## NOTIFICATION FOR ALL INDIA PRE-VETERINARY TEST-2008 FOR ADMISSION TO B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE COURSE

Veterinary Council of India invites applications for appearing of the entrance examination for filling up 15% of total number of seats to be filled on Merit in Veterinary Colleges in India (except Jammu & Kashmir State) from Indian Nationals for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course for academic session 2008-2009.

**Note:-** Students from the State of Jammu & Kashmir are not eligible to appear in this test, as that State has not adopted the provisions of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 in the State of Jammu & Kashmir. The details may be seen in the Information Bulletin/website.

- 1. DATE AND VENUE OF EXAMINATION :** Saturday, the 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2008 (time 2 to 5 P.M.) at the centers (cities) stated in the Information Bulletin/Website.
- 2. DURATION OF COURSE:** The duration of B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course is spread over five complete academic years including a compulsory rotating internship of six months.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :**

### **Qualifying Examination:**

- (i) A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination equivalent to 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination ( after a period of 12 years of study) the last two years of study with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and any other elective subject with English at a level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the National Council for Education Research and Training or equivalent qualification as prescribed in the Veterinary Council of India - Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education –Degree Course (B.V.Sc. & A.H) Regulations, 1993.

OR

Candidates who have passed the B.Sc. examination from a recognised University with not less than two of the following subjects - Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany/ Zoology), and has passed the earlier qualifying examination with the following subjects - Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

- (ii) To be eligible for appearing in entrance examination, the candidates must have passed the qualifying Examination obtaining not less than 50% of the aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. In respect of candidates belonging to the SC/ST or other special category of students as specified by the Government from time to time, marks required at the qualifying examination shall be 10% less than that prescribed for general category.
- (iii) A candidate who is taking up the qualifying examination prior to the Entrance Examination, or whose result is awaited, may also apply and take the examination but he/she shall not be eligible for admission to the B.V.Sc. & A.H. Programme, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required percentage of marks as prescribed at 3(ii) above, on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 and submit the documentary proof during counseling, if selected.

### **4 Age:-**

- (i) The candidate has attained or will attain age of **seventeen (17) years** on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2008.

### **5 How to submit the Application Form:-**

A desirous Candidate can submit the Application Form for the All India Pre – Veterinary Test in the following two ways:-

#### **(A) Online:**

Online submission of application may be made by accessing the Council's website [www.vci-india.in](http://www.vci-india.in) Candidates are required to take a printout of the Online Application Form after successful submission of data Online. The print out of the computer generated Form, complete in all respect as applicable for offline submission should be sent to the Controller of Examination, Veterinary Council of India, 'A' Wing, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi- 110066 by registered / speed post only. Candidate

should remit the examination fee Rs. 700/- for General/Other category and Rs. 350/- for SC/ST Category through a Demand Draft in favour of the "Veterinary Council of India Examination Fund" payable at New Delhi drawn on any nationalized bank. Instructions for online submission of Application form will be made available on the website [www.vci-india.in](http://www.vci-india.in) w.e.f. 01.01.2008 (10.00 A.M.) to 15.2.2008 (5.00 P.M.).

**(B) Offline:**

In case, copies of Application Forms are sold out before the last date at any of the branches and the same are not available with Vijaya Bank/Designated centres of Council, the candidate should get the same from the office of the Veterinary Council of India, "A" Wing, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, August Kranti Bhawan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi-66 by sending Demand Drafts as stated above. The request along with Demand Draft should reach office of Council on or before 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2008. In such case, the candidates may submit Online application as detailed above.

No correspondence regarding purchase of Information Bulletin and Application Form will be entertained after closing date of sale. **General candidates applying on Forms meant for SC/ST category shall be rejected.**
