POSTGRADUATE MEDICAL ENTRANCE EXAMINATION - 2011

1. GENERAL

HIHT University has been granted deemed to be University status vide notification no. F.9-43/2006-U.3(A) dated 6th June, 2007 by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development. For details about the University please visit our website www.hihtuniversity.org.

The University invites application from the eligible candidates for admission into various postgraduate medical courses conducted by its medical college (Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences). The details of the course are as follows:-

2. DURATION OF COURSE

For Doctor of Medicine (MD) & Master of Surgery (MS): Three years from the date of admission. However, exemption of one year shall be granted to students having a recognized two years postgraduate diploma in the same subject.

For Diploma: Two years from the date of admission.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (i) A candidate, who holds MBBS degree or an equivalent qualification and who has obtained permanent registration with the Medical Council of India (MCI) or any of the State Medical Council(s) after completing compulsory rotating internship shall be eligible to take this examination.
- (ii) However, a candidate who after passing the final qualifying examination (MBBS or equivalent examination), is undergoing 12 month compulsory rotating internship and is likely to complete the same by 31st March, 2011 can take up this examination. The candidate must produce a certificate from the head of institution that he/she will be completing internship by 31st March, 2011. But he/she will not be eligible for admission unless he/she has completed the compulsory rotating internship and obtained full registration on or before 31st March, 2011.

4. METHOD OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- (i) A candidate seeking admission to the Entrance Examination is required to send his/her application in the prescribed format which can be downloaded from our website www.hihtuniversity.org.
- (ii) The candidate should fill in the application form in his/her own handwriting (in capital letters) clearly and legibly.
- (iii) Furnishing of false information or suppression of material information in the application form will entail disqualification and shall render the candidate unfit for admission. If ineligibility is detected at any stage, the candidature/admission will be treated as cancelled and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained. Further, the intimation in this regard will be sent to M.C.I. and concerned medical college for necessary action.
- (iv) Incomplete application form will be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained by the University in this regard.
- (v) It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that the correct address is filled in the Application Forms. **The University shall not be responsible for any loss in transit or for incorrect address given by the applicant in the Application Form.**
- (vi) No candidate should submit more than one application. However, if submission of another application becomes necessary for any reason, the word “**Duplicate**” be clearly mentioned in red ink on top of the second application. Failure to do so may entail rejection of both applications.

- (vii) Since allotment of seats is made through **personal appearance**, candidates are not required to give their choice of subject at the time of submission of application form.
- (viii) Candidate is required to go through the check list before sending his/her application form.
- (ix) Application form complete in all respect alongwith a Demand draft for ₹ 2000/- (rupees two thousand only) should be sent to the **Controller of Examinations, HIHT University, Swami Ram Nagar, Doiwala, Dehradun 248140 (Uttarakhand)** by speed post/registered post or deposited by hand at the office of the Controller of Examinations. Application received after the prescribed last date will be rejected.
- (x) Demand Draft shall be in favour of **HIHT University payable at State Bank of India, Jolly Grant (Branch code No- 10580), Dehradun**

NOTE: Candidates are strongly advised not to approach any individual or agency for admission. This University has no branches and no individual/agency is authorized to act on its behalf. Admission to all the Post Graduate courses is solely based on the merit list of Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination (PGMEE) conducted by the University.

5. CHECK LIST

Before sending the Application form, candidate must ensure that self attested photocopies of the following documents are sent along with duly filled Application Form.

- (i) Date of birth certificate or High School certificate containing date of birth.
- (ii) Mark sheets of MBBS examinations (all professional examinations).
- (iii) MBBS degree or Provisional passing certificate.
- (iv) Internship completion certificate or certificate from the college principal that Internship will be completed on or before 31st March 2011.
- (v) Three self addressed registered envelopes.
- (vi) Two recent passport size coloured photographs (photographs should be same as affixed on the application form and the admit card).

6. INSTRUCTION FOR PHOTOGRAPHS

- (i) Two recent clear passport size coloured photographs **with white/light background** are required. Polaroid photographs are NOT acceptable.
- (ii) Photographs **MUST** be snapped on or after 01-09-2010.
- (iii) Photograph must be taken with name of candidate (as in application) and date of taking photograph.



Example:

- Important:**
- (a) The photograph must be snapped with a placard indicating name and date of taking photograph. In case name and date are written on the photograph after taking it, the application will be rejected.
 - (b) The name and date on the photograph must be clear and legible.

- (iv) Applicants should not wear any cap, goggles, while being photographed.
- (v) One photograph should be **pasted** (NOT stapled) on the Application Form and the other on the Admit Card.
- (vi) The photograph on the Application Form must be attested by a Gazetted Officer/Principal with a legible stamp. The photograph on the **Admit Card is NOT to be attested.**
- (vii) Few identical photographs should be kept in reserve.

7. IMPORTANT DATES

- (i) **Last Date for Submission of Application Forms : 31st January 2011**
- (ii) **Date of Entrance Examination : 13th February, 2011 (Sunday) from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM**

8. EXAMINATION CENTRE

The Postgraduate Medical Entrance Examination - 2011 will be held in **New Delhi**.

9. ADMIT CARD

- (i) In case a candidate does not receive the Admit Card by 7th February 2011, he/she should immediately get in touch with the Controller of Examinations with duly attested passport size photograph and proof of sending application form, so that Duplicate Admit Card can be issued. Last date for issue of duplicate admit card shall be 11th February 2011 (04:00 pm).
- (ii) The University bears no responsibility for non-receipt of Admit Card due to loss in transit or on any other ground. Efforts to procure the duplicate admit card, from office of the Controller of Examinations, is the sole responsibility of the candidate.
- (iii) Candidates are advised to preserve the Admit Card till allotment of seat. **Duplicate Admit Card will not be issued after the examination.**
- (iv) No candidate will be allowed to enter the Examination Hall / Venue of allotment of seats (by personal appearance) without valid Admit Card in original.

10. CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION

- (i) Candidate should report at the Examination centre on Sunday, the **13th February, 2011 at 9:00 AM**. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall after 9:45 AM.
- (ii) The Examination will start sharp at 10:00 AM. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before the expiry of 3 (three) hours i.e. 1:00 PM.
- (iii) Candidate must bring his own Pen, pencils and eraser.
- (iv) No candidate should carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except the Admit Card (without envelope) inside the hall. If a candidate is found to be copying/conversing with other candidates/ to have in his/her possession papers, notes or books, he/she shall be disqualified from taking this Examination and the next one or two such examinations according to the nature of offence and the matter be reported to MCI for necessary action.
- (v) Candidates shall maintain silence and attend to their papers only. Any disturbance in examination hall shall be deemed as misconduct and the candidate shall forfeit the right to continue to write in the examination. The decision of the Centre superintendent shall be final and binding on candidate.
- (vi) Cellular phones, pagers, calculators etc. are strictly prohibited in the Examination hall.

11. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

- (i) There will be one paper of 3 (three) hours duration containing 250 **Multiple Choice Questions** consisting of all the subjects of MBBS curriculum.
- (ii) The questions will be single response **objective type**. For each correct response, a candidate shall be awarded **four** marks. **One** mark will be deducted for every wrong response. **Zero** mark will be given for the questions not attempted. More than one answer indicated against a question will be considered as incorrect response and will attract **one** negative mark.
- (iii) The tentative number of questions from each subject will be as given below:-
Anatomy (10), Physiology (10), Biochemistry (10), Pharmacology (10), Pathology (15), Microbiology (10), Forensic Medicine (10), Social and Preventive Medicine (15), Ophthalmology (10), ENT (10), Medicine & allied (50), Surgery & allied (50), Obst & Gynae (30) and Paediatrics (10).
- (iv) The examination will be conducted in **English medium only**.
- (v) Separate answer sheet will be provided to the candidate. Candidates must write roll number and test booklet number in Arabic Numereals in the appropriate boxes using a black ball point pen and also completely darken the corresponding circles. For example, if the Roll no. is 2011001 and the booklet no. is 3101, it should be filled as follows :

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- (vi) The Roll number and the Booklet number as filled by the candidate in the Answer Sheet will be accepted as final for the purpose of evaluation. When these numbers are not written or written wrongly, the answer sheet will not be evaluated. The candidate will be solely responsible for any error, omission in filling up the Roll Number and the booklet number.
- (vii) Each MCQ will consist of a stem which may be in the form of a question or an incomplete statement and four responses labeled a, b, c and d. Candidates should indicate the most appropriate answer by darkening the appropriate circle completely. **Black ball point pen should be used.** Candidate should not indicate the answer in any other way like tick mark, cross, dot, line etc. The following example illustrates the correct method of indicating the answer.

Question no. 131 in the Test Booklet may read as follows:

The CASEIN contained in milk is a

- a. Bactrium
- b. Carbohydrate
- c. Fat
- d. Protein

The Correct response is d. The candidate will locate question No. 131 in the answer sheet and darken the circle d as shown here. There is only ONE Correct WAY of indicating the answer.

If more than one circle is darkened or the response is not marked in the correct manner as instructed above, it shall be treated as wrong answer. Candidates who do not wish to attempt a question should leave the circle given against the question blank. Candidates must ensure that the answer sheet is not folded and no stray marks are made on it.

- (viii) Candidates are to submit question booklet also alongwith the answer sheet at the end of examination.

12. DECLARATION OF RESULTS

- (i) The result of successful candidates only with their rank numbers is expected to be declared by **20th February 2011** and will be available on our website **www.hihtuniversity.org**.
- (ii) The University will not intimate candidates individually the result of entrance examination and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- (iii) There is no provision for rechecking/re-evaluation of the answer sheets and no query in this regard shall be entertained.

13. MERIT LIST

- (i) Candidates securing less than 50 % marks (40 % in case of OBC/SC/ST candidates) in the entrance examination will not be considered for admission and their names will not be included in the merit list.
- (ii) In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks at the PGMEE (i.e. in case of a tie) the following procedure shall be adopted for preparing the merit list:
 - (a) *First Level:* The candidate having more marks in the final professional MBBS examination shall get priority. If the tie still persists then-
 - (b) *Second Level:* The candidate having higher aggregate percentage marks in all the professional MBBS examination shall get priority. If the tie still persists then-
 - (c) *Third Level:* Candidate who is older in age shall get priority.

14. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE (COUNSELING)

- (i) The date of Counseling will be intimated to the successful candidates separately and posted on the University website also. However the candidates are required to remain in touch with the examination office to avoid any inconvenience.
- (ii) The allotment of seats shall be made to the candidates through personal appearance and strictly on the basis of merit cum choice.
- (iii) Failure to report for counseling on the scheduled date and time shall result in cancellation of the claim of the candidate to the seat. It shall be the candidate's responsibility to ascertain the result of the PGMEE.

- (iv) The candidate appearing for allotment by personal appearance should bring the following documents **in original** along with 2 set of attested copies of the same:
- a. Admit Card of Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination (PGMEE) – 2011.
 - b. Call Letter issued by University for counseling.
 - c. MBBS degree/Provisional passing certificate.
 - d. Mark sheets of MBBS examinations.
 - e. Internship completion certificate / certificate from the head of the institution that the candidate will be completing the internship by 31st March, 2011.
 - f. Valid permanent/provisional registration certificate issued by MCI/State Medical Council.
 - g. High School/Higher Secondary certificate in proof of age.
 - h. Recent Character Certificate from the head of the institution last attended/ or from a Gazetted officer.
 - i. Any other relevant certificate or document. e.g. – Caste certificate in case of O.B.C./ S.C./ S.T. candidates.
 - j. Affidavit against ragging from Candidate & parent as per appendix- III A & III B.
(Note: The above undertaking is to be given on a notarized stamp paper of ₹ 10/-)

Candidates without original documents will not be allowed to participate in the counseling (allotment by personal appearance).

- (v) The candidates will have the right to choose any one of the seats available at the time of his/ her counseling and the same will be allotted to him/her.
- (vi) In case any candidate is unable to appear in person on the notified date for counseling, he/she can send his/her authorized representative with an authority and undertaking letter as given in **Appendix I** and **Appendix II** along with requisite original documents. The allotment made to the authorized representative shall be binding on the candidate.
- (vii) The mere fact that a candidate or his/her authorized representative has appeared for allotment on a notified date does not mean that a seat shall be allotted to him/her, as the same shall depend upon the availability of a seat and the choices exercised by the candidate or his/her authorized representative.
- (viii) Allotment letter will be issued on the day of counseling to the person who appears for counseling.
- (ix) The candidates who do not appear for allotment in person or through an authorized representative, on notified date, or who reject the available seats for allotment or those who do not join the allotted course by the last date of joining mentioned in the allotment letter, shall forfeit their claim for a seat, which shall then be allotted to the candidate next in the merit list.
- (x) Admitted candidates, must join their courses on 02.05.2011. If they do not join, they shall forfeit their claim for a seat.
- (xi) If a candidate after taking admission to the allotted course, discontinues the PG course, or his/her admission is cancelled by the institution for any reason, he/she shall forfeit the claim for a seat.

- (xii) While reporting for admission, all the relevant certificates/documents in original are to be submitted. These original documents shall be kept with the institution till completion of the course.
- (xiii) All disputes pertaining to conduct of examination by the University and allocation of seats in various subjects shall fall within the jurisdiction of Uttarakhand.
- (xiv) No oral enquiry would be entertained by the authorities. Candidates are requested to communicate in writing. They must take special care to indicate their rank number, roll number, name and postal address in their letter. It should also be signed.
- (xv) Canvassing directly or indirectly for allotment of seats or adjustments thereafter would lead to disqualification of their candidature. Influencing the staff by unfair means would lead to serious consequences for all concerned. The candidates or their relatives visiting University for seeking change of the allotment would face disqualification, since such visit would be treated as trespassing.
- (xvi) The authorities are not obliged to enter into any correspondence with candidates, unless it is an absolute necessity.

This fee does not include enrollment fee & mess charges and the same will be charged separately. In case a candidate is not able to complete the course in stipulated period of time, extra fees shall be charged.

If a candidate withdraws his/her candidature before 21st May of admission year, he/she will forfeit the admission fee.

If he/ she discontinues the course after 21st May of admission year, he/ she has to deposit fees for entire course.

BAN ON RAGGING

Definition

Ragging means causing inducing compelling or forcing a student whether by way of a practical joke or otherwise to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his person or exposes him to ridicule or to forbear from doing any lawful act by intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongfully containing or injuring him or by using criminal force to him or by holding out to him any threat of such intimidation, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force. Supreme Court of India has defined ragging as a criminal offence. -

Penalty for ragging (Section, 116 of the Act)

1. No person who is a student in an educational institution, including an institution under the management of the university or of the central government shall commit or abet ragging.
2. Any person who indulges in or abets ragging shall on conviction be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year. Ragging is a criminal and non-bailable offence.

Warning

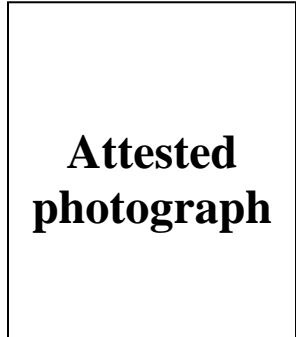
No leniency will be shown to the offenders involved in ragging. All students are requested to note and co-operate in keeping our University and its constituent colleges free from ragging.

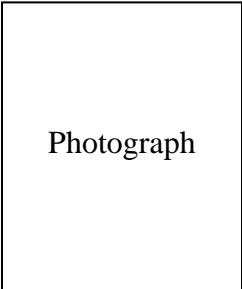
