From the desk of the Chairman CCB

Dear Candidate,

It is my pleasure to invite you to participate in the Central Counselling process of AIEEE-2008. The two page CCB Information Leaflet given to you during the written examination provides summary of instructions for the counselling procedure to be followed this year. Due to some unavoidable circumstances the counselling date had to be rescheduled. The detailed Information Brochure on the website www.ccb.nic.in further elaborates the various phases of the process. It is to inform you that several changes have been made in the process of counselling, Participating Institutions (PIs) and their seat matrix. For latest updates in this regard, you are advised to visit our website: <http://www.ccb.nic.in>.

With a view to make the Counselling process more user friendly and transparent, several innovative features have been introduced this year. Some of the important features of the counselling process are highlighted below:

IMPORTANT FEATURES

1. A candidate can exercise choices for branch along with institution a number of times during Off-campus On-line counselling to be held from June 23 to June 29, 2008.
2. For On-campus counselling (July 4 to July 13, 2008), a candidate has to report only to that counselling centre which is based on the state of eligibility, i.e., the state from which he / she has passed his / her qualifying (+2) examination.
3. The On-campus On-line counselling will be completed in one day but candidates should come prepared to stay for another day at the designated counselling centre to meet any contingency.
4. The candidates allotted a seat may download the allotment letter from the CCB website from a place of their convenience. However, in case of any difficulty in downloading the allotment letter they may collect the same from the counselling centre.
5. The candidate's data will be verified from the original certificates on the day of counselling before he / she is allowed for registration.
6. Initial Fee deposit of Rs. 15,000/- for OP/ OBC and Rs. 5,000/- for SC/ST category will be collected in the form of a demand draft in favour of Central Counselling Board (CCB) payable at **Allahabad**. After allotment of seat the Initial Fee is transferred to the allotted Institute, if the candidate joins there.
7. During On-campus counselling, on-line submission of choices for Institutions along with branches is to be made by a candidate through Form 1 for '**offered**' seats, and for Institutions only through Form 2 (optional) for '**dropout**' seats.
8. As a special arrangement for your convenience, on allotment, you may report for admission to NITs and IITs at designated counselling centre.
9. '**Dropout**' seats will be allotted amongst the candidates who have filled Form 2 and have not been able to get seat allotment on the basis of Form 1.
10. Only the institution will be allotted against the '**dropout**' seats. The branch will be allotted later in that institution based on the merit of a candidate and number of vacant seats available in various branches there.
11. After allotment of seats against Form 2, the PIs will carry out the sliding process for re-allotment of branches according to their AIR, choices, category and sub-category. The State of eligibility will also be taken into consideration as per rules of respective PIs.
12. This year, a Second Round of counselling will be held during August 2-4, 2008. The registered candidates but without allotment can fill up choices on-line over internet for vacancies created after sliding from a place of their convenience.
13. The candidates can withdraw at any stage of counselling process and claim refund according to refund rules.

I earnestly hope that you would be able to exercise your choices judiciously taking full advantage of the flexibility built into the system. For further clarifications the counselling officers at the counselling centres will be happy to provide the necessary support. The On-line Counselling system has been designed using state of the art technology for admissions to our country's premier institutions in engineering and technology.

My best wishes to the candidates declared eligible for central counselling.

1. INTRODUCTION

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India had taken a policy decision to conduct All India Engineering Entrance Examination in 2002 (AIEEE-2002) with a view to minimize the difficulties experienced by the candidates and their guardians arising due to a large number of entrance examinations conducted for admission to undergraduate degree programmes in the disciplines of Engineering / Technology, Pharmacy and Architecture. This initiative has been widely accepted and appreciated by all.

This year Central Counselling Board (CCB) is re-constituted under the Chairmanship of Prof. Arun. B. Samaddar, Director, Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology, Allahabad. The list of CCB Members is given in the Office Memorandum of Ministry of HRD, Government of India and is placed as Annexure I.

Total 20 National Institutes of Technology (NITs), 05 IITs / IIITM / IIITDM, 07 other Central / State Government funded Institutions and 14 self financed Deemed Universities and 2 others are included for admitting candidates in the first year of Engineering / Technology and Architecture / Planning programmes commencing from academic session 2008-09 through Centralized Counselling of AIEEE-2008.

The counselling will be conducted in two phases. Phase-I will be Off-campus On-line, where **eligible** candidates can exercise their choices from a place of their convenience over internet. Phase-II will be On-campus On-line, where **eligible** candidates will be required to report at pre-specified counselling centres for final choice submission. This year the Centralized Counselling will be conducted at 18 counselling centres.

With a view to minimize the vacant seats and to reduce inconvenience to the candidates, a Second Round of on-line choice filling has been introduced. The eligible candidates may fill their choices in this round of counselling from a place of convenience during August 2-4, 2008.

Two types of choice forms, Form 1 for '**offered**' seats with both Institute & branch choices and Form 2 for Institute choices only for '**dropout**' seats have been designed. The candidates who wish to be considered for '**dropout**' seats would be required to fill Form 2 (optional) along with Form 1 on computer screen on the day of their counselling as per schedule of On-campus counselling. During Phase-I counselling also both the forms can be filled up. But final choices will have to be locked by a candidate on the day of Phase-II counselling.

Allotment against the '**offered**' seats will be for a branch in an institution while allotment against '**dropout**' seats will be only for institution (without branch). The candidates will be required to join the allotted institutions directly between July 05 to July 20, 2008 for '**offered**' seats and July 23 to July 28, 2008 for '**dropout**' seats. Further, allotment against Second Round of counselling will be made on August 4, 2008 and the successful candidates have to report to the allotted institution from August 5 to 9, 2008. It may be noted that the candidate allotted a seat only in NITs and IITs / IIITM / IIITDM may report to the allotted institutions through Remote Reporting process at their counselling centres.

Important features, counselling procedure, fee refund rules, counselling schedule, list of counselling centres, tentative list of participating institutions with total number of seats, fee structure, and contact address, seat distribution in the institutions are given in this Information Brochure. **The candidates are advised to read this Information Brochure carefully and visit our website www.ccb.nic.in regularly for updates.**

In case of any dispute arising out of the counselling process at any stage up to the final allocation of institution and branch or institution alone, the decision of Chairman, CCB shall be final.

In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be limited to Allahabad courts only (Lower, District and High court) and will not be subject to the jurisdiction of any other courts outside Allahabad.

2. SALIENT FEATURES

- The facility of Off-campus On-line counselling is provided to enable the candidates to assess institution and branches likely to be available at their merit. During Off-campus counselling the candidates can fill Form-2 also.
- Opening Rank (OR) and Closing Rank (CR) of candidates admitted in different institutions and branches last year have been put up on the Web. The candidates can take advantage of this data before exercising their choices during Off-campus and On-campus counselling.

- During On-campus counselling (Phase-II), on-line submission and locking of choices are to be made on Form 1 as well as Form 2 (strongly recommended although optional) for 'offered' and 'dropout' seats, respectively.
- 'Dropout' seats will be allotted only to those candidates who have filled Form 2 and have not been able to get seat allotment on the basis of Form 1, provided they have not withdrawn before Form 2 allotment.
- Only the institution will be allotted against the 'dropout' seats. The branch will be allotted later by the institution based on the merit among the students joining it and number of vacant seats in various branches available there.
- **The last submitted choices during Off-campus counselling (Phase-I) will appear in Form 1 and Form 2 (if filled during Off-campus counselling) on day of On-campus counselling. The candidates will be free to re-order, delete or add choices for final submission in both the forms.**
- Some of the institutions have restrictions on qualifications, age, gender and categories as given in section 4.3. The candidates are advised not to exercise their choices if they find themselves not eligible for such institutions. **If they fill their choices for such institutes knowingly or otherwise, CCB will not be held responsible.**
- The Second Round of counselling has been specifically planned with a view to minimize number of vacant seats.

3. COUNSELLING PROCEDURE

The counselling procedure is divided into two stages, Main Counselling and Second Round of Counselling.

3.1. Main Counselling:

The main counselling procedure is divided in two phases:

Phase-I: Off-campus On-line Counselling (June 23 - June 29, 2008)

Phase-II: On-campus On-line Counselling (July 4 - July 13, 2008)

The detailed procedure is described below:

3.1.1 Phase-I: Off-campus On-line Counselling

1. During this phase, candidates found eligible for counselling by CBSE, on the basis of AIEEE-2008 results are required to exercise their initial choices of branches and institutions by filling Form 1 through Internet (www.ccb.nic.in) from places of their convenience. The candidates may contact the nearby PI for availing the Internet facility free of charge.
2. For Off-campus counselling a candidate has to log on to the website www.ccb.nic.in and click on "off-campus counselling".
3. Engineering and Architecture streams will appear on the computer screen; click on the desired stream.
4. Register as a new candidate by clicking on "New candidate!! Register here" link. Read the instructions given on the screen and click on "Register".
5. The candidate is required to enter the details as printed in the Admit Card.
6. The procedure for exercising choices or seeking other information is menu-driven. It guides the candidates through appropriate messages on the computer screen.
7. Information relating to institutions, disciplines (Engineering / Technology and Architecture / Planning), branches (e.g., Electronics Engineering, Computer Science, etc.) and categories (OP, OBC, SC, ST, etc.) will be available through each relevant dropdown menu for the purpose of exercising choices as well as for a feel of their competitive standing for their preferred choices among the logged-in candidates.
8. The state of eligibility will automatically appear on the screen as per the data filled by the candidate in AIEEE-2008 application form. Candidate will not be allowed to change his / her state of eligibility during Off-campus counselling. The state code of eligibility, however, can be changed, only if it is wrongly mentioned, during the On-campus counselling in the presence of a counselling official after proper verification.
9. The name of counselling centre based on state of eligibility will also be displayed on computer screen during Phase-I.

10. The candidates are permitted, if they so desire, to change or re-order their choices, delete earlier choices and add new choices any number of times based on the information which will appear on the computer screen. The candidates are free to consult their parents, teachers, friends and others for advice during Phase-I.
11. The Off-campus counselling will facilitate the selection of the most appropriate discipline, institution and branch at candidate's rank and in their categories for submitting their final choices during On-campus counselling.
12. Choices will be processed and indicative seat allocation will be put on the web at frequent intervals. The dates of next update of indicative seat allocation will be displayed on the website.
13. Form-2 (optional) can also be filled during Off-campus counselling.
14. Candidates must fill their address for correspondence during the Off-campus counselling. The same address will be used for future communication and sending the refund, if any.

3.1.2 Phase-II: On-campus On-line Counselling

Eligible candidates will be required to report at specified counselling centres (Table 6) in accordance with their state of eligibility, which will be displayed on computer screen during Phase-I. The Phase-II counselling will be completed in one day. However, the candidates are advised to come prepared to stay for two days, if required, to meet any contingency. They can download the admission letter from a place of their convenience.

(a) The Counselling Procedure

1. On the scheduled (AIR based) counselling date (Table 4), the candidates will report to the document verification counters for verification of their Certificates and Admit Card. Candidates are required to bring all certificates in original along with one photocopy of each and four copies of their photograph identical to the one pasted on the AIEEE 2008 application form. **If the original certificates are not in English, duly certified English version / translation of such certificates will be required.**
2. Thereafter, the candidates will proceed to fee deposit counters. Initial Fee deposit of Rs. 15,000/- for OP and OBC candidates and Rs. 5,000/- for SC / ST candidates will be collected at the computerized fee counters. The deposit is to be made through a **demand draft** in favour of **CCB** payable at **Allahabad**. This amount will be transferred to the allotted institution and adjusted in the fee to be deposited there.
3. **Discrepancies related to category, sub-category, gender and state of eligibility in the computer record generated on the basis of AIEEE 2008 application form earlier submitted by the candidate to CBSE will be rectified by the competent authority at the counselling centre on the basis of the original certificates.** Candidates must give their address for correspondence, where the cheques for refund of Initial Fee deposit may be sent, if required. A printout of the duly authenticated modified record will be given to the candidate.
4. Any change in the candidate's name and father's name shall not be permitted under any circumstances.
5. Candidates must ensure in their own interest, that their state of eligibility, category, sub-category and gender are mentioned correctly on the printout given to them after verification.
6. After verification of certificates and depositing the Initial Fee, the candidates will be required to exercise their final choices of seats On-line by using Form 1 to indicate the choices of institutions with branch in order of their preference.
7. The status of the available seats will be displayed for the guidance of candidates.
8. **Form 1 will show the choices last submitted during Off-campus counselling. During On-campus counselling candidates are free to change these choices as they may like.**
9. In order to be considered for the '**dropout**' seats, candidates must also submit Form 2 on-line indicating their choices for institutions only. For the candidates who failed to get an '**offered**' seat against Form 1, the Form 2 will be processed for allotment of the institution for admission without branch. The branch will be allotted later by the institution where admitted with due consideration of merit among the students joining it.
10. **After filling the choices through 'Form 1' and / or 'Form 2', the candidate must get the choices locked. Candidate must ensure in their own interest that the choices have been locked. If the choices have not been locked, the FORM 1 and FORM 2 WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**

11. After locking of the choices, the candidates will collect two copies of printouts for each of the choice forms submitted by them. Both copies are to be signed by the candidate and the competent authority at the counselling centre. The same must be verified by the candidate and one copy of each of Form 1 and Form 2 returned to the authorized person at the counselling centre.

(b) Allotment Letter

The choices submitted through Form 1 on the scheduled date of counselling will be processed centrally late in the evening and the list of candidates who would be allotted an institution along with a branch for admission will be displayed on our website. The candidates are required to download the allotment letter from the website www.ccb.nic.in from a place of their convenience. In case of any difficulty in downloading the allotment letter they can contact the counselling centre.

(c) Reporting at PIs or Remote Reporting (for IITs, IIITM and IIITDM only) at Designated Counselling Centre

For admission, the successful candidates are to report to the allotted institution during the period July 5-20, 2008 for 'offered' seats, *failing which their allotment will be cancelled*. The seats thus falling vacant will be considered as 'dropout' seats for which allotment will be made on the basis of Form 2.

A facility of Remote Reporting has been introduced at the Counselling Centres for the benefit of the candidates selected only in NITs / IITs / IIITM. The candidates may use this facility under emergent conditions.

(d) Multiple Allotment

The candidates who have been selected both in Engineering and Architecture disciplines will be given option to retain any one allotment of their choice. The candidates will be required to withdraw the other allotment and surrender the corresponding allotment letter.

3.1.3 Allotment Against Dropout Seats

1. The choices submitted through Form 2 for 'dropout' seats will be processed and list of candidates who would be allotted an institution against 'dropout' seats on the basis of AIR for each category will be displayed on website on July 23, 2008. These candidates will be required to directly report at the allotted institution for admission during July 23-28, 2008 (*failing which their allotment will be cancelled*).
2. **No allotment letter will be given at the Counselling Centres for allotment against 'dropout' seats.** The candidates have to directly report to the allotted institutions on the basis of allotment results as displayed on the CCB website.
3. The allotment of the branches to the candidates admitted to various PIs against 'dropout' seats will be made during July 28-30, 2008 by the allotted Institutions.
4. With a view to minimize the number of 'dropout' and 'un-availed' seats, a Second Round of centralised counselling has been introduced.

3.2 Second Round of Counselling

Only those registered candidates who had neither been allotted seats nor withdrawn will be allowed to participate in the Second Round of Counselling during August 2 - 4, 2008. For this, the candidates will not be required to be present physically at the Counselling Centres. They can fill their choices On-line from a place of their convenience. The choice filling form will be similar to Form 1 but without State specific seats as these seats will be converted to All India Seats wherever applicable.

The result of Second Round of Counselling will be published on the website on August 4, 2008. The candidates are required to report to the allotted Institutions from August 5 - 9, 2008.

4. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

4.1 Academic Qualifications

The academic qualifications as prescribed in Information Bulletin and Application Form of AIEEE-2008 are applicable for this counselling. These are reproduced below.

- The minimum academic qualification for admission through AIEEE-2008 is a pass in the final examination of 10+2 (Class XII), or its equivalent, referred to as the qualifying examination. Those appearing in 10+2 (Class XII) final, or equivalent, examination and whose results are not declared may also appear in counselling. Such candidates will be admitted provisionally, subject to the submission of proof of passing in qualifying examination latest by September 15, 2008 at the allotted institution. In case they fail to comply with this deadline for providing the proof of passing in the qualifying examination, their admission will stand cancelled.
- Subject combinations required in the qualifying examination for admission to B.E. / B.Tech and B.Arch. / B. Planning Courses shall be as under (Table 1):

4.2 Date of Birth

Only those candidates whose date of birth falls on or after October 01, 1983 are eligible for admission. However, in the case of Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Physically Challenged (PH) candidates, upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years. Date of birth as recorded in the Secondary Education Board class X (High School) certificate only will be taken as authentic.

4.3 Restrictions on Qualifications, Gender, Age and Categories

There are some restrictions over and above the eligibility requirements as given above in some Institutions / Branches as detailed in the Table 2:

Note: (1) The software may not be able to stop submission of choices not allowed as per restrictions stated in this table. Efforts have been made to warn about such restrictions for admission through pop-up messages whenever the institution / branch is clicked by a candidate. **Candidates must read these restrictions carefully and they should not submit choices if they find themselves not eligible as per the restrictions given herein. If they fail to follow these instructions, even after formal issue of the allotment letter the admission would be denied by that institution and responsibility for the same would lie exclusively with them. The Central Counselling Board would not be responsible for denial of admission in such cases.**

(2) **Female Candidates for Mining Courses:** Section 46 (1) of the Mines Act, 1952 states that "No woman shall, notwithstanding anything contained in any other law, be employed (a) in any part of a mine which is below ground, (b) in any mine above ground except between the hours 6 a.m. and 7 p.m."

List of Qualifying Examinations

- The 10+2 level examination of any recognized Central / State Board of Secondary Examination, such as Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, and Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi.
- Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board / University.
- Final Examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defense Academy.
- Any Public School / Board / University Examination in India or in foreign countries recognized by the Association of Indian Universities as equivalent to 10+2 system.
- H.S.C. Vocational Examination.
- A pass grade in the Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Open School with a minimum of five subjects. Proof of place of examination centre of the final examination from the National Open School will be required for determination of State of Eligibility.
- 3 or 4-year diploma recognized by AICTE or a State Board of Technical Education.

5. RESERVATION OF SEATS

Some seats in NITs, other Centrally Funded Institutions and some Deemed Universities are reserved for OBC, SC, ST and PH candidates. In NITs and BIT, Ranchi (Mesra, Deoghar & Patna), the seats are state specific and will be allotted as per the state of eligibility.

The candidates as per AIEEE 2008 records shall only be considered as OBC/SC/ST for Central Counselling. OBC candidates will have to satisfy the caste and Creamy Layer requirements detailed on the following National Commission for Backward Classes (ncbc) websites:

5.1 Category Rules

There are four vertical categories, namely, Open (OP), Other Backward Class (OBC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Scheduled Caste (SC). In addition, there is only one horizontal reservation for Physically Challenged (PH). If a candidate is found to possess an invalid certificate of category he / she will be assigned a new category as detailed in Table-3.

Note: The Social Welfare Department of Government of Maharashtra will validate certificate for OBC, SC and ST category issued from Maharashtra State to be obtained in CCB format (Annexure II & III). It is therefore compulsory for the candidates to submit validity certificate alongwith category certificate (in CCB format).

5.2 Change of Category to OP

If a candidate is not able to produce required category certificate (OBC / SC / ST) or the certificate is found invalid, his / her category will be changed to OP category. Accordingly he / she will be required to deposit Initial Fee of Rs 15000/-.

6. CERTIFICATES AND CREDENTIALS FOR ON-CAMPUS (PHASE II) REGISTRATION

Following certificates and credentials in original with their photocopies will be required at the time of On-campus On-line counselling;

- (i) Score Card issued by CBSE, indicating the AIR in AIEEE-2008 of eligible candidate.
- (ii) Admit Card of AIEEE-2008.
- (iii) Class X (High School) Board Certificate as a proof of date of birth.
- (iv) Certificate of qualifying examination.
- (v) Marks sheet of qualifying examination.
- (vi) Certificate of category (OBC / SC / ST), if applicable, issued by the competent authority (Annexure II / III).
- (vii) Certificate for Physically Challenged (PH) (Annexure IV).
- (viii) Four photographs identical to the one pasted on the application form.
- (ix) Demand Draft of Rs. 15,000/- (Rs. 5,000/- for SC / ST) in favour of **CCB payable at Allahabad**.
- (x) Passport of the candidates who have passed qualifying examination from outside India for determination of the State of Eligibility.
- (xi) Proof of place of examination centre of the final examination from the National Open School for candidates having Senior Secondary Certificate for determination of the State of Eligibility.

Note: English version / translation of certificates will be required at the time of counselling.

Note:

- i) The candidates are required to offer their choices only on scheduled counselling date of their turn, but they are advised to come prepared to stay for the next day as a contingency measure.
- ii) The seat allotment results will be declared everyday after the counselling and will be available on the CCB website.
- iii) The successful candidates are not compulsorily required to go to Counselling Centre for collecting the allotment letter on allotment date. They can download the same from a place of convenience.
- iv) Candidates once appeared for On-campus counselling for one type of courses, say, Engineering / Technology shall not be permitted to appear again on subsequent days in the counselling for the same courses.
- v) No more rounds of Counselling at Counselling Centres shall be held. The vacant (or drop out) seats shall be filled on the basis of choices of Form 2 (without Branch) and Second Round of Counselling.
- vi) Only those candidates, who registered themselves during On-campus counselling and could not get a seat, will be permitted to fill their choices during Second Round Counselling.
- vii) The candidates, who could not report for counselling on the specified date, may report on any subsequent date during main counselling for Engineering / Technology. However, the seats will be allotted based on the availability of the seats at that point of time.

9. COUNSELLING CENTRES

Candidates are required to report on the designated Counselling Centre only. The Counselling Centre of the eligible candidates for On-campus On-line counselling is determined on the basis of State of Eligibility. For example, if a candidate has passed / appeared for his / her qualifying examination from Haryana, his / her counselling centre shall be National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra, Haryana. 10. INITIAL FEE DEPOSIT, REFUND AND WITHDRAWAL RULES

For registration during On-campus counselling the candidates will have to report to the designated counselling centres. They would be required to make an Initial Fee deposit of Rs. 15,000/- (Rs. 5,000/- for SC / ST candidates) through demand draft in favour of **CCB** payable at **Allahabad**. For all such candidates who are allotted seat and who take admission in the allotted Institution, the amount of this Initial Fee would be adjusted towards the total fee payable by the candidate at that Institution.

10.1 Refund Rules

The refund rules have been made as per the guidelines of AICTE and MHRD. Initial Fee will be refunded after deducting 10% of the Initial Fee deposit or Rs. 1000/- which ever is less from the Initial Fee to the candidates withdrawing from the counselling process at any stage of counselling. **Refund after taking admission in the allotted institute will be as per Refund Rules of the institute.**

Note: For candidates seeking withdrawal from the counselling process on or before August 09, 2008, DDs deposited by the candidates will be returned after receiving the balance amount (i.e., the difference between the amount of draft and refund due). **The candidates can get back original DD deposited by them, after payment of the balance amount upto August 09, 2008.** Otherwise, a cheque of the balance amount will be sent by post at the address given by the candidate during On-line On-campus counselling (Phase-II).

10.2. Method of Withdrawal / Cancellation

A candidate is free to withdraw from the counselling process at any stage and is entitled for refund of Initial Fee as per the rules mentioned in section 10.1. For this, the candidate first has to go to the withdrawal counter. The candidate will be given computer generated withdrawal slips, which will be carried by him / her to the fee counter to claim the refund.

11. PARTICIPATING INSTITUTIONS AND THEIR FEE STRUCTURE

Name, address, phone, fax and e-mail, and fee structure of participating institutions are given in Tables 7-11. Interested candidates are advised to use the information given here to contact institutions for any clarifications before coming to the Counselling Centres. Total number of offered seats to be filled through centralized counselling by CCB is also indicated. For breakup of offered seats branch-wise and category-wise please refer Section 12. The fee structure shown in the Tables is indicative of expenditure on tuition, mess and hostel per annum / semester as given by the Participating Institutions. The fee is to be paid every semester or every year and differs from institution to institution.

It may be emphasized that the following information has been compiled to provide an idea of fee structure at various institutions. However, it does not exclude the possibility of its revision by the institutions.

12.1 National Institutes of Technology (NITs)

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Re-constitution of Central Counselling Board (CCB) for all India Engineering Entrance Examination (AIEEE), 2008.

An All India Engineering Entrance Examination (AIEEE) is being conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) since 2002 for admissions to undergraduate courses in Engineering, Architecture (including Planning) and Pharmacy in participating Institutions [notably National Institutes of Technology (NITs), Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs) etc.]. First Central Counselling Board was set up vide Order No.F.17-7/2002-TS.I dated 27th March, 2002. Thereafter, a Central Counselling Board (CCB) was constituted vide this Department's Office Memorandum No.F.17-7/2002 – TS.I dated 23rd June, 2004 to organize centralized counselling and allocation of seats for filling up seats in NITs, IIITs and certain other Institutions. Subsequently, CCB were re-constituted by MHRD/CBSE during 2005, 2006 and 2007. The Board was last constituted for 2007, vide CBSE's OM No. HoD/PA/2007 dated 9th April, 2007, which was based on this Ministry's letter No. 17-21/2006 – TS.I dated 4th April, 2007 addressed to the CBSE.

2. In supersession of CBSE's OM dated 9th April, 2007 referred in para 1 above, the Central Counselling Board (CCB) is hereby re-constituted as under with immediate effect:-

(5)	Director, National Institute of Technology, Calicut (Kerala).	–	Member
(6)	Director, Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology, Surat (Gujarat).	–	Member

3. The Central Counselling Board shall be responsible for allocation of seats to be filled up on All India Basis as per the results of AIEEE, in participating Institutions. For this purpose, the CCB shall ensure compilation and wide dissemination of information relating to institutions, highlighting peculiar learning environment in each of the Institute, wherever applicable. CCB would be specifically responsible for:-

- (a) Finalization of counselling procedure and schedule;
- (b) Finalization of counselling centres and making necessary arrangements at the counselling centres;
- (c) Printing of brochure-cum-option form;
- (d) Maintenance of web site;
- (e) Fixation of counselling fees and deposits, if any;
- (f) Distribution and collection of option forms;
- (g) Laying down procedure for verification of certificates and credentials;
- (h) Coordinate with concerned agencies counselling against State/UT quota of seats; and
- (i) Any other Tasks related to counselling and allocation of seats against All India quota.

4. For the above purposes, CCB shall meet as often as required. The Board shall hold its extended meetings with all or some of the participating Institutions to facilitate close interaction and coordination. All participating Institutions shall provide to the Board necessary assistance as may be required by it. On matters of policy, Board shall abide by the directions of the Central Government, issued from time to time.
