow on personal appearance of the candidate during counseling :
    - i. The date and place of the counseling shall be notified to the candidates according to rank on the Institute's web site [www.sgpqi.ac.in](http://www.sgpqi.ac.in).
    - ii. Candidate shall be permitted to opt for only one subject as per his/her rank.
    - iii. A seat once allotted to a candidate shall be final and the candidate shall not be permitted to change the subject.
    - iv. If for any unforeseen reason a candidate is unable to appear for counseling in person, he/she may represent his/her case to the **chairperson** admission committee for consideration.
  - **Admission Procedure:-** Candidate opting for a seat shall be provisionally admitted as per the following procedure:
    - i. The candidate will be issued an allotment letter immediately after allotment of the seat.
    - ii. The candidate has to confirm acceptance of the allotted seat and has to deposit prescribed fee in cash or through bank draft. A receipt shall be issued to the candidates.
    - iii. The candidate shall also have to deposit all his / her original certificates and execute a bond as per procedure of the Institute.
  - **MEDICAL EXAMINATION :**  
No candidate will be permitted to join a course, unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board appointed by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final.

- **JOINING:**

If a candidate fails to deposit the fee or join the course by the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled. **At the time of joining, the selected candidates shall have to submit in original, Matriculation certificate, MBBS mark sheets of all professional examination, MBBS Degree, proof of recognition of MBBS degree from Medical Council of India, permanent registration number, internship completion certificate, migration certificate and certificate of good conduct.**

- **FEE:**

The present fee structure for MD course is given below and may be revised from time to time without prior notice.

The fee is payable annually in two equal instalments. Fee for the first instalment must be paid at the time of counseling and no candidate will be allowed to join without payment of fee. For subsequent years, fee has to be deposited between 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> May & November each year.

- **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Students admitted to MD courses are simultaneously appointed as Junior Residents. The Institute shall fix duties and responsibilities of all Residents from time to time. They will be required to perform such work as may be needed in the interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in Emergency services as and when required.

- **DURATION OF TRAINING:**

All MD Courses are full time courses and of three year duration.

- **SALARY:**

The emolument of Junior Residents is Rs 9,400/- , Rs. 9,725/- , and Rs. 10,050/- / in first, second and third year, respectively and other allowances as per rules.

- **HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION:**

Residence in the campus is compulsory for all Junior Residents. (Subject to availability) They are provided semi-furnished hostel as per policy of the Institute.

- **LEAVE ENTITLEMENT:**

The following leave shall be permissible to the Junior Residents.

1. Leave : 30 days in First year, 36 days in IInd and IIIrd year. Leave of one year can not be carried forward to the next year.
2. Female residents will be entitled to maternity leave as per rules.
3. Male residents will be entitled for paternity leave as per rules.
4. No other leave is permissible.

- **LEAVING THE COURSE:**

Candidates selected for MD courses will have to execute a bond at the time of joining. As per terms & conditions of the bond, if a candidate discontinues the course without completion, he/she will have to pay a sum of Rs.1, 00,000/- (Rs. One lac only) to the Institute.

- **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- ❖ The date, time and venue of examination will be provided on admit card.
- ❖ No TA/DA shall be paid for appearing in the entrance examination, counseling or for joining.
- ❖ Number of seats/posts indicated in the advertisement against various programs is provisional and subject to change without prior notice.
- ❖ Any attempt on the part of a candidate to suppress facts, provide false information or influence selection directly or indirectly will be treated as a disqualification, and if selected, the services are liable to be terminated.
- ❖ Each selected candidate shall have to pay the fee/dues within the prescribed period, failing which his/her admission/appointment shall be cancelled.
- ❖ The selected candidates shall submit in original Matriculation certificate, MBBS mark sheets of all professional examination/MBBS Degree, **proof of recognition of MBBS degree from Medical Council of India**, permanent registration certificate, migration certificate or certificate of good conduct and internship completion certificate at the time of counseling.
- ❖ The training programs are full-time and continuous, and private practice in any form after joining the Institute is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ All students admitted to the Institute shall maintain good conduct, attend their classes regularly and abide by the regulations/guidelines of the Institute failing which their names are liable to be struck off the rolls of the Institute.
- ❖ Participation in any agitation, protest, strike, etc. is prohibited. Candidates not abiding with these provisions are liable to be terminated.
- ❖ **Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the Institute.**
- ❖ No intimation to unselected candidates will be sent and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- ❖ These rules are subject to change in accordance with the decisions of the Institute, taken from time to time.
- ❖ The decision of the Director, SGPGIMS, Lucknow, shall be final in the matter of selection of candidate for admission to the MD courses and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.

- **FORCE MAJEURE:**  
If the entrance examination is postponed or cancelled (in part or in full) due to any reason whatsoever beyond the control of the organizers (viz. elements of nature, force majeure or orders/directives issued by any competent government authority), the institute shall not be responsible for any loss or injury sustained by the candidates directly or indirectly.
