About GENET

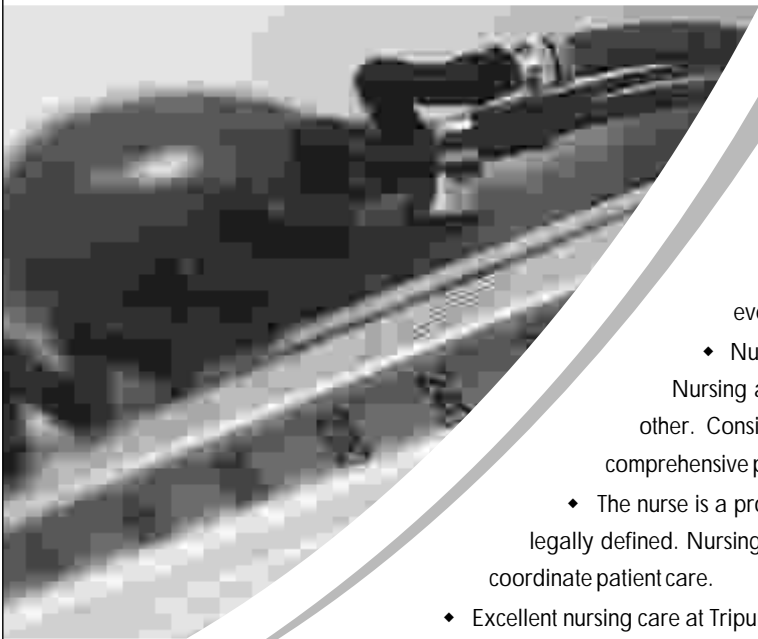

Recognition

Basic B.Sc Nursing

The session will start in December, 2007. The course body has an intake of 60 students per year. Recognised both by Indian Nursing Council and State Council, this programme is aimed at developing competent and professional nursing Practitioners who are pro-active and responsible both in clinical and teaching set-up.

Admission Requirements

Eligibility :

- ♦ Pass in 10 + 2 with subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English.
- ♦ 50% and above of the total marks in subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English) of the Qualifying examination.
- ♦ Minimum age : 17 years at the time of admission.

Entrance Test

All candidates should appear for the Entrance Test conducted by Tripura College of Nursing for admission. Entrance Test will be conducted in English medium only and shall be of objective type. The distribution of marks and duration of the exam will be as below. The answers shall be of multiple choices for which an answer sheet shall be provided to mark the answer

- A) Completed application form.
- B) Two recent passport size photograph, same as the one pasted on the application form.
- D) Attested copy of qualifying examination mark sheet.
- E) Date of birth proof (Birth certificate with name, Passport, School Leaving Certificate, Passing Certificate)
- F) Attested copy of Community certificate in case of SC/ST candidates.

The application should reach the college on or before 21st November, after which the college shall not accept any applications. The college does not take any responsibility for applications not received by it.

Publication of Results

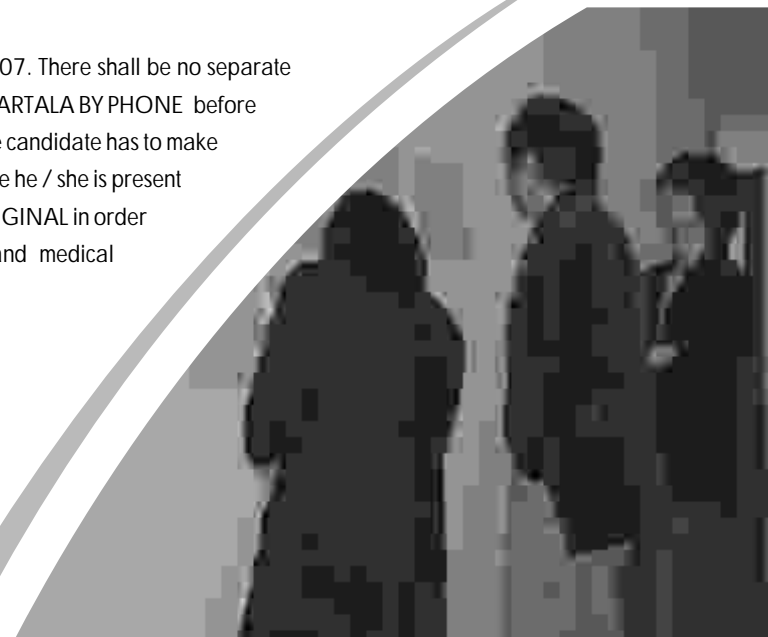
Results & Ranking will be available on our website www.trimedcol.com by the 28th of November 2007. There shall be no separate communication from the college in this regard. Candidates will be required to contact our office at AGARTALA BY PHONE before 29th November 2007 4.00 PM failing which the seat will be offered to the next ranking candidate. The candidate has to make his own travel and boarding arrangement to reach Agartala along with his parent / guardian to ensure he / she is present for the counselling on 30th November 2007. The candidate has to bring along all his documents in ORIGINAL in order to complete admission process. The admission can be confirmed only after the counselling and medical

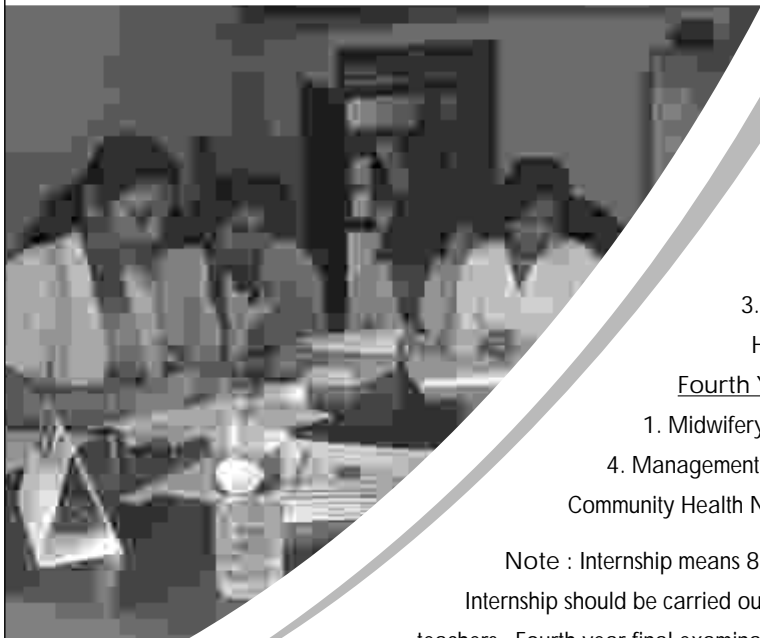
Admission Procedure

Candidates called for admission must produce the following in ORIGINAL at the time of counselling:

- i. Hall ticket of entrance examination.
- ii. Proof of date of birth.
- iii. Proof of residence
- iv. Original mark sheet HSC or its Equivalent examination.
- v. Original pass certificate of HSC or its Equivalent examination.
- vi. Original Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended.
- vii. Migration Certificate from the Board which conducted the plus two examination or the University from where candidate passed his/her 12th examination
- viii. In case of SC / ST, a community certificate, recently obtained from the competent authority a Revenue officer not below the rank of Tahsildar.
- ix. Two Passport Size colour photographs recently taken.

Note: if any of the above original certificates is found defective, the candidates' admission will be forfeited. If the certificates are found in any other language other than English, the English translation attested by a gazetted officer should be produced. Candidates must preserve and produce the Hall Tickets at the time of interview as well as admission.





Programme Duration

Duration of the course will be 4 years. The whole course has been divided into four yearly terms. Regular classes will begin after the admission to the course. The details of the course content are as follows:

4. Practical & Viva Voce-Medical Surgical Nursing II, Child Health, Mental Health Nursing

Fourth Year

1. Midwifery & obstetrical Nursing
2. Community Health Nursing II
3. Nursing Research Statistics
4. Management of Nursing Services & Education
5. Practical & Viva Voc - Midwifery & obstetrical Nursing, Community Health Nursing

Note : Internship means 8 hours of integrated clinical duties per day in which evening and night shift duties are included. Internship should be carried out as 8 hours per day @48 hours per week. Students during internship will be supervised by nursing teachers. Fourth year final examination will be held only after completing internship.

Attendance , Progress and Conduct .

Each students must have a certificate of satisfactory attendance, progress and conduct to be eligible for appearing in the university examination. Minimum 80% attendance is required in theory and 100% attendance in practicals in each subject.

Internal Assessment

There shall be an internal assessment which follows broadly the principles enunciated by the university in each subject for which 20% of the marks are set apart and these will be added to the final marks in the university examinations. There shall be a minimum of 2 assignment and 3 periodicals test in every subject each year to assess the progress of the candidates.

If a candidate fails in an examination , his/her internal assessment marks shall be assured again only if she/he is a regular student for the second attempt.

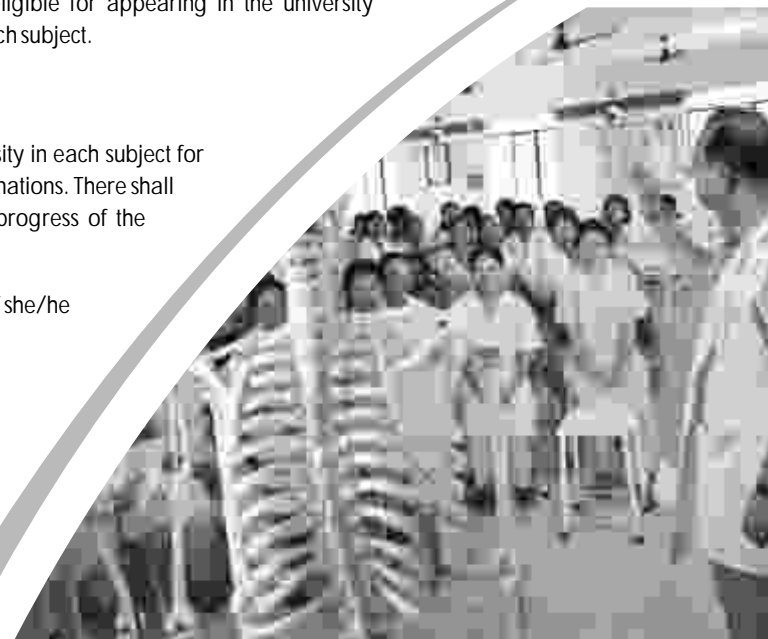
FEES

The tuition fees has been fixed by Tripura University
Apart from the tuition fee, the students will be required to pay Hostel and Mess fee, University fee, and Refundable caution deposit, and any other fee as required.

All candidates admitted to BSc Nursing course must remit the tuition and other fees on the day of admission by way of demand draft in favour of "TRIPURA COLLEGE OF NURSING" payable at AGARTALA. Request for extension of time for payment of fee will not be considered.

For Candidates opting to discontinue the study from day of admission to one week of commencement of classes, 90% of tuition fee will be refunded, while 10% of the tuition fee will be retained as administrative charges. After this period but before one month 50% of tuition fees alone will be refunded. After one-month period no Tuition fee will be refunded. Other fees will be refunded after proportionate deduction.

Candidates will be deemed to have withdrawn if they remain absent for more than 30 days from the date of admission.





Clinical Experience

Clinical Experience will be at Tripura Medical College & Dr. B.R Ambedkar Memorial Teaching Hospital which has over 350 beds covering all the disciplines including ICU, ICCU and super specialties like Cardiology, Neurology, Nephrology, Dental Surgeries, Plastic Surgeries etc. Students are rotated through all the departments.

Tripura College of Nursing has a well- equipped Audio-visual Aids department headed by a senior faculty member.

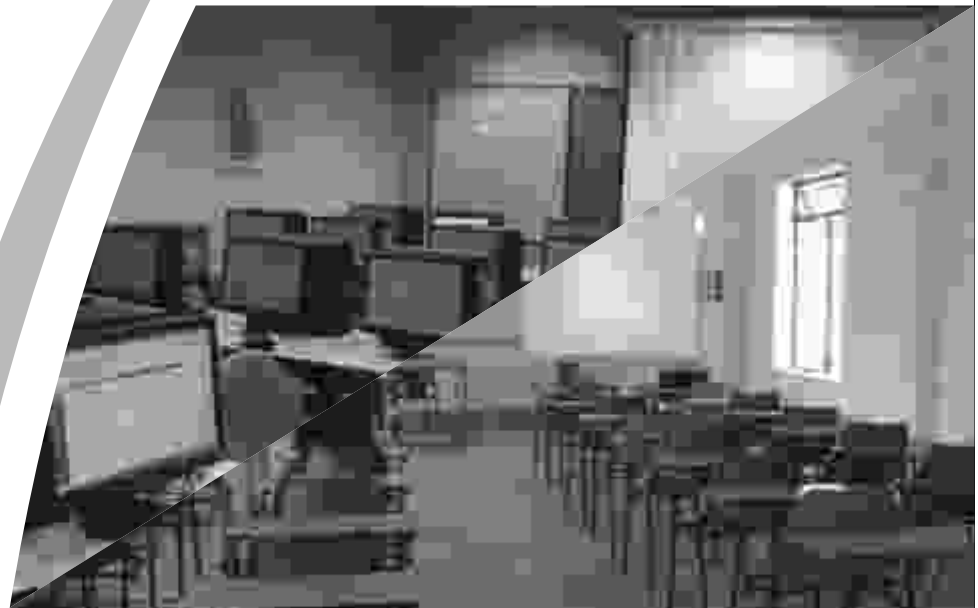
The equipments available are:-

Library

We are proud to say that our library is well ventilated , spacious with comfortable seating arrangements . There is a full time qualified and well experienced Librarian who manages the library . There is a Separate journal room and an adjacent reading room which students can utilize . We have more than 1000 books of latest edition on various subjects of the syllabus, and new journals at National and International levels. Our library is computerised too, and will soon provide e - library with internet facility .





Recreation

The institute provides facility for indoor games like table tennis, carom boards, chess boards etc. There is also an outdoor game facility for badminton and cricket.

Hostel

Separate Hostel for girls and boys with canteen facility is provided. Students are accommodated in rooms that are spacious with proper ventilation. A Warden is appointed to look after the general administration of the hostel and to see that the students adhere to the rules & regulations.

Rules & Regulations

Hostel

Going Out

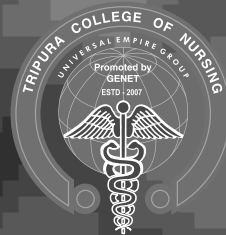
Students will be permitted to go out only on Sunday after getting permission from the principal and should report back to the hostel once they return. Students must not leave the hostel campus after 6 pm.
